4-Rain began at 6pm, brief moderate at times and letting up after noon and becoming occ'l after 1pm with some breaks after 4pm. Had 1.35" by 5pm. Baro. fell from 29.93" at 9am to 29.76" at 9pm. Since 11am yesterday it has fallen from 30.17". A few more showers fell in evening.

5-Showers ended by 2am with .22" more since 5pm or 1.57" storm total. Snow stuck above 5,000' with 12" Big Bear and Tram and 8" Mt. Laguna. Office-1.12", Avalon-.95", Wld Hills-.75", Pasadena-1.87", Beaumont-1.84", Big Bear-1.48", Lancaster-.23", Death Vly-.13", Plm Sprs-.41", Borrego-0, San Deigo-1.26" and wet spot of 2.73" at Cuyamaca Park. Low of 41 was coolest morn since Mar.17. RMRC-.22"

6-Started to sprinkle after 1pm with lite rain after 2:15pm ending by 3:40pm but occ'l showers after with .27" by 5pm. Showers ended by 5:45pm with .03" more or .30" storm total. New snow stuck on Lukens down to 4,000'.

7-From 2 to 4am had .13" more for new storm total of .43". New storm totals were; LA-.27", LAX-.40", Pasa-.35", Wld Hills-.41", Beaumont-.40", Big Bear-.05", Lancaster-.11", Death Vly-.07", Plm Sprs-.17", Borrego-.09", RMRC-.14", San Deigo-.42" and wet spot at Cuyumaca Park again with 1.22"

8-Low of 40 was coolest day since Mar.17. Went down to 39 Pasadena, 23 Lncst. 17 Bishop, 15 cabin and 6 Big Bear. Was -5 Tahoe and -15 Mammoth.

9-Lag Peak at 7am hit 71 mph from Santa Ana winds but none here. Baro went up to 30.31" at 10am for month high.

11-High of 77 was warmest day since Dec.3.

14-Gusty NW winds belw from 3am to 9am up to 31 mph at 8:10am.

15-NW winds came up after 5:15am and shifted NE after 9am and increased. Clou and showers hit deserts with lite snow above 4,000' including just above Vegas. Thermal had .03". Wind hit 62 mph at 7:20pm with

- wind chill in teens as high as only 56°. This was strongest wind since Dec., 1985. Baro fell to 29.66" at 2pm. RMRC temps were a cold 50/32°.
- 16-Strong NE winds conti. all night up to 59 mph at 5:50am with wind chill at 0°. Let up some after 8am but hit 45 mph at 2:30pm. After 40 hours and 20 minutes of non-stop wind, wind ended at 9:35pm. Began again tho after 11pm. Low of 35° this morn tied the station record for Dec. and high of 53° was coolest high since Mar, 1986.. Was cold all over the SW with 39° Burbk, 36° Pasadena, 21° Beaumont, 7° cabin, 3° Big Bear, 37° San Deigo and Tuscon had snow with 38° high. High at cabin was only 18°. ~~Wind hit 70 mph @ Mt. Laguna.~~
- 17-NE wind ended, finally, at 2:15am after hitting 41 mph at 12:55am. Baro has risen to 30.08". Temp fell to 32°, second coldest temp ever for statio coldest Dec. ever by 3° and coldest temp since Dec. 8, 1978. Many local areas had ice this morning. Was 34° Pasadena, 33° Burbk, 36° LA, 12° Lancaster 36° San Deigo, 16° Paso Robles, 10° Mt. Laguna, 11° cabin, -13° Flagstaff with Tuscon 28/30° with 1" snow and Phoenix a cold 29/49°.
- 18-Baro rose to 30.29" at 9am.
- 19-NE winds suddenly came up just before 8pm and increased rapidly to 68 mph at 9:54pm. This is highest wind since Oct, 1985.
- 20-NE winds continued all nite up to 65 mph at 3:30am and ended at 9:30am. Av. wind speed for day of 8.48 mph was highest day since Oct, 1985.
- 22-Weak front passed over during day with no rain here but T" LAX, .03" Santa Ana and .05" Avalon. Strong winds hit deserts up to 60 mph at Daggett.
- 26-Low of 57° was warmest morn since Nov. 28 and high of 84° was warmest day since Nov. 12. Was only 1° shy of tying station record set last year.. Was 86° LA, 80° LAX, 84° Pasa, 86° Riverside, 80° Plm Sprs, 82° RMRC and 87° at Fallbrook, the nation hot spot. Was 63° at cabin.
- 27-Had a shower after 9pm from approaching weak storm ending before 10pm with T". Other areas were; Lg Bch-.02", Stana Ana-.12", Wld Hills-.01" Riverside-.17" and wet spot at Beaumont-.20" Big Bear had-.77"

