- 1-Santa Ana winds hit 28 mph just after midnite then ending.
 5-Low of 49 was warmest morn since Dec.11 and hi of 74 was warmest day since Nov.11. Hit 78 at LA, Santa Ana and Santa Monica Pier, the nation hot spot Pasadena was 73 and Burbk 74. Lancaster go up to only 47.
 6-Low of 55 was warmest morn since Nov.11. Increased Ac deck during day produced a few showers in some areas but nothing here except the coolest day in over a week. Beaumont-T", Borrego-.01" and Palomar-.16"
 7-Had occ'l drizzle or lite rain after 1am to 5am of .04". Stayed cloudy all day with only a 48 high with showers again after 4pm with .08" storm total by 5pm. At 5:30 moderate rain began until ended at 6:30pm with occ'l show after and storm ending by 11:30pm with .39" more or .47" storm total. La Crea Office-.53", hill-.45E", LA-.24", LAX-.16", Woodld Hills-.21", Beaumont-.8 Mt. Wilson-.85", Big Bear-.90", Lancaster-.11", Plm Sprs-.12", RMRC-.38", Borreg-.42", San Deigo-.16" with 2.56" at Palomar Obser. Mountains had 3" 5" new snow above 6,000'. Temp-difference of only 2 was lowest for Jan. since 1980.
 10-Rapid moving weak front went over in early morn with .01" at 3am. Office-.01", hill-.01", Wldd Hills-.19", Avalon-.15", Pasadena-.1" with other areas getting nothing to a trace. La Crea-T"
 12-In early morn hours Santa Ana winds increased rapidly up to 97 mph at time unknown as power went out just past 5am until 3pm. Winds eased during day. Was alot of damage in many areas with trees down, roofs off and even truck blown over in Ontario where airport reported 65 mph. Totalizing aneometer lost a cup.

- 13-Santa Ana winds ended by daybreak after hitting 35 mph at 5am.
 16-Warm offshore winds hit northern Calif. coast today with nation hot spot at Shelter Cove with 78°, was 75° at Arcata and 70° Eureka.
 20-Fog in morn with visi. at 500 feet.
 23-Hottest place in US today was Vista (San Deigo Cty) and Monrovia with only 69°. Was 63° here.
 28-At just before 8am lite rain showers began, first moisture in 18 days. It has now rained on 6 of last 7 January 28ths. Increased some during day with breaks after 4:45pm with .33" and .01" more when ended at 5:30pm for .34" storm total. High of 46° was coolest high since Mar, 1982 and coolest Jan high since 1979. Office-.34", hill-.34", LA-.47", Pasadena-.29", Wld Hills-.43", Beaumont-.84", Mt. Wilson-1.04", Big Bear-.58", Lancaster-.17", Plm Sprs-.01", RMRC-.04", San Deigo-.27" and Julian-1.42" *La Cres-.34"*
 29-Low of 37° was coolest Jan. in 3 yrs. Was 39° Burbk, 23° Mt. Wilson and -2° Big Bear.
 30-Had gusty north winds after 7am up to 31 mph at 12:30p. Conti cold with 38° this morn including Pasadena with 22° at Mt. Wilson and 5° at Big Bear. Showers hit areas to south in morn with .02" Beaumont, .03" San Deigo and .16" Julian.
 31-Low of 35° tied Jan record low and was coldest temp for any month since Jan 1982. To find a colder temp one goes back to Dec. 1978. Went down to 37° at Burbk, 38° Pasadena, 28° Beaumont, 18° Yucca Vly and -4° Big Bear with a 30 high. The Grand Cyn hit -23° this morn (a all-time record) and was -18° Ely and -36° West Yellowstone. Eureka, Calif ended up with .65" rain this mont driest January ever (1889). *Normal is 7" Klamath had .87" with 15" normal.*

1-Continued cold with a 36° low, tying the Feb. record. Was 34° Pasadena, 38° Burbk, 28° Beaumont, 29° Plm Sprs, 24° Mecca, 26° RMRC, 39° LAX, 22° Daggett, 26° Thermal and 0° at Big Bear. Maybell, Colorado in NW corner of State reported a -62°, a State Record.

