DECEMBER '68

- 1-Had gusty NW winds following dry front passage to 40 mph. Had coldest morn since May 14 with Off. 43°
- 2-With some areas getting very strong Santa Ana in PM, none blew at this station.
- 3-At 5am a brief Santa Ana blew raising temp 10°. At 10am baro hit 30.30". Official baro at Van Nuys hit 30.139"
- 11-At 12:15am a lite rain began lasting until 3:15am with total of .19". In morn had fog with vis at 200 feet. At 8am NW winds came up hitting 34 mph in even. LA-.09", Burbk-.15", Glen-.12", Baldy-.65"
- 12-Low of 41° was coldest since May 14.
- 14-Started to sprinkle from approaching weak storm at 4:30pm with T" by 5pm, then ending soon after.
- 15-At midnite had a lite rain shower until 12:45am of .02". No significant rain fell then until 7am with .08" more by 8am when let up to occasional mist with sunny periods. Had occasional lite showers during day with .02" more by 5pm or total of .12". Clouds then broke some.
- 16-At 2:45am lite rain began again with .24" more by 8am and .01" more by time clouds cleared at 10am for two day storm total of .37". LA-.22", Pasadena-.36", Chatsworth-.46", LA Cresc.-.25", Palmdale-.12", Wilson-.49", Glen-.35", Baldy-1.00"
- 17-Had the FIRST FROST OF YEAR with low of 37°. Coldest since March 18.
- 19-Fifth day of cold temps brought the coolest high in exactly 1 year when it snowed here. Hit 47° at 2pm.
- 20-First snow of season fell on Lukens down to 3000' as well as above 3000' on Verdugos. Fell at 4:30am very litely until 6am with .03" by 8am in 39° temp. Snow fell in upper desert from Palmdale to Barstow until 1pm. At 11:30am began to SNOW at station off and on until 12:45 pm but never stuck long. High of 43° at noon in snow was coldest high since Dec.14, 1967. By 10pm dog water had ice on it with temp of 33°. Lite snow fell also but did not stick in Pasadena, Palso Verdes and parts of San Ferdn valley. Snow stuck in Glendora (el. 800') 1" and Alta Loma (el. 1400') 2". Mtn areas ranged from 4" Baldy to 16" Holiday Hill. Gusty N winds hit 46 mph in PM.
- 21-Had the coldest temp I've ever recorded with low of Off. 27° at 7am. Was below freezing from 1am to 8:30am. Had ice 3/8" thick on dog's water pan. Had a very lite frost too. Was very cold elsewhere with lows of; Arrowhd +8°, Baldy Notch -4°, Palmdale +9°, Big Bear -4°, Tram -3°, Wrightwood +7°, Crestline +10°, LA airport +32°, Glendale +30°, Riverside +17°, Wilson +18° and Apple Valley +3°, Tujunga +25°, Pasadena +28°, Sandberg +17°, Avalon +37°, Burbk +26°
- 22-Had a very lite frost with low of 33°
- 24-Started to sprinkle off and on from approaching storm at 9:30pm with .01" by midnite. Was very stormy in northern Calif. with record low elev. snow-falls with 23" Redding. Shasta Dam -18", Shasta City -36" (in last days)
- 25-Had the first rain on Xmas Day since 1959 and heaviest on records. Had .10" total by 8am in occ'l drizzle. Increased after 11am becoming mod rain from 1:30 to 2:15pm with front passage. Stopped and clouds broke some after 2:30pm with .71" total by 5pm. Had occ'l fog in afternoon too. From 8:15 to 9:30pm had a shower of .10".
- 26-Had lite rain in early morn from 4:15 to 7:15am of .19" then skies cleared some. Gusty NW winds came up in afternoon. Snow fell down to 4,600' on Lukens and 4000' on San Gabriels with up to 14" new at Baldy. Had total of 1.00" rain here. Baro went down to 29.64" at 2pm. LA Cres-1.02", Glen-.42", Burbk-.41", LA-.91", Baldy-2.05", Wilson-1.15", Palmdale-.45", Arrowhd-2.67"