- 5-Went up to 80°, was 80° at Pasadena & Burbank, 81° LA and nation hot spot at Pt. Magu with 83°. Baro went up to 30.26" at 10am.
- 6-Hit 82° here with 84° LAX, 81° Burbank, 83° Pasadena, 86° Newport Bch and Pt. Magu and nation hot spot at Santa Monica Pier with 89°. Was 81° Palm Sprs.
- 7-Low of 61° was warmest morn since Nov.12 and 3rd warmest Feb. morning in 10 years of records. Was 80° here with 80° Burbank, 83° LAX, 84° Newport Bch, 82° Santa Monica Pier, 85° Santa Maria, 81° Monterey and nation hot spot of 86° at Santa Ana. East to SE winds continued all day to 26 mph here at 12:45pm but stronger in other areas including a 38 mph at Beaumont.
- 9-Showers began at 6am occ'lly during day with T" by 5pm after which became rain with .10" by 7pm. After occ'l drizzle from 8:30pm to 10:45pm had a brief moderate shower of .17" in 5 minutes ending by 11pm with .33" storm total. Office-.26", LA-.17", Pasadena-.25", Wild Hills-.22", Santa Ana-.27" Avalon-.51"(wet spot), LAX-.09", Beaumont-.02", Big Bear-T" and deserts-0.
- 11-Very weak front went over in morn with sprinkles from 5-6am of .01". Most areas had nothing but with .01" office, T" LAX, .01" Northridge, .08" Long Beach, T" San Deigo and .14" Julian the wet spot.
- 12-Barometer went up to 30.26" at 11am.
- 13-Occ'l drizzle began at 6am and increased breaks after with .34" more or 1.20" storm total. Had occ'l fog all day. Totals; office-.66", LA-.60", LAX-.30", Northridge-.50", Beaumont-.28", Mt. Wilson-.70", Big Bear-T", deserts-0 with 1.30" Santa Barbara and .25" San Deigo. Heavier amounts fell to north with 2.66" San Fran, 4.72" Blue Cyn and 6.87" Kentfield. Mammoth had 41" of new snow.
- 14-Gusty NW winds came up at 12:30am to 4:30am up to 31 mph at 2:15am. Big Bear had .08"
- 15-Sprinkles to occ'l lite showers began around 7am with .01" at 8am. Ended by 3pm with .02"more or .03" storm total. Gusty NW winds came up at 7:30pm

