**Bob Gregg does a lot more than just talk about the weather.**

**W**hen Bob Gregg discusses the weather, he's not making small-talk.

Even he admits his daily routine for nearly the past 40 years of taking weather readings in the Foothills "is a hobby that's gotten out of control."

Gregg, local weather observer for the Los Angeles County Flood Control District, and who is often quoted about weather in the News-Press, says he's not really sure how he got mixed up with all the thermometers, barometers and other gauges around his hillside Glendale home.

He believes the weather obsession began when he was about 12 and worked on a weather ment badge for the Boy Scouts.

Gregg's grandfather built a little wooden weather station in the

- 2-Had a lite frost in morn with Off. 36°  
 3-Had a lite frost in morn with Off. 38°  
 5-Baro went up to 30.29" at 10pm.  
 6-Had the warmest day since Dec. 7 with Off. 73° and warmest morn since Dec. 10 with Off. 47° due to \* very weak Santa Ana condition.  
 7-Had the warmest day\* since Dec. 7 with Off. 77° and warmest morn since Dec. 6 with Off. 54.  
 11-Santa Ana winds began at 6pm after a very hazy, smoggy day rising temp 5° in 1 hr, winds increased after 10pm hitting 34 mph at 10:53pm.  
 12-Santa Ana winds continued through nite but ceased during mid-morn. Winds came up again after 6pm but light.  
 13-Lite Santa Ana winds continued through nite but ceased during morning.  
 14-Had elite Santa Ana wind in morn then came up again from 5-8pm hitting 32 m  
 15-Mod. Santa Ana came up after 4:30pm hitting 49 mph at 7:31pm and increasing to highest wind I have ever recorded with 74 mph at about 9:25 pm. After 9:30pm had occasional sprinkles from Ac clouds until 11:30pm of .5" Many gusts were over 50 mph after 9pm and steady above 30 mph. *Wind hit 51mph at Sandberg*  
 16-Strong Santa Ana continued all night and into morn and all day with many gusts over 50 mph and peak so far of 56 mph at 8:54am. Was dark and cloudy to SE all day with showers in area. Avalon had 60 mph winds, worse in 10 years and mod. damage. Winds increased somewhat in evening, hitting 64 mph at 9:23pm. Wasn't a dry Santa Ana with lowest humidity at 4:30pm of humid 20% and dwpt. +15°. Had showers in deserts with snow on East slope of mtns with 8" Big Bear and 4" Wrightwood.  
 17-Winds continued through nite with gust to 59 mph at 3:50am. Continued all day up to 50 mph but then began to decrease after sundown. Rotor clouds existed most of day with deserts cloudy and raining with rain at Needles, Palm Springs and Blythe with snow again on East slopes. Snowed at 29-Palms Yucca Valley and Joshua Tree. Winds hit 85 mph at Ontario and 40 at Burbank Was cold in mtns with 18° to 8° at Baldy Notch and 18° to 12° at Tram.  
 18-Winds stopped at 2am but blew lightly off and on again in early morn after 3am then stopped at daybreak. Continued showers fell in deserts. *.1" to .60" by the 4, .40" Brawley.*  
 19-Surprise weak storm went over during day with sprinkles from 9:30am-11am of .1". LA had .01" and Airport .11". Some snow fell in San Berdo mtns with 6" Big Bear and 5" Holiday Hill. *Catalina had .23", by the .18", & 7" La Cresenta.*  
 20-Santa Ana wind came up at 4:30am with gust to about 30 mph, continued throughout day dying down after dark.  
 21-Had a very lite frost with Off. 35°  
 22-Had a very lite frost with Off. 36°  
 23-Had a lite frost with Off. 34°. Coldest morn since Ap. 12, 1965.  
 24-Had a ~~very~~ ~~lite~~ frost in morn with Off. 35°  
 25-Had a very lite frost in morn with Off. 40°

30-Lite to mod. rain fell from about 3am (first measurable rain this month and in 30 days) then had a thunderstorm (first in Jan. since 1962) go over between 4:25am-4:45am with closest lightning at 0.8 miles North. Cold front went over at that time with temp dropping to 39° and baro hitting low of 29.82" along with gusty E. winds prior to front passage. Baro dropped ~~\*\*\*\*~~ .38" in 18 hrs. Snow fell above 3500' on Lukens. Had snow reced~~ed~~ to 4000' by evening. Snow depths ranged from 10" to 14". Rain stopped, but remained cloudy at about 7am with .70" so far. Started to rain again at 9am until 1 am with .08" more. Skies broke and at 2:30pm could hear thunder from storm about 7 miles south. Clouded up rapidly after 3:30pm and began to have lite rain at 3:40pm. At 3:47pm could hear thunder 6 miles West and as storm move over mainly over Verdugo Mtns. had 18 rolls of thunder, with closest at 1 mile so th at 4:15pm, in 28 minutes. FEBRUARY '66

