OCTOBER '67

- 2-With a low of only 58° was still coldest Oct. 2nd on record here, previous was 60° in 1962.
- 3-Had the coldest morn since June 26 with Off. 55°
- 4-Had a fog in morn.
- 5-Had the coldest morn since June 6 with Off. 48°. Was coldest Oct. 5th on stations records too.
- 6-Santa Ana wind began at 3am with gusts to 44 mph at 7:27am. At 8am had humid of 22%, winds died down during day.
- 8-At noon had humid of 16% and dewpt. of +34°.
- 14-Santa Ana wind began at 10:30pm raising temp 10° in 1/4 hr from 65° to 75°. Had gusts to 20 mph. Baro went up to 29.76" at 5pm.
- 15-Santa Ana wind continued through nite with gust to 42mph at 10:20am although was probably stronger in early morning hours. Continued all day up to 25 mph and was very dry. At 3:30pm had humid of 4% and dewpt. +6°. Bad brush fires burned in several areas. Winds increased some after 5pm. High for day of 90° was hottest for date on records bettering record by 11° set in 1966. Got drier with humid of 3% and dewpt -10° at 10pm. The humidity figure tied for all time low on my records. Both were lowest since Jan. 3, 1964. Had warmest morn since Sept. 1 with Off. 73°. Was hot elsewhere with Culver City nation's highest with 106°. Was 98° in Burbank, 99° in LA and 95° at Santa Monica Pier.
- 16-Santa Ana continued all nite and into morn. At 8am had humid of 7% then died down. High was warmest Oct. reading since Oct. 6, 1964, with Off. 95°. Was warmest Oct. 16 on record, 15° above previous high. Was hottest day since Sept. 1. Wind came up after 5pm to 18 mph at times. At 10pm had humid of 5%. Continued brush fires plagued areas west of Chatsworth.
- 18-Baro went up to 30.15" at noon.
- 21-Had a fog in morn.
- 22-Had a fog in morn and coldest morn since Oct. 5 with Off. 49°.
- 28-Had a fog in morn. A high of 71° was the coolest this month, but the warmest low-high on my records for Oct.
- 29-Strong Santa Ana came up at 6am with gusts to 47 mph at 7:41am and 49 mph at 8:55am. Continued less strong rest of day. At 6pm had humid of 3% and dewpt. of -11°.
- 30-Santa Ana wind blew briefly in early morn but only long enough to raise temp 11° around 3am.
- 31-Santa Ana wind continued, lightly in morn and again in afternoon. At 5pm had humid. of 11%

NOVEMBER '67

4-Had a thick fog in early morn with vis. down to 150 feet. Had coldest morn since June 6 with Off. 47°.

12-Baro went up to 30.12" at 11am.

15-The first rain in 47 days began at 9:30pm from heavy Ac clouds with a lite shower and ended at 10pm. Other areas had lite sprinkles too.

19-A series of lite to occ'l heavy thunderstorms moved in beginning about 1:30am and continued off and on until 8am with 1.77" of rain. Thunderstorms moved close with lightning at 2 miles East at 1:40am and at 5:20am was $\frac{1}{2}$ mile West. Clouds broke at 8:15am briefly, then fog moved in briefly too. Was first measureable rain in 51 days, 4 days short of Fall record.

At 8:30am had thunder 4 miles away. From 9:50am to 10:25am had a mod thundershower with 12 strikes within 7 miles during time, closest 1 mile SW. Rain fell from 10am to 10:25am with .17" more. Showers and occ'l thunderstorms then began intermittently after 10:45am. Had .49" more by 4:15pm for 2.43" storm total so far. Showers increased after 5pm with 1.13" additional by 10:30pm for 3.56" storm total so far. High for day of 59° was coolest high since June 17. Many other areas had flooding and rainfall ranged from less than 1" along south coast to over 8" in mtns with many campers isolated and 2 killed by flash floods. Baro went down to 29.80" at 11am. Briggs had 3.43" & Pickens-3.20" Opid Cp had 7.86" Today high for 24hr. in state. AT Wilson-4.81", Big T Dam-4.58", Cp Colby-6.36"

