JULY '60

- 1-Had the warmest morn. since Sept. 13, '59 with Off. 69°. In even. thick Ac. clouds produced a lite .T" of rain in form of scattered lite sprinkles.
- 14-Had the warmest day so far this mo. with Off. 95°.
- 15-Had the hottest day so far this mo. and since July 10, '59 with Off. 103°. At 10pm was 81°. Beat the old record of 100° set in 1954.
- 16-Had a high of Off. 100½° and the warmest low since Sept. 14, '59 with Off. 66°. The high beat the old record of 99° set in 1954. Observer in evening went to friends house in La Creseenta at 2,073' and at 10:30pm temp there was Off. 96°. At 1:30am temp. was still Off. 87° and at same time temp at Gregg WS was 15 deg. cooler at 72°. A tremendous temp difference.
- 17-Had a lite fog in early morn.
- 18-Had a thick fog in real early morn. but cleared by 6am. Was a very hot, humid day with a humidity at 2:30pm of 50% and dewpt. of 65° and temp of around 95°. Had severe sand storms in desert with 65 mph winds and damage at 29 Palms, Blythe, and Thermal. Lightning also caused fire to palm trees in Coachella Valley. *Temp. hit +129° at Death Valley, hottest of yr*
- 19-Had a tie for the warmest morn. so far this mo. with Off. 69°. Was also Off. 101° this afternoon, breaking the record for that date by 8° set in 1954. Was also the 5th date record set in a row. Showers fell along Verdugo Mtn. foothills around 7:30pm but none fell here.
- 20-Had the warmest morn. this mo. & since Sept. 12, '59 with Off. 73°. Had also the hottest day this yr., month and since July 10, '59 with Off. 105°. Beat the old record for this date by 14° set in 1956. Showers and thunderstorms occurred in Foothills and mtns. starting numerous forest fires, but none occurred here at station. Heavy winds and .40" rain hit Tustin area with downed utility lines. In San Gabriel Mtn's lightning started 9 fires and in San Berdu. Mtns. 24 were started.
- 21-Had a tie for the warmest morn. this mo. with Off. 73°, had also the 5th 100+ reading this mo. of Off. 101° at 4:30pm due to high clouds all morn. Beat the old record by 14° set in 1959.
- 31-Average temp for month was the highest on my 6 yrs. of record and beat old record of 76.75° in 1959 by 1.4° to Off. 78.15°. Average high temp. also set a record by beating old record of 91.86° in Aug. 1955 by .4° to 91.9°. In all, temps were about 4° above normal. Also set a new record for number of days of 90° ~~***~~ or above with 20, beating old record of 17 set in Sept. 1956. Of these 20, 19 have occurred in the last 19 days in a row through today.

15-Had a strong Santa Ana wind hit last nite and lasted all day. Winds hit about 25mph here in Glendale with many fallen trees and lights went out in North Glendale for 1½ hr. in early morn. Winds hit 65 mph at Sierra Pelona firelookout, 4,850' near Bouquet Res., 50mph at Mt. Wilson, 45mph at Ontario and 40mph at San Fernando. The air was also very dry with a dewpt. 25° and humid.-17% at 11am.

NOVEMBER '60

- 1-Had a fog in morn. with vis. at 700 feet.
- 2-Had a fog in morn. with vis. at 1/8 mile. Had the highest low of Off. 57 for November, since 1955.
- 3-At 9:45am a lite rain began, becoming heavier, especially around 11:45-noon and then continued until clearing at 6pm, bringing a total of .61". Between 11:45-11:50am(5 min) had .085", had in 15 min. .125", and in 1 hr. had .165". Was a very cold day with the high the coolest since Feb.28 with Off. 57. The low occurred at 11pm with Off.51. The high today and the low yesterday were the same temps.
- 5-Showers began falling about 5pm again at 10pm and then off and on till about 3pm producing .25". At 4pm a very heavy and severe thunderstorm moved in from SE. Rain came down in sheets, wind blew and thunder was heard for shorttime 1 1/2 miles SW. By 4:45pm(45 min.)-.66" rain had fallen with Chev Chase almost curb to curb, many areas of city flooded, mountain rds. closed by slides and one life lost in Sepulvada area. Rain then became steady and tapered off until midnite. With a total of storm so far at 1.24". Was the earliest season heavy rain(1") on my records. Set a new 1 hr. record rain-.71" on my records.
- 6-D ring early morn. hrs. another .59" fell and then at 12:45pm another heavy shower fell producing .135" in 15 min. and a total showere of .19", total for storm which ended then was 2.02". Heavy ams. over 1" fell in other areas of So.Calif. but my station had around the heaviest. Bar. went up to 30.10" in even.
- 9-Bar. went up to 30.15" in forenoon.
- 10-Bar. went up to 30.19" in forenoon.
- 11-The low this morn.was not outstandingly cold, but set a new date record by 1 deg. set in 1957.
- 12-Day dawned cloudy and cool, at 11:45am showers stated that fell from lite to mod. until clearing at 6:45pm. It produced .56". The high for day occurred at 9am as temp.fell all day-the high tied the low high so far with Off.57. Had the lowest day temp.on record for Nov. records.(1955)
- 15-Bar. went up to 30.22" in forenoon.
- 16-Had the coldest morn. so far this mo. with Off. 44 1/2.
- 17-Had the warmest day so far this mo.and since Oct.30 with Off. 80.

- 1-Had the warmest morn. in 17 days with Off.50 $\frac{1}{2}$ °.
- 6-Strong gusty winds hit Southland about 2am and continued all day. Strongest winds ~~here~~ were about 25mph., but hit 105mph at Ontario Airport and 60 mph at Burbank. The bar. rose rapidly and reached 30.25" around noon. Was cool also with Off.60°. At 6pm had 20° dewpt. and 26% humid.
- 7-Winds continued all day, but not as strong. Temps remained cold with my low at Off.40°, tied the record for this date back in 1954. Snow squalls occurred in San Berdu. Mtns. with temps. around +8°.
- 8-Had the coldest morn. so far this mo. with Off.39°. Clouds and wind moved in from east due to storm over southern Ariz. but produced only .T" here in sprinkle in late afternoon. Heavy snow fell in San Berdu. Mtns. south and over high desert. Big Bear-18", Snow Valley-6", Arrowhead-5" Yucca Valley-9", Joshua Tree-4", 29Palms-2", Cp. Baldy-3", Mt. Palmar-4", Barstow-1", Beaumont-1", Palmdale-.T". Only T"snow fell in mtns. around here. Was cold too with Big Bear having high of +16° and low of -10. Victorville and Barstow high was +39°. Chains were needed in Barstow-Amboy area and San Geronio Pass too.
- 9-Had the coldest morn. this season and mo.and since Feb.25 with Off.37°. Tied the date record set in 1956.
- 14-Bar.rose to 30.25" in even. Bar.has been over 30.10" for last 3 days.
- 15-Bar. rose to 30.30" in morn.
- 16-The Off°. low of 41° this morn. beat the old record for date set in '54 by 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ °
- 18-Had the warmest day so far this mo.& since Nov.22 with Off.79°. Beat the old date record by 1° set in 1958.
- 19-Had the warmest day so far this mo.& since Nov.22 with Off.80°. Beat the old date record by 2° set in 1954.