2-Lite rain began just before 5am and ended at 9am with .26" falling. Was a cold storm with lite snow above 3,500 ft. on local mtns which melted off in afternoon. From 10:30-12:30pm RMRC had SNOW with T" sticking. Plm Sprs had snow too with 2" at Cyn Country Club along with snow falling at Needles and Blythe and 3" on ground at Lake Havasu City. Observer was at Las Vegas which had snow in early morn and a days high of only 35°. Road on Mountain Pass was closed due to snow above 3,000' all the way to Barstow. Yucca Vly area highway was closed with 2" on ground. Daggett's high was 33°, Needles 40°, Blythe 43° and the 44° at Thermal was a record for the coldest high ever. RMRC reached 41°. Rain totals included; office-.17", hill-.27", Pasa-.27", Wld Hills-.25", Beaumont-.11", LA-.30", Lancaster-T", Plm Sprs-.17", RMRC-.28", Mt. Wilson-1.19", Big Bear-.15", San Deigo-.31" & Palomar-1.02" with 9" snow on ground.

3-Low of 34° was coldest temp since Dec., 1978 and coldest Feb temp for station. Had first frost since Jan., 1982. Went down to 38° Burbk, 32° Pasadena, 29° Wld Hills, 39° LA and 20° Mt. Wilson. Needles high today was only 46° with Plm Sprs at 49° and RMRC 50°.

4-At 8am had a brief lite shower of T" but were heavier to south with .13" Newport Bch, .14" San Deigo, .40" Cuymaca Park with 11" snow and 19" snow at Palomar. San Deigo reported a tornado that hit a trailer park. Was cold everywhere with -17° at Alturas and -45° West Yellowstone. Palm Sprs

