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Rainfall was 1 1/3" below normal, the driest April since 1979. Average high was warmest on record for April and 4 above normal. Av. low was normal. Temp difference was a April record and 31 below average Highest av. max. wind for April was a record high and highest for amy month since Dec, 1982. Was clearest April on record.