- to 51 mph at 11:25pm. ^{Hit 70 mph Mt. Laguna} Rain totals; office-.01", LA-.01", LAX-.02", Northridge-.06", Beaumont-.02", Mt. Wilson-.07", Big Bear-.05" and deserts again 0 with San Deigo-.03" and wet spot Julian with .29".
- 17-North to NW winds continued all nite and day up to 49 mph at 2pm.
- 18-NW winds increased after noon and shifted and increased after 5pm to NE. Hit 69 mph at 10pm. In afternoon could see snow showers over mtns to NE. Big Bear, Mt. Wilson and mountains in San Deigo County reported T" of snow was strongest Feb. wind in 3 years and highest wind since Oct, 1985.
- 19-Strong NE winds continued all nite up to 66 mph at 1:50am and rarely dropping below 20 mph. From 10:30pm last night to 6:30am this morn wind averaged 21.0 mph. Slowly decreased some after noon. Av. wind speed of 13.07 mph from 10:30pm last night to 8pm tonite was highest since Jan.'84. After 10pm winds increased rapidly again.
- 20-NE winds continued for 3rd straight day all nite up to 70 mph at 6:45am. Continued all day but generally ended by 7pm. Av. wind speed for 24 hrs ending by 8pm was 13.96 mph. In last 5 days have had 1,067 miles of air go by, average per month for last year was 1,066 miles.
- 22-At 1am occ'l lite rain began ending by 6:30am with .10" falling. Low of 42° was coolest morn so far this month. Showers were very spotty with .06" office, .07" LA, T" Wedd Hills, .03" Long Bch, .43" Newport Bch and .59" Mt. Wilson with .13" San Deigo. Light snow stuck down to 4,000'.
- 23-Low of 39° was coolest morn since Jan.17. Dark, fast moving clouds provided occ'l sprinkles and brief showers from 10am to noon with T" as began to clear some. Baro fell rapidly since 8pm last night to 29.60" at 4pm, lowest reading since Mar, 1983. High of 50° was coolest afternoon since last March. Winds were very strong in places, hit NW 30 mph here at 3:20pm but hit 43 mph at George AFB, 44 mph LAX, 45 mph Las Vegas and 46 mph at Palm Springs. Light snow fell above 4,000 ft.
- 24-Clear skies in morn became cloudy rapidly with lite rain after 1:30pm along with brief thunderstorm 5 miles south. Rain ended by 4:45pm with .16". Was a very cold, blustery day. Moring low of 33° was coldest Feb. temp ever for station. High was only 53°. At 8:15pm lite rain and thunder began with closest lightning at 8:30pm at 4/5th mile. Storm ended by 9:10pm with rain falling in 35° temp. Had .22" more. Snow fell very low sticking above 1,400 feet in La Crescenta with 1" at 1,850 foot level. Stuck above 2,000 above station. During day 17" snow fell at Big Bear T" Beaumont 16" Cuyumaca Park and Ridge Route closed with 6" Lebec. ^{Tech Canyon - 1" Mt. Wilson - 1" Laguna - 1"} Snow here was lowest since Feb.2, 1979 and deepest in La Crescenta since Jan.22, 1962. Santa Maria had a high of 45°, which was coldest in Feb. ever and only 2° shy of of record. Thunderstorm today was first in Feb. in 4 years.
- 25-Observer went to La Crescenta in morn and found snow on ground above 2,000 in Verdugo Mns with 2" on ground at 2,400' level in La Crescenta. Even a snow plow was working. Clouds again rapidly increased with showers after 1pm becoming lite rain after 3pm with .04" falling by 5pm or .26". Cleared and showers ended at 5:15pm with T" more. At 3pm had a brief small hail shower, first in Feb in 4 years. Observer at 4pm found mixed snow falling in La Crescenta above 2,000' with all snow falling above 2,200 ft. San Gabriel Mtns had solid snow line above 3,000'. During day funnel clouds were reported near San Berdu and 5 at one time near Brown Field in San Deigo County. Waterspouts were seen off San Deigo coast. Snowfall was heavy with 10" Mt. Wilson, 18" Big Bear, 23" Tram, 16" Palomar and 20" Mt. Laguna. Lake Hughes had 4" snow in 1 hour this afternoon. Snow fell in Las Vegas and Mercury to NW had 5". ^{At 24 hrs 10" on ground, San Deigo 15"} In Arizona, Tucson had snowfall, 1" at Nogales, 27" Flagstaff, ^{35" Williams} 33" Pinetop, 26" Prescott and 8" Sedona.
- 26-Gusty NE winds came up at 3:45am up to 47 mph at 8:05am decreasing during afternoon. Could see snow showers over mtns to NE but cleared by midmorn. Areas to SE had snows in morn too. Rain totals for last 3 days; here-.4" office-.41", LA-.37", LAX-.23", Pasa-.58", Northridge-.24", San Berdu-.69", Beaumont-1.68", Mt. Wilson-1.76", Big Br-2.41", ^{Crested Lk - 1.41"} Lancaster-.29", Plm Spr-.5" RMRC-.45" with 1.08" San Deigo, 2.41" Campo, 1.28" Borrego and .08" Thermal.
- 27-Went down to 9° at cabin, 2° at Big Bear and 36° RMRC. ^{WWS - 22° below} Rain was 1/2 normal, driest in 3 yrs. Was coolest av in 8 years but only 1° below normal. Av. max. wind, highest in 6 yrs. Av. wind highest in 6 yrs. Days of thunder-1, days of hail-1, days of fog-1, days of NE wind-5