- high was only 49° and Big Bear with a T" of snow went from +3° to +29°. Low here was 39°. Gusty NE winds came up at 9am hitting 30 mph at noon and died down after 9pm. Low in 30s was 3rd day this month in 30s, a Feb. record.
- 5-Went down to 35° here, only 1 shy of record low for month set 2 days ago. Went down to -6° at Big Bear, coldest temp since Feb., 1979. Was 39° LA, 25° Beaumont, 34° Burbk, 35° Pasadena, 17° Mt. Palomar and 15° Mt. Laguna. Elsewhere went down to -23° Grand Cyn south rim, -21° Flagstaff, +4° Prescott, -17° Gallup and -4° Cedar City.
- 7-Had 5th day in a row of temps in 30s with 39°. This is 6th day this month of 30° temps, tying station record for any month set in Jan. 1979 and Dec. 1978. This also ties a record of most number of 30 days in a year with 9 set in 1979.
- 8-Started to drizzle from approaching storm after 10am with lite rain after 3pm with .04" by 5pm. Became steady after 6:30pm, increasing some after 11:30pm with .83" total so far by midnite. Had occ'l fog in evening. Av wind speed of only 0.29 mph was lowest for any Feb and since Nov., 1982. In Sierras, Blue Cyn had 42" snow in 24 hrs, a Feb record. Emigrant Gap had 54" in 28 hrs and 36" at Tahoe. All roads were closed.
- 9-Moderate rain fell until 3am with let up and storm ended at 8:30am with 1.11" since midnite or 1.94" storm total. Had 1.81" in 12 hrs (6p-6am) and 1.37" in 6 hrs (9p-3am). Snow line was high at about 7,000' with 2" at cabin. office-1.72", hill-1.83", LA-2.53", LAX-1.48", Pasadena-1.56", World Hills-1.02", Beaumont-1.30", Mt. Wilson-2.59", Big Bear cabin-.17", Lancaster-T" Big Bear-.38", RMRC-.02", San Deigo-.23", Borrego-T" & Mt. Laguna-.38"
- 11-High of 75° was warmest in 3 months (Nov. 11). LA was nation hot spot with 81°. Was 80° LAX, 76° Pasadena, 75° Burbk and 55° Big Bear. Plm Sprs hit 71° with 73° RMRC and 63° Death Vly.
- 12-Low of a warm 50° was warmest in a month. High hit 79°, tying max of 3 months ago and one had to go back to Oct. 13 to find a warmer day. LA again was nation hot spot with 85°. Was 80° Burbk, 81° Lg Bch, 83° Pasadena, 81° Sta Maria and after weeks of cold hit 70° at Bishop and 53° Tahoe. Humidity went down to 17% in afternoon.
- 13-Santa Ana winds came up after 2am to 22 mph at 5:15am and ended by 9am. Low of 59° was warmest morn since Nov. 4 and the high of 84° was warmest since Oct. 13. Was also the 2nd warmest Feb temp for station (8yrs) and since 1980. Was just 2° shy of tying record. Just back of Feb. 10 was 38° here. LA again was nation hot spot with 90°. LAX hit 85° with 85° Burbk and 86° Pasadena. Hit 89° Ontario and Plm Sprs, 82° San Deigo and 83° Sta Maria. Santa Ana came up again at 3pm up to 21 mph and ended at 11:15pm. Lag Peak near Ventura had NE winds at 7am to 69 mph. RMRC had month's high with 90°.
- 14-High was only 1° shy of tying Feb record set 4 years ago with a 85°. Mild Santa Ana blew occ'lly in early morn hours up to 17 mph at 1:15am. Hit 90° again in LA and 85° LAX, Burbk and Pasadena. Santa Ana had 90° and the end of the Santa Monica Pier hit 81°. Avalon was 80°. Plm Sprs was 87°.
- 15-Third day in row of 80° temps with 83°. Was 88° LA, 86° Pasadena, 84° Burbk, 81° LAX, 84° Sta Maria, 80° Mt. Wilson and at Big Bear, 63°, warmest Feb in 4 yrs. Plm Sprs was nation hot spot with 89° and was RMRC. Even with heat, local mtns had alot of snow above 5,000' in shade.
- 16-Big Bear high of 64° was warmest Feb. temp since 1980 and had to go to 1977 to find a warmer Feb. high. Low was 21°.
- 19-Fog in morn with visi. down to 200 ft.
- 20-Drizzle began in early morn with .03" by 8am becoming occ'l lite rain until ended and cleared after 11am with .07" total. After 2:30pm N to NE winds came up increasing to 49 mph at 8:38pm. Was windy everywhere particularly in deserts. In late afternoon rain showers hit Plmdale-Riverside-Plm Spr, El Centro and San Deigo areas. Baro fell all day to 29.66" at 4pm. LA-.01", Pasa-.06", office-.10", hill-.08", World Hills-.01", Lach-T", RMRC-.01", San Deigo-.08", Julia-.57", Big Bear-.17" and 2" snow and Tram-1" snow.
- 21-NE winds blew all nite up to 65 mph at 4:30am and up to 37 mph at 11:10am and died down.
- 27-Lite fog in morning. Clear days-8 Cloudy days-1 Partly Cloudy days-19 Days with frost-1 Days with fog-3 Days with NE winds-7
- Av. high was 1° above normal and av. low was 3° below. Rainfall was ½ of normal

- 2-Weak front passed over during day producing cloudy, cold, windy conditions but only a brief shower at 6pm of T". Was much more active to east and south with snow all day at Big Bear with 6-10" and at the Tram with 7". Snow fell quite low in mtns including Tejon and Cajon Passes and the Yucaipa-Beaumont area had an inch stick on ground above 2,500'. In San Deigo area Cuyumaca had 5" and 7" at Mt. Laguna. Rainfall totals in this area were mostly 0 or a trace with .02" Woodl'd Hills, .27" Beaumont, .25" Mt. Wilson, 1.03" Big Bear, T" Lancaster, Plm Sprs and RMRC. San Deigo had .26", Mt. Laguna-1.00 Cuyumaca-1.46" and Borrego-.13". Gusty NW winds blew all day up to 30 mph at 3:20pm, hit 40 mph at Bishop, 41 mph LAX, 55 mph Lag Peak, 35 mph Ontario 36 mph RMRC and 50 mph at Coachella. Observer was near Mecca and sand dust was so thick one could see only 1 car length.
- 3-Low of 36° was coldest March for station. Was 40° Burbk, 31° Woodl'd Hills, 22° Mt. Wilson and 37° RMRC was also a March record.
- 5-Low of 38° was 3rd time this month of temps in 30s, a station record. This was 13 th time this year already of temps in 30s. Nearly double the old record of 9° in 1979.
- 6-Around 3am shower moved over with .04" falling. A dusting a snow stuck above 4,500' locally. Office-.05", hill-.05", LA-.04", Woodl'd Hills-T", Pasadena-.08", Mt. Wilson-.14", Lancaster-T" and most other areas-0. Considerably more rain fell to north including a low snow level with snow at Ukiah and Red Bluff.
- 7-At 1am temp hit low of 39°, 5th day in a row of temps in 30s. For year so far 30° temps number 15 days. At 4:30am occ'l lite rain began in 43° temp with

