9-Drizzle began at 6am becoming lite rain after 7am to 8am then a lite drizzle until 11am as the skies broke with .10". Office-.06", LA-.07", Pasadena-.0. Wld Hills-.08", Beaumont-.14", Avalon-.06", Redondo Bch-.32", Lancaster-.0. Mt. Wilson-.04", Big Bear-.09" with San Deigo-.04" and Mt. Palomar the wet spot with .77". Gusty NW winds hit the deserts and ocean with Santa Cruz Is.-53 mph, Oxnard-.32 mph, Edwards AFB-37 mph and Imperial-35 mph. NW winds hit here after 8pm up to 30 mph at 8:40pm.

10-NW winds continued until 2am up to 29 mph. Low of 44° beat the date record by 3° set 9 years ago.

11-High of 83° was warmest day since Mar. 15. Was 84° LA, Burbk and 85° Lg Bch.

12-High of 89° was warmest day since Mar. 13. Beat the date record by 2° set 4 years ago. Was 90° LA and Pasadena and Santa Ana, 91° Long Bch and 89° Palm Springs.

15-Day temperature difference of 36° was highest for April since 1986.

16-First 100° reading of the year in the deserts with 101° Thermal and 103° Blyt

20-Brief fog in morning.

21-Drizzle from stratus clouds from 7 to 8:30am of T".

23-Began to sprinkle after 8:30pm from weak front with T".

24-Storm was heavier in some areas but only T" here. Tehachapi Mtns. had lot of snow with up to 6" Bear Valley and 14" Hedy. Tejon Pass was closed.

Low of 42° was coldest since Mar. 26 tied the date record and was coldest

April temp in 3 years. Strong winds hit areas with LAX-38 mph, Oxnard-40m Long Bch-37 mph, Lancaster-40 mph, Palmdale-40 mph, Pt. Vincente-44 mph and

Was wettest April in 4 years but still only 83% of normal. Was coldest April since 1983. Av. max. was $\frac{1}{2}$ above normal but the average minimum was $2\frac{1}{2}$ below normal and coolest since 1983. Average temp was 1° below normal.

1-Drizzle in the morning from heavy stratus of .T".

3-Fog rolled in at 7:30 to 8am.

5-Showers in the morning with .01". Showrs again after 11:30pm with .02" by m

6-Showers fell until 12:30am with .01" more but began again at 1:30pm until 3pm with .05" falling. Observer was in Big Bear and had snow with $\frac{1}{4}$ " on ground in morning. Had one last shower of .01" at 11:30pm for a total of .10" in last 2 days.

7-At 9am lite rain began becoming drizzle after 11pm with .03" by midnite. Barometer up to 30.13" at 9am, high for the month.

8-Drizzle ended by 4am with .02" more for .05" overnite. Other areas had mor with LAX-.07", LA-.17" and Avalon-.50". For the last 4 days; office-.09", LA-.23", Pasadena-.26", Newpt Bch-.08", Beaumont-.17", Daggett-T", Palm Sprs-0 and Wrightwood-.28" and up north; San Fran-1.08", Napa-1.52", Blue Cyn-1.29", Sac-1.56", Fresno-.63", Kentfield-1.71", Paso Robles-.46".

11-Showers and thunderstorm developed over mountains to east in afternoon with storms at 6pm at Ontario and El Toro with .06" Big Bear.

12-Fog in morning with drizzle until 11am of T". Office-T", Riverside-.05", Beaumont-.05", and San Deigo-.03". Flash flooding hit Death Valley in the afternoon including Scotty's Castle. Palm Sprs-.02"

15-Drizzle hit some areas with .01" Beaumont and .04" Redondo. Up north Crescent City-.97".

16-A few sprinkles of T" in morning but other areas had more. Gusty winds hit deserts up to 35 mph Palmdale and 58 mph Mojave. Sierras including Truckee had snow with low of 16°.

