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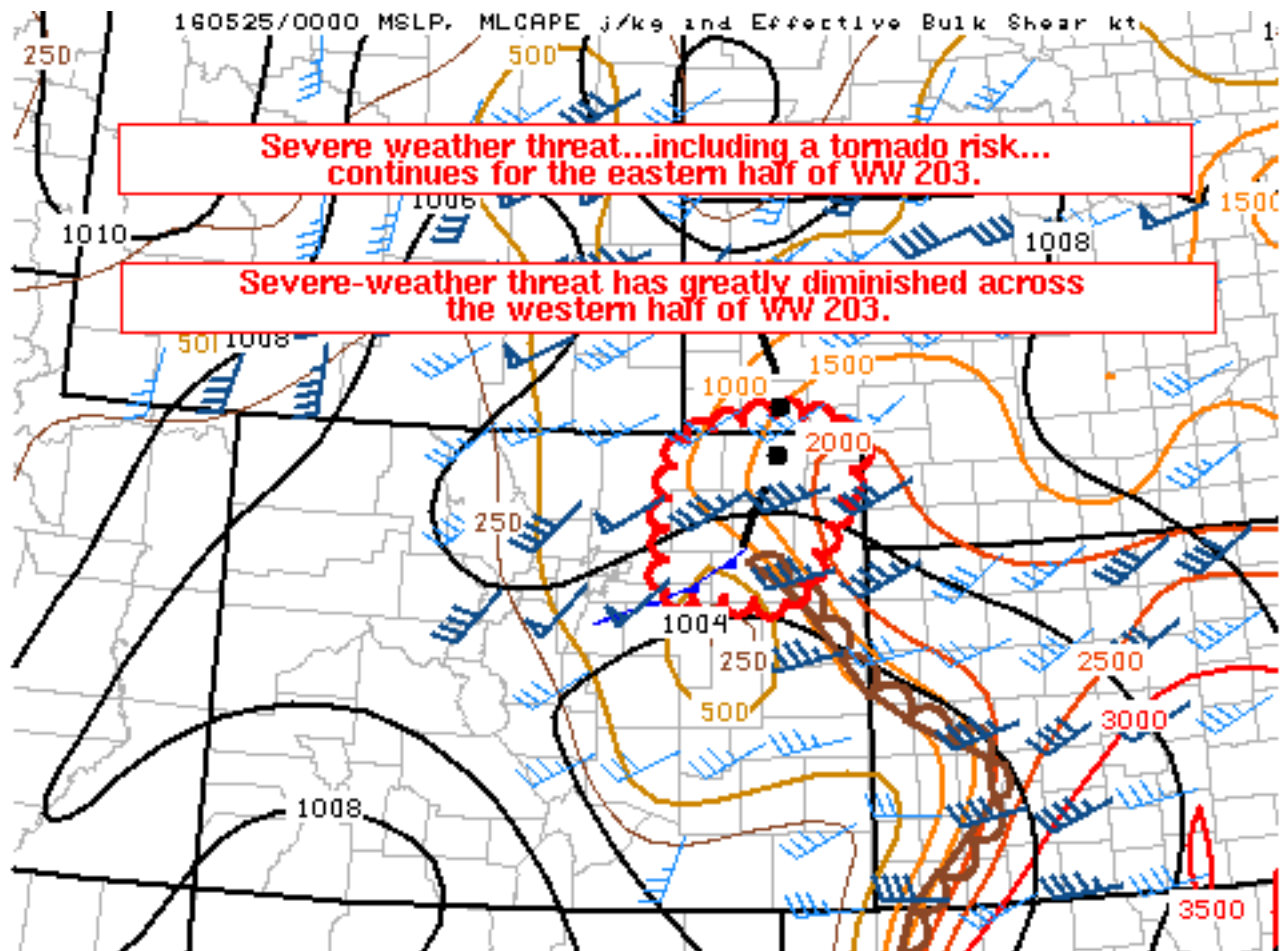

CONCERNING...TORNADO WATCH 203...

THE SEVERE WEATHER THREAT FOR TORNADO WATCH 203 CONTINUES.

SUMMARY...SEVERE-WEATHER THREAT...INCLUDING THE RISK FOR TORNADOES...CONTINUES THIS EVENING ACROSS THE EASTERN HALF OF WW 203. MEANWHILE...THE SEVERE-WEATHER THREAT ACROSS THE WESTERN HALF OF WW 203 HAS DIMINISHED GREATLY WITH LOCAL WFO CANCELLATION FOR THREE COUNTIES IN THIS PORTION OF THE WATCH.

DISCUSSION...A LINE OF STORMS CONTINUES TO MOVE EAST THROUGH NORTHEAST CO AND THE SOUTHERN EXTENT OF THE NEBRASKA PANHANDLE. THE STRONGEST STORM WITH POTENTIAL TO PRODUCE ALL SEVERE HAZARDS WAS

MOVING FROM MORGAN COUNTY INTO WASHINGTON COUNTY. THIS STORM WAS LOCATED AT THE INTERSECTION OF AN ATTENDANT CONVECTIVE OUTFLOW AND THE NORTHWESTWARD PORTION OF THE DRYLINE. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE EASTERN HALF OF WW 203 IS INCLUDED IN MESOSCALE DISCUSSION 712.

MEANWHILE...OBJECTIVE ANALYSES AND SURFACE OBSERVATIONS INDICATED THE ENVIRONMENT ACROSS THE WESTERN HALF OF WW 203...IN THE WAKE OF THE STORMS NOW IN NORTHEAST CO...HAS STABILIZED. ADDITIONAL STRONG TO SEVERE STORMS ARE NOT EXPECTED IN WELD...ADAMS AND ARAPAHOE COUNTIES.