- 1-Had a lite to very lite rain from weak storm begin at 3pm with .06" by 5pm then became a drizzle after 7pm with .20" total by 11pm so far. Had a lite fog in evening too. No snow fell on Lukens ~~but~~ but Angeles Crest had snow above 4000' w/ 1" *at Lukens*
- 2-Mist ended and skies cleared at 2am with .01" more for storm total of .21". Had a frost in morn with Off. 37° *La Cus. -.32", Buick -.10", Mt Lukens -.27" & Palmdale -.14"*
- 5-Had a lite sprinkle from Ac clouds of T" at 3:45 and 5:45pm and from 9:30-10:15pm of .T".
- 6-Lite to mod rain began around 2am(?) with .98" so far by 7:45am along with occasional fog at 350' visibility, continued until 3pm with few sprinkles after with 1.49" total by 5pm. In last 85 days have had a total of 29.17" rain. Skies broke briefly between 5-6pm then fog rolled in. Had a T" sprinkle from 8-9:30pm. Snow fell above 6000' with 4" Big Bear, 12" Baldy, 2" Wrightwood. Other rainfall was LA-1.39", Burbank-.83", Arrowhead-2.23" and Mojave-.37". Day temperature difference of 2° was lowest of record for Feb. and lowest since May, 1965.
- 7-Few showers in early morn brought .01" more. Ptly cloudy skies clouded up during day with showers in area beginning by 11am with lite shower at station between 3:30pm and 4:30pm of .01". Heavy snow showers existed over mtns most of afternoon and on Lukens with snow falling above 2800' and sticking above 4600'. Had gusty N. winds during showers up to 33mph. At 5:30pm started sprinkling again with snow on Lukens down to 3500', stopping at 8:30pm with only T" here as skies slowly cleared. Snowed only  $\frac{1}{2}$ " at Palmdale Cutoff and 1" Red Box. Palmdale and Victorville had snow too. In mtns ranged from 20" at Snow Valley to 48" Blue Ridge and Baldy. During evening had thunderstorms over Catalina Island.
- 8-As skies clear baro hit low of 29.68" at 3am. Had a very lite frost with Off. 37°
- 9-Had a mod frost in morn with Off. 37°
- 10-Had a frost in morn with Off. 37°. Weak, rapidly moving cold front, went over at noon with T" sprinkle from 11:30am to 12:15pm with snow on mtns including Lukens but only T". Strong, N. winds began at 11:30am hitting 45 mph at 5:15pm and 56 mph at 8pm in Santa Ana type winds. Heavy snow fell in Baldy area where Cp Baldy had 1.45" rain in form of snow. After falling to 29.86" at 3pm baro rose rapidly to 30.12" by 11pm (0.28" in 8 hrs.). Baldy had 12" snow, Waterman 10" and Big Bear-12". *Sandberg had 2" snow & Redup-T"*
- 11-Strong Santa Ana winds continued until about 2am then let up but continued. Baro went up to 30.23" at 11am.
- 12-Strong Santa Ana winds came up at 6pm with gusts increasing to over 50 mph.
- 13-Continued Santa Ana winds brought a gust of 70 mph at 1:15am topping observers TV aerial. Winds died down after sunrise with temp falling to 43° at 8am. At about 3-4am winds were very strong and felt to be over 70 mph. Winds hit 58 mph at Ontario and 85 mph at Baldy Notch during morn. Observer went into San Berdu Mtns and found snow still on ground above 3900' in shade and 6000' in sun. Big Bear Lake was completely frozen over.
- 14-Had a very lite frost in morn with Off. 37°
- 15-Had a frost in morn with Off. 36°
- 16-Had a very lite frost in morn with Off. 41°. Had the warmest day since Jan. 15 with Off. 68°

