WIND COLUMNS- Directions are those from which the wind blows, indicated in tens of degrees from true North; i. e., 09 for East, 18 for South, 27 for West. Entry of 00 in the direction column indicates calm. Speed is expressed in knots; multiply by 1.15 to convert to miles per hour.