JANUARY '69

- 2-Had a lite Santa Ana in even to 25 mph.
- 3-Lite Santa Ana came up in early afternoon dropping humid to 23% at 4pm. High of 81° made it the warmest Jan temp in 2 yrs. High of 89° at Long Beach was nations hot spot.
- 4-Santa Ana incre. in morn hitting 41 mph. Had the warmest Jan. morning on stations records and warmest since Oct. 27 with Off. 63°--low for day of 61° was at 11pm.
- 5-With high of 81°, missed being nations hot spot by 7° held by Northridge.
- 8-Had a fog in morn.
- 13-Started to sprinkle from approaching storm at 8am occasionally. Began to have steady lite rain after 1pm with .07" by 5pm. Rain incre. during evening becoming mod. at times with 1.00" by midnite. Had occ'ly fog too.
- 14-Rain conti., mod. at times, until stopped at 7:15am with .92" more or total of 1.92". A fog moved in in morn too. Remained cloudy rest of day but no rain. Glen-1.48", LA-1.46", La Cres-1.87" Burbank-1.14", Cp Baldy-1.76", Palmdale-.21". Snow fell above 8000' *with 1" at Baldy.*
- 15-Lite shower around 5:30am produced .03" rain.
- 18-Started to rain from approaching storm at 12:45pm with .20" by 5pm along with fog. Rainfall conti. into evening with .85" by midnite total.
- 19-Lite rain conti. until early morn becoming misty at times with total of 1.3" by 8am and incre. some around 11am with .34" more by 1pm or 1.68" total. Had occ'l fog too. Had gusty SE winds in afternoon to 26 mph. Had .20" more by 5pm for 1.88" total so far. Had .43" more by 10pm or 2.36" total and 2.58" total by midnite for 1.73" for today. Was warm storm with snow level 7000'.
- 20-At 12:10am mod to heavy rain began lasting until 2:20am with .72" in this 2 hr 10 min period. Slackened off some but had another mod shower at 6am & by 8am had total of 3.64". Rain let up to occ'l showers during morn but 11:11am rain began again after 12:30pm and a heavy rain fell from 4:30-4:50pm of .28" in 10 min. by 5pm had storm total of 4.62". Had occ'l fog too making this month the foggiest Jan on stations records. Heavy rain fell all over area with 8.87" at San Luis Obispo in 15 hrs this morn. LA had 5.05" total by 5pm. In evening gusty SE winds came up along with heavy fog (vis. 300') and occ'l mod rain and hit .36 mph at 10:30pm. At 11:05 pm mod-heavy rain began with storm total of 5.85" by midnite or days total of 3.27"
- 21-Heavy rain fell from midnite to 12:30am when nearly stopped. At 1:45am mod to heavy rain began and conti. until 6:35am with 2.94" falling. By 8am had storm total of 9.09". Clouds broke some at 9am but occ'l brief mod showers during day produced .47" more by 5pm for storm total of 9.56". Had occ'l sprinkles after. In early morn and morning had very strong SW winds to about 40mph. Had 11.51" so far this month. The wettest mo. since Nov., 1968 and second wettest on my records. We have had $\frac{1}{2}$ " more rain than fell all last year. At 11:30pm a mod rain began with .10" additional by midnite for days total of 3.81".
- 22-Mod to heavy rain fell from midnite on but let up some until stopped at 8:30 when cleared some from NW. Had 1.83" during nite by 8am or 11.43" total for storm. Had another sprinkle around 10-11am when skies partly cleared. Had no rain rest of day. At 5pm had .04" more in morn or storm total of 11.47"

Rainfall was a all time record of 27.38" or 25" above normal. Days of measurable rainfall tied for most days and was 10 days above normal. Temp av 2° below normal but coolest av high on stations records. Was foggiest Jan on station records being 6 days above normal. Was foggiest mo since Dec, 1964.

