SEPTEMBER '58

- 2-Had some mod. fog in early morn.
- 3-Had the warmest days so far this month and since July 10 with Off. 97°. Desert areas had severe thunderstorms with 29 Palms being flooded.
- 4-Had the warmest day this month and since July 10 with Off. 101°. Had the warmest low so far this month of since Aug. 13 with Off. 70°. At 8pm the temp. was still an Off. 93°. At 8pm a small thunderstorm began 3 miles east of station and moved NW with some rain & lightning seen at station but no rain fell there. Lightning was observed from 7pm to 10pm SW of station. Many severe storms hit other areas with 50 fires started in the Angeles Forest alone. Big Pines had 11 in. of rain and the ranch had almost 2 inches with the spring being flooded and buried.
- 5-At 8pm one roll of thunder was heard and was 5 mi. south of station. At 12:30pm a short & very lite sprinkle produced .11" inch of rain.
- 11-Had the coolest morn. so far this month and since July 25 with an Off. 58°.
- 12-Had the coldest morn. this month and since July 25 with an Off. 57°. Had the coolest high so far this month and since June 13 with only Off. 79°. Was first high temp. below 80° since June 13.
- 13-Had a tie for the hottest day this month with Off. 101°. Bar. went down to 29.67" in. morn.
- 14-Had a three way tie for high this month with Off. 101°. Temp. was still Off. 80 at 9pm.
- 20-Bar. went down to 29.63" in. morn.
- 21-Had the seventh day in row that the days high broke the days high for the last 5 years.
- 22-Had still snow at the 7,400' level on the Angeles Crest that was up to 12' deep and covered a large area. Had the coldest high so far this month with Off. 79°.
- 23-Had the coldest high this month and since May 11 with Off. 68° due to a weak cold front that produced .01" of rain here and cloudy skies all day. This made it the wettest Sept. on my 6 yrs. of record.
- Had heavier amounts elsewhere with .63" at Big Bear and .35" at Tujunga.
- 24-Had a tie for the coldest day this month with Off. 57°.
- 27-Temp. was still a humid Off. 76° at 12 midnite with a Ac. cloud cover.

JANUARY '59

3-Had the coldest morn. tie for this month and since Nov. 18 with off. 40°. Thin ice formed on small water surfaces.

5-Had the coldest high this month and since Dec. 16, 1958 with off. 57°. Had the first rain of yr. begin and the first rain and measurable rain in 51 days. Started off and on at 12:30pm and became more general at 7:15pm. By 10:30pm had .18" and was coming down at the rate of .10" per hr.

6-At 3:30pm a very severe thunderstorm moved in till 8:30 at pm. Rain came down the hardest I think that I have ever seen. Chevy Chase Dr. in 5 to 10 min. was curb to curb and large cans and rocks rolled down it for over an hour. Some lightning strokes were very close with one at 3:40pm at 1,500 feet to the west. Rain stopped at approx. 5:30pm but a short shower between 11 and 12 noon produced .06" more, bringing the total to 2.03" here with up to 4½" in other areas.