- 17-At 9:30am occ'l drizzle to lite rain began turning to brief moderate at 2:50pm then back to occ'l showers with .32" by 5pm. Made the month total of .47" average for May and wettest May since 1990 and second wettest in 11 years. Low of 44° was coolest May temp in 3 years and set date record by 4° set twice before. High of 57° was coolest May high since 1983 tying record set in 1982-83. Had .01" more by 6pm for .33" storm total.
- 18-At 4:25am a moderate shower fell until 4:45am with .16" falling. Low fell to 43° after the shower. Only 3° other May's have lower temps (record 40°). Set the date record by 2° set in 1991. From 10 to 11:30am had T" more for .49" storm total. Month total so far of .64" makes this May the 8th wette in 40 years of records. Up north the last 3 days produced 1.05" Stockton and 1.14" Red Bluff. Snow fell in Tahoe area and up to 16" at Bodie.
- 21-High of 79° was warmest day since Ap. 19. Barometer went down to 29.88" at 4pm, low for the month.
- 24-Fog in morning. Showers hit eastern deserts and mountains including Therm Beaumont and Imperial. A lite 3.1 aftershock felt at 1:56pm.
- 25-Drizzle after 4am from heavy stratus with .02" and occ'l fog. Was 4th day this month with fog., most since 1983. At 5:57am had a moderate aftershock of 4.5 with another lite one at 2:42pm. Thunderstorms hit far deserts again with .13" Needles and .03" Pasadena, .14" Beaumont and .16" Monrovi
- 29-High of 93° was warmest day of month and since Oct. 26. Was 94° Pasadena, 92° LA and Burbank, 95° Woodland Hills. Day temp difference of 38° was highe for May since 1990. Min temp of 55° was 'warmest' of the month but record for coolest 'high' low.
- 30-At 8:30am thunderstorm began to east until 9am. Had occ'l sprinkles after the rest of the day with .01" falling from 3-3:30pm. Was due to a upper low off the coast. Glendale-T", Pasadena-T", Beaumont-.03", Mt. Wilson-.0 RMRC and Palm Sprs-T", Big Bear-.07" and cabin-.11". Was 8th day this month of measurable precip tied the max. for May.

- 2-Low of 61° was warmest morn. since Mar. 14.
 7-Was cold in central Calif. with 18° at Truckee and 14° Bodie.
 9-High of the year so far with 96°, hottest June in 4 yrs. and hottest day since Oct. 1. Beat the date record by 4° set in 1979. Day temp difference of 40° was highest for June since 1985 and second highest for June. Was highest for any month since May, 1990. Was 94° Pasa, 101° San Berdu, 103° Wld Hills, 108° Palm Sprs, 83° Big Bear, 100° Solvang and 104° Paso Robles.
 10-Cooled off 11° here but was very hot to north with 91° Monterey, 96° San Fran 101° San Jose, 100° Napa, 105° Fresno, 116° Blythe and first 120° of year at Death Valley.
 13-Barometer went down to 29.86" at 7pm, low for the month.
 14-High of 68° was coolest day since May 26. Strong winds hit deserts up to 84 mph at Mojave. Some areas had T" drizzle. At 11pm had a brief but moderate aftershock of 4.1
 15-Heavy stratus produced heavy drizzle after 5am with .06" by 8am and conti. until about 2:30pm with .05" more or .11" total. High of 63° was coolest day since May 25 and coolest day of month. Made this the second wettest June in 12 years and third wettest in 22 years. Strong winds hit deserts again with 30 mph at Palm Sprs, 43 mph at 29 Palms and 58 mph at Mojave. I appeared to be in the wettest area with T" El Toro, .02" San Gabriel, .05" Monrovia, .30" Rrout and .33" Bev Crabtree.