- 22 (conti) Snow finally fell in local mtns above 6000' up to 24" at Big Bear. Storm totals: Camp Hill-21.81", Switzers-13.65", Baldy-20.08", Chantry Flats-16.03", LA-6.80", La Cres-11.96", Glen-8.04", Glendale-1.96", Lancaster-1.50", Chilao-9.30", MT. Wilson-16.64".
- 23-Started to rain from new storm approaching at 3:30pm with .04" by 5pm and about .46" total by midnite.
- 24-Rain continued all nite and into morn with .65" more by 8am or total of 1.11". Rain continued all day from drizzle to mod. with 1.09" more by 5pm for total of 2.20". Had occ'l fog too. Rain became mod in late evening with 3.80" total by midnite or day total of 3.34". Bishop had 12 1/2" of snow today - 24th in.
- 25-All of this rain showed its effect today as the worst storm since 1938 in southern California, brought mod to heavy rain all in early morning. Between midnite and 7am had 8.22". Between 6am-7am had .89". During this time disastrous mud slides occurred in area with 100 people dead. Several dams went over spillways and Big T Wash went over Foothill Blvd and changed its course below them (bridges). Almost all trees were washed away upstream. Big T. Rd above the second bridge was washed completely away in two places. Many people were marooned everywhere. All rail service out of LA was washed out. Worst of storm was felt between San Juan Cap. and Lompoc. Rain continued all morning and slackened some after 2pm and became sprinkles after 4:30pm with storm total by 5pm so far of 10.72". We have now had 23.31" this month. A all time record for this area in La Crescenta for one month in records dating back to 1934. Had gusty SW winds in morn to 40 mph along with occ'l fog all day. Rained during evening from very lite to briefly mod with total by midnite of 11.09" or 8.59" for day. Heaviest 24 hr. state fell at Little Creek P.S. w/ 21.61" Other 24 hr. totals: Camp Hill-15.56", Baldy Patch-13.45", Arrowhead-11.96", even Death Valley had .16". Another 11" of snow fell at Bishop - two day total 5 times year total.
- 26-Rained during nite from periods of drizzle to briefly heavy rain with total of 12.10" by 9:15am or 1.01" since midnite. Rain incre. some with brief heavy showers along with very thick fog with vis. down to 150 feet and blowing from south to 35 mph. Had .90" more rain by noon or storm total of 13.00". Skies lifted and rain stopped except for occ'l sprinkles after 2:30pm. At 5pm had storm total of 13.62" or .62" since noon. Clouds broke to west and south but remained cloudy here. Had an apparent frontal passage at 1:30pm. Finally cleared around 7pm--first time in weeks.
- 27-Had a frost in morn with low of 37°. Was first day with no rain in 10 days
- 28-Had a mod. frost in morn with low of 35°. Clouded up rapidly in morn and at 11:45am rain began from storm moving in from west. At 12:30pm a thunderstorm began and lasted 20 minutes. At 12:45pm snow began to fall for 10 minutes but didn't stick here but above 3000' on Lukens. Temp fell to 38°. Storm moved east and rain ended about 1:15pm with .19" falling. At 3pm another brief thunderstorm moved over, mainly to south with lightning hitting a house in Glendale. Had .10" more by time broke at 3:30pm. Had .29" total by 5pm. At 5:45pm had another .05" rain by 6:30pm as clouds broke again. Was a very cold day with high of 46°, coolest since Dec. 20. This was first snow to fall at station during mo of Jan. Glen-.46", For month of Jan.: LA had 14.94" (highest total for a month since Jan, 1889), La Cres-27.15", La Canada-28.60", Gregg-27.38", Briggs-29.46", Glendale-17.11", Baldy Patch-59.70", Little Creek-21.61", MT. Wilson-37.52".
- 29-Had a mod frost in morn along with 1/8" ice on dogs water with low of 32°. Was coldest Jan temp since 1964. Was first clear day in 22 days. Went on to 40° at MT. Wilson.
- 30-Had a mod frost in morn with low of 34°. Was +2° at Bishop - coldest Jan. in 5 yrs.
- 31-Baro went up to 30.17" at 10am. Highest reading for month but lowest for any Jan. on stations records.

FEBRUARY '69

- 1-Had gusty W winds occ'lly to 38 mph.
- 3-Lite Santa Ana in early morn kept temp in mid 50s (20° above previous days). At 5pm had humid of 34%. High of 71° was month's high. This was coldest high for any month on stations records. Baro went up to 30.12" at 9am.
- 4-Started to sprinkle around 10pm with T" by midnite.
- 5-General rain began at 1pm with series of thunderstorms (first for Feb since 1962) moving over between 5:15 to 6am with closest at ½ mile at 5:35am. Rain ended and skies broke at 6:45am with .97" total by 8am. At noon had lite rain or sprinkles until 1:30pm with .04" more for storm total of 1.01" at 5pm. Up to 6" new snow fell above 4500'. At 6pm sprinkles and lite rain began again from approaching storm along with gusty SE winds to 25 mph. *Barbark-.94", Glen-.90" LA-.26", Palmdale-.09" & Baldy Notch-2.85"*
- 6-General rain began at midnite with heavy rain at 3:50am as front passed over along with NW winds to 47 mph. In 5 min. had .24". At 4:30am rain ended & skies broke. At 8am had storm total of 2.03". Mod rain fell between 8:20am and 8:45am. Had another shower around 10:45am then another mod rain between 10:10-20pm then showered until 3pm. Had occ'l sunny periods and gusty W wind. By 5pm had storm total of 2.47" or .44" since 8am. Heavy snow fell above 5000' with up to 36" in Big Bear. Water-30", Tram-54". Glendale-1.68", La Cres.-2.20". Had 3.48" of rain so far this mo. which is the wettest Feb since 1963. *Palmdale-1.03", Big T. Run-4.24", Ep Colby-4.63" Bishop had 7½" of snow today & Independence-4½"*
- 7-Had a mod frost in morn with low of 37°.
- 11-Had a fog in morn.
- 12-Sprinkled around 6am with .02" by 8am from storm that was forecast to produce 3" of rain. Had a few more sprinkles around 1pm of T".
- 13-Had a lite frost in morn with low of 38°. Baro went down to 29.67" at 5am.
- 14-Started to sprinkle around 6pm-until 7pm with T" by midnite.
- 15-Sprinkled off and on during morn with occ'l lite rain beginning at 6:30am with .07" by 8am. Had frontal passage around 4pm with clouds breaking after 4:30pm and rain ending. Had total of .58" by 5pm. Had a few brief sprinkles around 5:30pm of .01". Cleared after 6:30pm. Had occ'l fog too. At 7pm could see lightning over LA who had .96" for storm. Snow fell mainly above 6000' with 4-8" new. High for day occurred at 1am as temp stayed at 46° all day until cleared. *Glen-.82", Barbark-.33", Palmdale-0" & Baldy-1.50"*
- 16-Had a frost in morn with low of 37°.
- 17-Had a sprinkle around 10pm of T" as weak storm approached.
- 18-Lite rain began at 1am with .38" by 8am, continued until broke at 11:30am then had showery weather with storm total of .61" by 5pm. Snow fell above 4600' on Lukens. At 6:30pm had a pea-sized hail storm of 5 min. briefly covering ground. At 7:05pm slushy hail fell again for 10 min along with thunderstorm to NE moving away by 7:20pm and dropping temp to day's low of 3°. Closest lightning was ½ mile NE. Hail was first for Feb on stations record. Rain ended by 8:30pm. Had storm total by 10pm of .91"
- 19-Sprinkled in early morn occ'lly with .01" more by 8am. After 10am sprinkle conti with lite rain briefly around noon. In Glendale at same time mod rain fell for an hour. Skies broke some at 3pm but occ'l sprinkles conti. Had .03" during day or storm total of .95". Mtns. had up to 2 feet on new snow with some 5 foot depths.