20-Occ'l lite to heavy rain continued through nite, ending and clouds breaking at 7am with .64" additional. Clouds increased after 9am with rain beginning again at 11:30am, heavy at times, and occ'l thunder between 1pm and 2:30pm as close as 2 miles. Rain ended at 4pm with .98" more or storm total of 5.1 Rain began again, litely after 6:30pm with .18" more or 5.36" total and 1.80 today. Flooding continued to hamper areas. West Fork Ranger Station has had 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", while Palos Verde has had only $\frac{1}{2}$ " so far. Storm total at Briggs-5.45" & Pickens-5.60"

21-Rained through nite with 1.60" by 8am. Continued, mod at times through morn until stopped and began to clear at 1pm. Had approx 1.20" more. Was like being in eye of hurricane as clouds moved over again around 4:30pm and at 6:45pm had a sudden heavy rain with .11" more by 7pm and storm total of 8.27 Continued to rain, more litely after. After 7:10pm thunderstorms moved in as close as 1 mile East with most lightning S and SW. This was 3rd day this month, most on all my records for Nov. Was also 13 days this year, most since 1958. Had .28" more rain by 10:30pm as storm broke with total of 8.55" and days total of 3.19" Thunderstorms let up after 10pm. Baro went down to 29.74" at 6pm. The high of only 55° was coolest since May 31. The low for the entire day occurred at 1pm. Cleared after 11pm. Snow fell above 7000' with 12" Hol. Hill and 7" Baldy. Briggs 8.74", Pickens-9.00"

22-Day dawned clear and beautiful. In afternoon had some increase in cu. over mtns but after 3pm increased with sprinkles beginning at 5pm increasing to mod rain at 5:45-6pm then cleared at 6:30pm with .24" additional and storm total of 8.79". Other areas had; Glendale-6.27", Burbank-8.13", La Canada-9.14", Red Box-12.16", LA-7.96", Airport-4.79", Palmdale-3.21", Indio-1.00" and Opid Cp-14.02" Briggs-14" additional-8.85", Pickens-14.20" additional-9.20"

28-A rapidly moving weak cold front went over with brief mod showers from 4:15-4:45am with .05" rain. Had another brief sprinkle around 8:30am of .02" for .07" total. Cleared after 9am with gusty NW winds to 40 mph at 4:10pm. Briggs 9.7" Burbank-7" Glendale-28", La Ctes-.21", LA-.01", Palmdale-.06" & Arrowhd-.80", The wet spot. (over)