- 16-Drizzle in early morn of T". Barometer went up to 30.06" at 8am, high for the month. *Baro was 16", 10 for month for state.*
- 22-Warmest morn of the month so far and since Mar. 14 with 62°. High of 91° was warmest day in 13 days and beat the date record by 3° set in 1992. Was 93° Pasadena and Burbank, 101° San Berdu, 108° Daggett, 110° Palm Sprs and 119° Death Valley with 90° low.
- 23-Low of 67° was warmest low since Oct. 2. High hit 95°. Was 97° Burbank, 99° Pasadena, 102° Wld Hills, 107° Hemet, 91° Long Beach, 113° Palm Sprs, 119° Death Valley and 86° Big Bear.
- 24-Over 90° for 3rd day in a row with 93°. Was very hot in the deserts and mtns with 86° Mt. Wilson, 95° Wrightwood, 88° Lake Arrowhead, 111° Daggett, 117° Palm Sprs, 119° Thermal, 120° Death Valley and 122° Lk Havasu City.
- 25-Hottest day of the month so far with 97°. Was 99° Pasadena and Burbank, 103° Wld Hills, 105° San Berdu and Beaumont, 111° Daggett, 118° El Centro and Palm Sprs, 120° Blythe and Laughlin, 122° Lk Havasu City and 124° Death Valley (the hottest Calif. June temp since 1990 but second warmest since 1961).
- 26-Low of 74° was warmest morn since Sep. 28 and for June since 1990. Was the 4th warmest June morn in 17 years of data here. Temp soared to 105°, only the 7th day of 100+ in June in 17 years. Record of 110° was set 4 yrs ago today. This was the third hottest June day. Humidity at 5pm was 6%. Pasadena 106°, Burbank 107°, Wld Hills 108°, Daggett 112°, Palm Sprs 117°, Laughlin 122° (tying the State record for any month), and Death Valley 126° (hottest June temp since 129° in 1902). Elsewhere El Paso tied the record high for any month with 112°. Denver set a record June high and was only 1° shy of their all-time record with 104°. Grand Jct was likewise with 104°.
- 27-From 3:15 to 6:15am had gusty east winds from Ac overhead up to 23 mph at 5am. Other areas had some damage. In the afternoon could see towering cumulus to NE. Cottonwood Cove had 60 mph winds and heavy rain. China Lake hit 115°, a June record as was Wrightwood at 96°, Needles 120°, Laughlin 122°, Bullhead City 123° and Death Valley 126° again after a 101° low. El Paso set a June record with 113°. Roswell, NM had their hottest ever with 114° and Lakewood, NM set the State June record with 119° (located just north of Carlsbad Caverns). In Okla. the 120° at Tipton tied the State record.
- 28-Seven days in a row of 90+. Was 94°. Hit 97° Pasadena, 101° Wld Hills, 104° Beaumont, 117° Palm Sprs, 117° China Lake (all-time record), 119° Needles, 120° Thermal, 123° Blythe and RMRC, 125° Death Valley with 110° Paso Robles, 123° Lake Havasu City and the 124° at Laughlin set a new Nevada State record for any month. Wrightwood 97° was also a all-time high. A few thunderstorms hit northern deserts. The 90° at Big Bear was the hottest June since 1985.
- 29-Another 90° day with 94°. Very hot in the interior. Mt. Wilson 97°, Wrightwood 98° (record high), Hemet 111°, Lancaster 109°, Daggett 115°, Palm Sprs, Blythe and Needles 121°, Death Valley 126° and Lake Havasu City set the Ariz. all-time high with 128°, old record of 127° was set in 1905 at Fort Mohave. Desert Hot Sprs was hit with 3 funnel clouds during a 2:30pm thunderstorm with damage. Was the 9th day of the month of 90+ tying for second most in June. *Palm Sprs-T", 14 Palm-T"*
- 30-Thunderstorms hit deserts again with tornado reported just east of Daggett. *Death Valley-128°*

Clear days-16 Cloudy days-1 Partly Cloudy days-13

Average temp was 3½° above normal and warmest since 1990 and was the 3rd warmest June in 17 years of data. Av. max was 5.2° above. The 16 clear days was the most since 1981 (tied with 1990). Av. rain was about normal but the second wettest June since 1982.

Newport Bch-.10", El Toro-.09", Avalon-.07", Riverside-.01", Big Bear-.01", Palm Sprs-T", Imperial-.02", San Deigo-.02", Mt Laguna-.65" and Cuyamaca Park-.84". At 7:36pm had a 3.6 EARTHQUAKE, lasted about 7 seconds. Again at 7:48pm had another at 4.5 and lasting 10 seconds and centered 3 mile east of San Fernando. No damage. Barometer went down to 29.86" at 3pm, low for the month.
- 6-Drizzle around 6am of .01" El Toro-T", Thermal and Mt. Wilson-T".
- 8-NE winds came up at 6am to 23 mph at 7:35pm and 26 mph at 2:35pm and conti. all day occasionally. Were very strong in other areas up to 35 mph Needles 33 mph Beaumont, 39 mph Pt. Magu and 46 mph Ontario.
- 9-Cold air returned with 41° low. Was 36° Pasadena, 34° Burbk, 12° Lancaster, 17° Thermal, 20° Lk Ar-rowhd and 12° Big Bear. Was 30° RMRC, coldest of the year. Barometer went up to 30.25" at 11pm, high for the month, but the lowest hig for Dec. since 1981.

- 23-Showers conti. to the south in the morning with Beaumont-.01", Daggett-.3 Palm Sprs-.15", RMRC-.11", Blythe-.15", Mt. Wilson-T", Big Bear-.22", Wrightwood-1.08" (wet Spot), San Deigo-.10", Fallbrook-.22" and MT Laguna .73".
- 24-Around 5am had a shower of .01" and had another shower around noon of .03" more as the storm approached. At 5:30pm began to sprinkle with rain, moderate at times after 7:30pm. At 8:42pm a thunderstorm began with closest at 1 miles at 9pm and ended at 9:15pm. Rain generally ended by 10:30pm with occasional showers after. Had .55" in 1 hour from 8-9pm.
