- 3-Had the warmest day so far this summer with Off. 93°
 5-Had the warmest morn since last Sept. with Off. 64°
 and warmest day so far this summer and this month
 with Off. 94° (a record low-high for July).
 10-Low of 50° tied record low for July set on July
 4th, 1964. Observer went into mtns and found
snow still on ground. Lowest was at 6100' on
 Crystal Lk. Road and 2 large snow fields on
 Angeles Crest at Dorr Canyon at 7700' and 7300'
 levels.
 11-Had a lite fog in early morn.
 13-Had the coldest morn recorded for July with Off. 49°.
 16-Had a short, moderate rain shower from heavy Ac
 clouds at 12:55am to 1:30am of .05" Yesterday and today, mtns had scattered
 thunderstorms along with humid air and temps here in low 80's. This was
 the first measureable rain for July on any of my records (since 1954) and
 since 1951 for Glendale. *La Crescenta-.03", Baldy Notch-.20", Pasadena-.03" & Palmdale-.01"*
 17-Heavy thunderstorms hit deserts with .20" rain in 20 minutes at Mojave, a
 3/4 hr. rain at Lancaster and lightning fires in Palm Springs. Had Ac here.
 18-More thunderstorms hit deserts and mtns with 1/2" rain at Palm Springs Tram.
 25-Had the coolest day since June 26 with Off. 72° due to morning stratus cover.
 Was the coldest high ever recorded on my records for July. Had a lite fog

- 5-Started to sprinkle around 6am off and on due to heavy stratus cover. Had a lite fog off and on to with visibility down to 300 ft. Had .12" by 5pm. High of Off. 61 was coolest on record for Sept. By midnight after an increase in intensity had .50" so far.
- 6-Steady mod. drizzle during nite brought total of .96" by 8am. Fog persisted with vis. down to 300' until lifted and drizzle stopped at 3pm with 1.05" total or .55" today. Again set record for coolest high in Sept. with Off. 57° at 1am. Was due to dying tropical storm Emily. LA had .07", Altadena-.82", Chatsworth-.46", San Berdu-.27", Lk. Arrowhd-.66" and Big Bear-.00". Was cool moist spots (like November) with 58-39° Mt. Wilson and 58-38° Big Bear. Tioga Pass had 9" snow-record for so early in season.
- 7-Went down to 28° at Big Bear this morn (47° here). Baro went up to 30.13" at 113-Baro went up to 30.17" at 11am. This was the highest reading on record for Sept. ~~15-102° at Imperial Today.~~
- 16-Had a fog (vis 300') and drizzle in morn with .02" by 8am. Sprinkled off and on rest of day increasing somewhat after 5:30pm (only T" all day) along with gusty SE winds (like winter). Had .22" total by 11pm. Baro went down to 29.73" at 8pm. Was all due to cold front from North. ~~102° at Indio Today.~~
- 17-Lite rain most of night brought .11" more (.33" total) and broke at 11am with .39" total. Had occasional fog in morn too. Glendale had .04", La Canada-.02".
- 18-Could hear thunder 7 miles to SE at noon and moved slowly this way with lite rain beginning at 12:30pm and mod rain after 12:45pm. Main storm passed 1 to 2 miles south with rain stopping at 1:15pm with .16". But continuing heavy to south. Started again at 1:35pm until 2pm with .01" more. Sprinkled off and on with continuing thunder to south and NW. Started to rain again at 2:45pm as thunder let up ending at 4pm. From 2:15 to 3:15pm LA downtown had cloudbursts with 1.25" a near one hour record to Feb. 1914 with 1.51". Flooded areas in Highland Park and Sunland. Was wintery type day with rain in desert and only 72° in Needles. T" was 46-32° at Baldy Notch. Temp fell from 62-52° during 4 hour rain. Rain ended here at 4pm with .24" more and .41" to 19-Started to rain prior to 6am and broke at 8:45am with .26". Snow fell above 8000', earliest in 15 years with 2" at Baldy Notch and 1" Big Bear. The rain in LA was heaviest (1.37" total) on record for so early in season so far.
- 25-Had a fog in morn with vis. down to 200 ft.
- 26-Had a lite drizzle til 9am in morn along with fog with T". Burbank had .01"
- 27-Had a lite drizzle til 8am in morn with T".
- 29-First Santa Ana wind of new season hit at 2am rising temp from 49-57° in 1/2 hr At 7:42am had 41 mph gusts. At 8am had dewpt. +23°, humid-21% with wind ending at 11am. At 10pm had dewpt +17°, humid-15%.
- 30-Had a lite Santa Ana in morn with winds to 15mph. At 8am had dwpt +23°, humid 15%. Baro went up to 30.18" at 11pm-Sept. record high. Temp hit 94° in Newport Bch, 97° Santa Ana and 79° Santa Monica Pier but only 84° here and 54° at Baldy Notch. Was 92° Santa Barbara, 95° Long Beach