- .17" by 8:15am as showers ended with a brief .01" more at 11:30am for .18" storm total. Office-.16", hill-.19", LA-.09", Pasa-.05", Woodl'd Hills-.19", Beaumont-T", Lancaster-.08", Mt. Wilson-.72", Simi-.34" and no rain in San Deigo area and deserts.
- 11-At 5am occ'l lite rain began along with occ'l fog with .07" by 7:16am as showers ended and skies broke. As in past storms, this was very spotty with many areas receiving nothing. Office-.07", hill-.12" (one of wet spots), Simi-.07", Mt. Wilson-.08" and LA-.07".
- 14-In afternoon could see dark clouds and snow showers to NE after 5pm. Sprinkles fell in Montrose. Was due to weak upper low causing towering cu.
- 18-Lite rain began at 7:30am from weak front ended generally by 9am with .16". Remained mostly cloudy tho with few showers then clouds darkened after noon with few showers and thunderstorm began at 1:15pm followed by heavy hail storm from 1:20-:35pm moving over from NW with 3/8" diameter hail covering ground 1/2" deep, even driveway up to house was slippery. Had many close lightning strikes as storm moved off to SE after 1:45pm with .36" rain in that short period. Hail was reported much deeper to NW in Verdugo Hills Golf Course area. Could see snow on ground down to 3,800'. Lite rain began again after 2:20pm with .02" more as cleared after 3pm for .57" storm total. Office-.18", hill-.47" (may have overflowed in hail), LA-.12", Pasa-.30", Woodl'd Hills-.10", Beau-.27", Avalon-.03", San Berdu-.41", Mt. Wilson-.66", Lancaster-.03" & San Deigo-.02". Pilots reported hail with tops of Cb to 26,000' and one 727 was hit by lightning. Mt. Wilson had 4" snow, Big Bear 3" and Tram-2". Gustly NW winds hit some areas with 40 mph at Thermal, 33mph Plm Sprs 41 mph Lancaster, 40 mph Hawthorne, 45 mph Pt Magu and 63 mph Lag Peak. ~~RMRC-40 mph~~
- 19-Low of 39° was 7th day this month of temps in 30's, tying last month's record number. Previous March record was 2 in 1982.
- 20-High of 74° was warmest day in 22 days.
- 21-Fog in morn with visi. down to 200 feet.
- 22-Occ'l lite fog in morn.
- 23-High of 80° was warmest day since Feb.15. Was 82° Pasadena and 84° LA.
- 24-Low of 53° was warmest morn since Feb.16.
- 26-Strong storm moved into No. Cal with snow down to 300 feet in places with ^{4"} Redding. Winds were strong too, up to 52 mph S.F., 58 mph Bishop, 71 mph Slide Mtn and at 6pm Tahoe Airport reported heavy snow, 33" and 35 mph wind. Pressures fell to 29.19" on Washington coast. *Mammoth airport-40mph*
- 27-Lite rain began at 12:30am letting up after 5am and becoming showery. Had .46" by 8am and .64" storm total as partially cleared after 1:30pm. Office-.54", hill-.67". 9-Had T" drizzle in early morn.

10-Cold day as upper low approached from NW. High of 56° was coolest afternoon since Mar. 27. At 6pm began to sprinkle with measurable rain beginning by 7pm. Had .12" by 9:30pm as rain became steady after 10:15pm. SE winds increased up to about 30 mph by 10pm. This storm caused heavy snow yesterday afternoon and today in Sierras with several feet reported in Tahoe area and 11" on ground in Reno.
