MAY 1962

12-Afternoon SW winds went up to 18mph.

13-Went down to 43° in morn.

14-A weak storm went over producing a .T" shower in morn and showers in afternoon produced .05".

At 6:15pm a thunderstorm moved in from the west with some thunder but mod. rain and some sleet, by 6:35-7pm closer and more numerous thunder occurred with several strokes of less than 1 mile away. As storm went over wind hit a NW gust of 28 mph. A total of .15" fell for storm and .20" for days total. Was cold all day with high of 67°. Low in morn of 45° was reached at 7:30pm again. Heavy hail fell in some areas and up to 4" snow fell above 5000' in mtns. Was first measurable rain in 53 days (Mar. 22).

15-Went down to 41° this morn. Low at GWS#1 for May never got this low. A sprinkle in early morn produced .01" rain

16-Precipitation began at 9am and continued from mist to mod. rain till cleared at 5pm with .20" falling. Had a high of only 62, coolest since Apr. 3. Up to 1/2" rain fell at Pasadena but many areas had no rain. Snow fell above 5000' with 6" at Barton Flats. *Reno, Nev. had 9" snow*

19-Had a lite fog in morn with vis. at 1/2 mi.

26-Bar went down to 29.87" in even.

27-Bar went down to 29.86" in even. Had the coolest high in a month with Off. 59°.

28-This morn's low of Off. 43° was 8° colder than record for date at GWS#1.

- 13-High today was 29° cooler than yesterday due heavy stratus cover with .T" heavy mist from 6pm.