- 20-Had a few showers in early morn but cleared around 3am with .04" during nite or storm total of .99" Had a lite frost in morn with low of 38°.
- 21-Started to rain from another approaching storm at 8:45pm. In last 40 days have had 25 with rain--Unbelievable! Rain was mod at times along with gusty SE winds to 21 mph. Had .68" by midnite. At 10:40pm had a lite thunderstorm until 11:15pm with closest lightning at 1½ miles. At 11:30pm had apparent frontal passage with temp dropping rapidly to 36° with SNOW flurries mixed with rain but not sticking at station.
- 22-Rain stopped around 12:30am with few showers in early morn. Had storm total of .80" by 8am. Snow stuck above 2400' on Verdugos and 2600' on Lukens. At 6pm a few sprinkles fell of T". Glen-.70", LA-.53", Pas-.76", Newport Bch-1.08"
- 23-New storm began in early morn with very lite rain incre after 8am becoming mod to briefly heavy after 1pm with total of 2.21" by 5pm. Had occ'l fog to This rain total made this Feb the wettest on stations records. Had gusty SE winds prior to frontal passage at 5pm then shifted to NW to 15 mph. Observer was at beach in early afternoon had had SE gusts to 37 mph. Heavy snow fell above 4500' with many people marooned and some buried by avalanche. Baldy-3½ ft. new. Rain conti. until 9pm when just sprinkled after.
- 24-Rain began again, heavy at times after 3:30am with storm total of 3.39" by 8 am or 3.97" during nite. On again-off again, rain briefly heavy fell all day with 1.03" more by 5pm or storm total of 4.46" Had gusty SE winds to 40 mph also. Had occil fog. Had 1.28" more by midnite.
- 25-Heavy rain fell all nite along with occ'l fog with 2.97" more by 8am or total of 8.71". Between 1:45am and 3:45am had 1.11" Floods occurred all over so. Calif. Silverado Cany was washed out. Big T washed the Foothill bridges out. Ventura Cty's roads were out and marina also. Rain let up during morn stopping between 10:30am and 3:30pm when lite rain began again with .23" during day by 5pm or total of 8.94". Had occ'l sprinkles in evening of .01" as skies broke. For storm: Glen=4.86", LA-3.74", Arrowhd-21.00", Pasa-5.85", Palmdale-3.05" Snow fell above 5800' and heavy snow above 6000 with Hol Hill-7 ft., Table-6 ft., Grn Valley-10 ft. Up north Mammoth-26 ft., Yosemite-24 ft with 4 ft. on valley, Squaw Valley-30 ft. *In last 4 days Bishop has had 19" of snow*
- 28-Had a lite frost in morn with low of 37°. At noon, began to sprinkler with rain beginning at 2pm. Had .27" by 5pm. Had occ'l lite fog too. Rain let up until had frontal passage around 6:30pm with rain ending and skies breaking by 9pm for storm total of .32". In Glen and LA heavy rain fell during frontal passage with .34" between 6-7pm at LA. I had .04" during same period. Totals; LA-.64", Glen-.54"