- 1-High of 90° was warmest day since Aug. 28. Was 99° at Long Bch and 98° at LA. Baro went up to 30.21" at 11am.
- 7-Had the 2nd day in row with terrible smog and vis less than 1 mile at times.
- 8-Had a fog in morn with vis. down to 300 ft.
- 9-Had a fog in morn.
- 10-Baro went up to 30.19" at 10am.
- 12-Had a fog roll in in late evening. *Was 107° at LA Sprs.*
- 13-Had a fog in early morn. *with T" at Burbank*
- 14-Had a lite sprinkle from early morn to 8:30am of T" from heavy stratus clouds.
- 15-Strong gusty N winds came up after passage of dry//58° colder front earlier in day with winds to 45 mph at 9:30pm. Baro went down to 29.92" at 7pm. *Hit 21 mph at Burbank & 37" at LA airport*
- 16-Winds died down somewhat but continued into morning up to 25 mph. After 2pm started up again, very gusty (being calm at times) hitting 58mph at 3:03pm. *Hit 33 mph at Sandberg.* At 5pm had dwpt. +14°, humid 11%. Was cold in mtns with lows of Big Bear 24°, Baldy 23°, Wilson 33°, and Tramway 20°. Rained in eastern deserts. *Had .13" Big Dr & T" snow, .05" Arrowhead & .15" Needles.*
- 17-Had the coldest morn on my records for Oct with Off. 43°. *Was 43° in Santa & 47° Pasadena.*
- 20-Lite Santa Ana wind came up at 10:30am increasing some after sunset to about 20 mph. At 6pm had dewpt +24°, humid 12%. Wind hit 34 mph at 9:30pm then winds died down some. High was 88°, but hit 96° in LA, 99° at Long Beach and 97° at Burbank.
- 21-Santa Ana continued through night, gusty at times. At 7:30am had dewpt +25 humid 16%. Was the hottest night on record for Oct. with Off. 71°. At 5pm had dewpt +32°, humid 13%. After being lite all day winds increased to about 25 mph until 10pm. Was quite hot elsewhere with hottest spt in US at San Deigo with Off. 101°. *Low was 80° at UCLA, 70° at Avalon & 90° at San Fernando.*
- 22-Lite Santa Ana continued through nite, but died down during day. At 5pm had dewpt. +28°, humid 9%. Was hot elsewhere with LA 100°, LA Airport 101°, Santa Ana 103° and San Deigo 104°. *Was only 60° at Baldy Notch for high and 92° here* Had 20-25 mph winds in evening. *Hit 90° at Avalon, 98° Catalina Airport (yrs. high).*
- 23-Had very weak Santa ana in morn again for 4th day in row. At 3pm had dewpt +20°, humid 7%. *Was 99° at Santa Monica Pier & 100° at Laguna Bch (yrs. high).*
- 24-Had very weak Santa Ana in morn again for 5th day in row. *Went dn. to +9° at Eddie this*
- 26-Baro went up to 30.22" at noon--Highest recorded on my records for October.

- 2-Had the warmest day since Nov. 5 with Off. 76°
- 3-Had a lite Santa Ana in morn. Baro went up to 30.30" at 9am.
- 4-Had the warmest day since Oct. 31 with Off. 81°
- 5-Had a lite Santa Ana in evening.
- 8-Started to sprinkle from approaching storm at 9:30pm. eventho moon was still coming through. Had T" by 10pm and stopped at 10:30pm.
- 9-Had another lite shower around 5am with .10" by 7am. Another lite rain began at 10am to 11am. Lite rain again started at 2:30pm with .25" total by 5pm. At 5:15pm had lightning to south and again at 5:48pm at 1½ mile south as rain increased some becoming mod at times then decreasing after 9pm to lite rain with .83" so far by midnight. Heavier rains fell to south and in deserts with flash floods in Needles and nearly 1" rain. Had 1" in Palm Springs too. Baro went down to 29.78" at 5pm. Cloudburst type rain hit east Glendale around 5:30pm with 1.99" at Newspress and 2.30" at School Canyon gage.
- 10-Very lite rain fell throughout nite becoming sprinkles in morn with .13" mor or .96" total by 7am as rain ended at 10am with .96" total. We appeared as one of driest areas for storm with 1½" Pasadena, 2½" Bev. Hills and 2" in mtns. Snow fell above 5500' with 8" Waterman and 12" Baldy.
- 11-Started to sprinkle around 11pm from approaching storm with T" by midnight.
- 12-Lite rain fell intermittently with .06" by 1:30am then became mod rain, cleared after about 4am with .21" total. Clouded up rapidly after 9am with T" sprinkle from 9:45-10am then began to rain at 11:45am lite to mod 'til broke at 3pm with .25" more or .46" total. Was cold with high of only 48° at 10:30am, coldest since Apr. 12. Snow fell briefly above 4600' (none on Lukens) but mainly above 5500' with T" Red Box, 2" Chaffin Flats & 4" Waterman. *Heavier aunts fell in other sections - Haines Canyon -.88", Fern Lodge - 1.13", Arrowhead -.78"*
- 13-Had alite frost in morn with low of Off. 38°.
- 14-Cold low off coast moved into area with lite to mod rain after 9am then tapering off after 1pm until stopped at 3pm with .38". Heavier rain fell along coast with many thunderstorms and hail but none here. Was very cold, with snow falling above 2600' mixed with rain and sticking above 3600'. Had the coldest high since Ap. 9 with Off. 42° (coldest on my Dec. records). Gusty N to NW winds came up after 4pm to 40 mph at 9:30pm. Baro went down to 29.65" at 4pm, lowest since March, 1964. Snow stuck above 2500' on Ridge Route but only to about 2" deep. Had up to 1 ft in local mtns. Rainfall varied from 1.05" Simi in cloudburst, 1.4-1.8", La Cresc. -.20" and Santa Ana had .02". *Glendale -.50", Catalina -.17", San Diego -.105", Big Pines -.104"*
- 15-Had a lite frost in morn with Off. 36°. Clouds formed during day with lite showers beginning at 4pm with .T" by 5pm then stopped at 5:30pm. Heavier showers fell in Glendale and other areas to south and mtns. More snow in mtns with 12" at Crestline.