MARCH 1966

- 1-Weak storm went over during day with very light showers in area and very light shower here from 4:45-5:15pm with .T". LA had .01" and Arrowhead had .06". Baro went down to 29.82" at 5pm.
- 2-Even tho skies here were clear most of day had a high of only Off. 49° after coldest morn since Feb. 15 with Off. 36°. Some showers did fall in area \* in early morn with .12" at LA airport, T" LA and ~~about 90"~~ Lk. Arrowhead. <sup>Big Day - 1.21"</sup> Very light snow or glaze was on Lukens above 4600' in morn. Gusty NW winds came up at 7:30am and blew all day up to 30 mph. Snow fell in morn in Palmdale area <sup>w/ 4" Dry Bear</sup> Winds came up briefly stronger after 8pm hitting <sup>41" Sandberg</sup> 47 mph at 8:35pm. <sup>43mph at LA airport</sup>
- 3-Had the coldest morn since Jan. 31 with Off. 34°.
- 4-Had a very light frost in morn with Off. 37°. Baro went up to 30.27" at 11am.
- 5-Warm, humid air pumped in from SW ahead of large storm to north brought high of 70° at 5pm with temp falling to 56° by 8pm then rising again to 60° at midnight.
- 6-Had the warmest morn since Jan. 13 with Off. 53°.
- 15-Had a fog develop after 10pm.
- 16-Dry, hardly noticeable cold front went over in forenoon bringing gusty NW winds behind it clearing out area of smog for first time in over a week. Had gusts to 26 mph. <sup>Sandberg had North winds to 46 mph.</sup>
- 17-Had a very weak Santa Ana come up in late afternoon until late evening. Haven't had any measurable rain for 38 days (Feb. 7)
- 22-Had a Santa Ana come up at 4pm to about 34 mph around 10pm. Temp didn't fall below 60° until 1am tomorrow. Wind hit 50 mph at Ontario.
- 23-After a warm nite, 59°, Ac increased to overcast in afternoon from weak upper level storm off coast. After dark lite Santa Ana came up again to 15 mph.
- 24-The first measurable rain in 45 days and first rain in 23 days occurred as unstable air created thunderstorms over mtns to drift over area from NE aft. 3pm with rain, heavy at times, beginning at 3:45pm with approx. .30" by 5pm and .49" total when rain stopped at 6:15pm. Had many rolls of thunder with closest lightning at ½ mile South as storm went over. Temp fell from 71° at 4:15pm to 52° at 5:30pm. Lite to very lite rain began again intermittently after 6:30pm with .53" total by 11pm.
- 25-Continued showers fell in early morn with .16" more for total .69" by 7am. Continued cloudy skies gave way to lite rain shower from 3:30-5:15pm of .04 more for .73" total. Other totals were La Crescenta .67", Glendale .52", Arrowhead .44", Palmdale .15" and Glendora 1.12". Snow fell above 7000' with 7" Baldy & 2" Dry Bear. <sup>Tramway - 1.30", Big Pines - 1.07", Mt. Wilson - 1.29"</sup>
- 26-Had a fog in early morn with vis. at ¼ mile.
- 30-Due to stagnant high pressure over SW had the Hottest day on my records for March with Off. 90°. Palm Springs had first 100+ temp of year with 100° <sup>as in North Valley</sup> Temp was 72° at 11:45pm <sup>Sunland hit 90°</sup>
- 31-Record high for March occurred at 2pm with Off. 94°, was above 90° from 11:30 to 5pm. Temp hit 95° Pasadena, 96° Burbank, 99° Northridge, and 104° Palm Spri LA had 90°, 9° below record for March set in 1897. Had the warmest low since Oct. 19, 1965, with Off. 63° at 1am. Temp was still 75° at 11:45pm. <sup>Sunland hit 95° Santa Monica Pier was only 60° with Avalon 61° in fog while Catalina Airport hit 90° in sun.</sup>

APRIL '66

1-High for day of Off. 91°; beat the date record by 44°. Had the warmest morn since Oct. 29, 1965, with Off. 65°. Was 76° at 2am. A ground fog developed after 10pm dropping temp to low for day of 56° by 11pm. Was 108° in Palm Springs, a record for April.

2-Lite fog developed in late evening. Baro went dn to 29.81" at 7pm. *North winds hit 39mph at Sandberg with nothing here.*

3-Had a fog in morn with vis. down to 300 ft. Had a drizzle also of .T" until 9:30am. *Aladena had .03" & LaCres - 0"*

11-Even with a mild low of 47°, was the coldest in 17 days.

12-Even with a mild low of 45°, was the coldest in 23 days.

13-Lite Santa Ana wind came up at 5pm with gusts to 25 mph.

14-Santa Ana continued during nite and all day with gusts to 31 mph in morn and caused the low to be 18° warmer than yesterdays.

15-Santa Ana came up again in early morn, dieing down during day causing the warmest morn on record for April with Off. 74° at 1am. Was also the warmest morn since Sept., 1963, actual low for day tho occurred at 9pm with Off. 69° rising again to 74° at 10pm. Temp rose to tie for the record warmest for April with Off. 95°. Other highs were; LA, 1° from record Ap, with 99°, Airport 95°, Santa Monica 85°, Burbank 97°, Pasadena 97°, Zuma Beach 93°, *Avalon 96° & Sanford 91°*

16-Low during nite was a hot 74° at 5am dropping to 63° by 7am as cool ocean air moved in causing a high of 82° and low occurring for day of 58° at 11pm.

18-Had the coolest high so far this month, a record high, and since Mar. 27 with Off. 63°. Baro went down to 29.79" at 6am.

19-Had a lite sprinkle in early morn with .T". Showers fell in other areas with .13" Mt. Wilson and .15" San Berdu. *Big Bear-.14" with 1/2" snow.*

22-Scattered thunderstorms fell over mtns and deserts south of here even tho was clear here *with .13" Warner Sprs & .05" Hydenwild.*