- 3-High of 78° was warmest day since Feb. 7. Was 82° LA & Pasa, 84° Santa Ana & 57° Big Bear with 81° Plm Sprs. Baro went up to 30.26" at 9am, month high.
- 4-High of 82° was warmest day since Feb. 6 and low of 58° was warmest morn since Feb. 7. Was 84° Pasa, 86° LAX, 87° Santa Ana and 89° El Toro. The 59° at Big Bear was warmest March temp since 1972. Was 85° San Diego, 89° Fallbrook and nation hot spot of 92° at Miramar NAS. Gusty SE wind belw during day to 31 mph at 11:30am. Hit 60 mph at Wheeler Ridge near Bakersfield. *Cal Poly Pomona 117 92 high for state this m*
- 5-Sprinkles to occ'l lite rain began at 6am from slow moving tropical front. SE winds were from calm to suddenly gusty hitting 45 mph at 7:20am. Air *Wheeler Ridge 180* was quite warm with high for day occuring at 7:17am with 68° but fell rest of day. In Calif. no temp this morn was below freezing. Warm air was felt eve in Montana with 70° temps. By 5pm had .22" but much heavier amounts fell between Sta Barbara and Monterey with 2.37" at S.B. and 6" in mtns south of Monterey. Lite rain conti. into evening. Coldest spot in all of Calif. tod was 33° at Big Bear, a very warm low for March. *Big Sur-4.99", Morro Bay-2.93"*
- 6-Occ'l lite rain fell all nite ending by 8am with .48" since 5pm or .70" stor. total. Skies broke briefly but clouded over after noon with heavy rain seen along mtn slopes to north and shower here from 2:30-3pm of .03" more or .73" storm total by 5pm. From 9-10pm had .05" more in a shower for .78" stor. total. Office-.58" Prout-.93", Pasa-1.43", Northridge-.62", LA-.42", LAX-.3 Beaumont-.82", Mt. - 12-Fog in morn.

- 13-High of 80° at Plm Sprs was the coolest afternoon since Ap.3
- 14-Fog in morning.
- 21-Upper low offshore moved Ac decks over with light showers from 3-3:30pm of T". Most areas had nothing but .02" Big Bear.
- 22-Cloudy all day with rain beginning at 11:30am, moderate at times, then stopped. At 5pm had 1.33" so far. Had occasional showers after with gusty SE winds coming up after 6:15pm to 42 mph at 8:30pm and ended by 10:30pm. At 9:15 to 9:45pm moderate to heavy rain fell causing some flooding with .67" in ½ hour. *Burbank had 1.00" from 7-9pm. Hansen Dam had 2.37" from 8-9pm.*

- 25-Baro rose to 30.24" at 11am, the highest Oct reading in 3 years and the 2nd highest ever for Oct.
- 26-Heat came back with the 85° the warmest in 20 days. Was 90° Burbk, 92° LA, 87° LAX and 93° San Berdu.
- 27-Overcast Ac deck from a old storm SW of here produced showers around 5am and 8am then breaks and light rain from 3:45 to 5pm of .05". Ended by 5:30pm with T" more. Just prior to the afternoon rain, gusty SW winds came up to 34 mph at 3pm. Baro took a dip also, dropping .07" from 9am to noon and then rose the same amount from 1pm to 5pm.
- 28-At 8am had a shower from Ac with .02", Prout-.05".
- 29-At 6:30am a thunderstorm began 2 miles SW along with lite rain becoming moderate at times as storm passed over with closest lightning at 4/5 mile at 6:48am and ending at 7am.