DECEMBER '67

- 4-Had the first FROST of season with a lite one and low of Off. 40.
- 5-Started to sprinkle occ'lly from weak front at 3:30pm with .T" by 5pm. Cleared after 6:30pm with .T" total. LA had .03"
- 7-Started to drizzle from approaching weak front at noon, increasing some with .01" by 5pm along with fog. High of only 50° was coolest since Apr. 19. Clouds broke some and drizzle ended at 10am with total of .02". LA had .10" ^{Griggs-.02"} ^{Pickens-.02"}
- 8-Gusty, cold, NE winds came up after 7am to about 25 mph but died down in morn. At 9pm strong, gusty Santa Ana winds began up to 42 mph at 11:45pm. Hit 48mph at Sandberg
- 9-Santa Ana winds continued all morn until 7am.
- 11-Baro fell rapidly from 30.15" at 1am yesterday to 29.80" by 11pm tonite (.35" in 46 hrs.)
- 12-Pressure continued to fall down to 29.59" at 8pm. At 6pm Santa Ana winds came up following very weak and dry cold front passage in morn. Hit 67 mph at 10:53pm with a temp of 37°--COLD. Coldest since Ap. 2. The baro reading was lowest on record for this station and since Dec., 1959.
- 13-Very strong Santa Ana (cold type) continued all nite and into morn causing some damage in area and at station. At 7:30am temp fell to 31°, coldest Dec. reading on my records and coldest since Ap. 11, 1965. Had $\frac{1}{4}$ " ince on small water surface. As winds continued all day up to 50mph high was only 37°, coldest high ever on my records-- in clear sky too! Occurred at 1pm. To SE of here area had snow above 500 foot elevation with Hemet-3", Fallbk-6", Sun City-3" and San Delgo-T". Shallow water froze over thinly after 6:30pm Wind cont'd gusty to 55mph at 11pm. Became dry with humid of 8% and dewpt of -17° at 9pm. This was the lowest dewpt I've ever recorded. Was very cold in mtns and deserts with Baldy +6°/-2° and Wrightwood +16°/+11°, Big Pines 16°/+2°, ^{Tajunga-42/33, Rosadena-49/38, Mt. Wilson 19/11, Palmdale 34/23, Daguerre 38/30, Independence 39/14}
- 14-Strong, cold Santa Ana continued all nite and into morn. Had the coldest Dec. temp I've recorded and coldest since Jan. 13, 1963 with Off. 29° at 7am. A pan 3" deep with water had ice $\frac{5}{8}$ " thick. Winds continued to 50mph at times all day. Deserts reported snow most of day. High was only 38° at 11am Baro fell to new low of 29.51" at 3pm. Up to 12" of new snow fell in mtns mainly on east slopes from Wrightwood south. Was cold too with Baldy +6°/-6° Big Bear +15°/-4° Arrowhd +19°/+12° Wrightwood +16°/+10°. Went down to 18° at Redlands and 25° at Santa Barbara, a record. ^{Started to snow at Acton at 4pm on 8° Temp went down to +15° at Red Box this morn. 8:14pm Mt. Wilson had 1" snow today}
- 15-Lite and warmer Santa Ana winds cont'd all nite. At 5pm yesterday temp was 33° and continued to rise all nite. At 8am was 38°. Highest wind gusts were around 30 mph. Winds ceased after 5pm. At 7pm a increase in Ac from 1 brought very lite rain shower until 9pm of .T". Temp was 43° then. Mod snow fell all day in deserts with 12" Barstow, 4" Mojave and 14" 29Palms, ^{Tale Mt-4" Sandberg-2" Little Rock Dam-4" Acton-6" Palmdale-4" Valhalla-4" Mono-4" Bishop-6" Independence-23/14 Mojave 38/25 Palmdale 38/23 Valhalla 38/20}
- 16-Heavy cu mass of day produced sprinkles after 6:30pm to 10:30pm of .T", then cleared.
- 18-At 6:30am began to sprinkle from approaching front with rain beginning at 7:30am. Increased to mod rain at times until stopped and clouds broke at 12:30pm with .95". At 4:30pm had a brief shower of .01" more for .96" total. Was a cold rain with temp between 41°-47°. The low of 41° was warmest in 7 days. Sprinkled some after 10pm. Snow fell on Lukens above 5000'

- 19-Showered all nite with .17" more by 8am. Could see snow down to 3500' level on Lukens. At 9:45am a storm moved in with mod hail storm of pea-sized covering ground then at 10am began to SNOW, mod at times, until 10:30am but only covering ground briefly with .T". At 10:45am had another brief flurry. Stuck on Verdugos above 2500' and on Lukens above 2200'. Temp fell from 42° at 9am to 36° in snowstorm. Snow receded rapidly back to 3500' level on Lukens after partial clearing after noon. Was first snow since Ap.11 of this year. Was first snow ever to fall at station in month of December. Continued heavy snow fell in mtns, mainly above 5000' with 18" new. Baddy this morn had total of 2 to 3 feet with 28" in last 24 hrs. Blue Ridge-2-3' Kratka-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ '. Rain during day, between 9:45am and 11:45am totaled .15" for .32" day total and 1.28" storm total. Briggs had total of 1.40". Pickens Dam-1.38" Big 7 Dam had $\frac{1}{2}$ " snow up and Clear Cr- $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Red Box-8"; Little Rock Dam-1"; Acton-4"; H.T. Wilson-11"; Val Vermo-1"; Llano-Palmdale-1"; Bishop-4"; Independence- $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 20-Had a mod frost in morn with some ice on water surfaces with low of 32°. Snow on Lukens receded on this side to 4500'. Baro rose rapidly during day from 29.68" to 30.00". Past 29.75" for first time since 11am, Dec.12 and past 30" for first time since 3am, Dec.11 (over 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ days). A ranger drove to Lukens summit at 11:30pm & reported 6" on ground of snow.
- 21-Had a very lite frost in morn with Off. 34°. Snow receded on Lukens to 4800' Was cold elsewhere with -4° Big Bear and +11° Arrowhead and -4° Bishop (a record)
- 22-Snow receded off Lukens with low here of 35°. Baro went up to 30.29" at 9am.
- 23-Had warmest day since Nov. 26 with Off. 73°.
- 24-Had the warmest morn since Nov. 20 with Off 54°. Had warmest day since Nov. 15 with Off. 76°. Santa Ana wind began at 7pm.
- 25-Warm, lite Santa Ana winds rose temp to 69° at 4am but ceased after that. Was warmest Christmas day on stations records and since 1956.
- 26-Had the warmest day since Nov. 15 with Off. 78°.
- 29-Had a fog in early morn.

- 3-Had a frost in morn with low of Off. 39°.
- 6-Had a lite Santa Ana come up in evening to 16 mph.
- 10-A brief sprinklle occurred around 4am of .01" from approaching storm. At 11am began to sprinkle occassionally with .04" more by 5pm or .05" total. Had occassional fog too. Had .15" total by midnt. High for day occurred at 11pm.
- 11-Drizzled off and on in early morn with showers ending and clearing after 3am with .01" more or storm total of .16". Glen-.09", LA-.08", LA airport-.18", wettest spot Mt. Wilson-.30" *by 4:58"*
- 13-Had the warmest day in 17 days with Off. 72°.
- 17-Had a frost in morn with Off. 41°.
- 18-Baro went up to 30.31" at 11am, highest baro reading in a year.
- 20-Had the warmest day since Dec. 26 with Off. 78°.
- 22-Lite Santa Ana came up fter 8pm to 36 mph at 10:35pm. Rained temp from 61° to 67° at 10pm.
- 23-Lite Santa Ana continued into morn. Had the warmest morn since Oct. 18 with Off. 62°. Had the warmest day since Nov. 14 with Off. 80°. Had low humid of 19% at 7pm.
- 26-Turned cold due to broken Cu. cover all day with coolest high since Jan. 10 with Off. 55°. Clouded up in afternoon and started to sprinkle at 4:45pm with .T" by 5pm. Had lite intermittent rain all evening with .14" by midnt. Had gusty SE winds most of day to 17 mph. Baro went dn to 29.85" at 5pm.
- 27-Rained intermittently through nite with a brief heavy shower from 3:05-3:15s of .08". Had total of .33" by 8am. Alternating sun then rain continued all day until mod rain began at 4:10pm with .16" more by 5pm or total of .49". Had coldest high since Dec. 20 with Off. 48°. Had occassional fog too in early morn. Mod rain ended at 6:15pm (.39" in 2hrs.) with sprinkles lasting until began to clear at 8pm, becoming clear by 10pm. Had .29" more since 5r for storm total of .78". Temp fell rapidly to 36 by 11pm. Snow fell on Lukens, dn to 4000' with up to *48"* in mtns. *LA-.47", Glen-.59", La Cus-.94", Baldy Mt. -3.30", Opal-2.31", MT. Wilson-1.95", Tujunga-1.17", Palmdale-.26"*
- 28-Had a mod frost in morn with low of Off. 33°.
- 29-Had a mod frost in morn with low of Off. 35°.
- 30-Had a frost in morn with low of Off. 36°. Clouded up in evening with lite rain beginning at 11pm with .02" by midnite.
