- 1-Clear morning gave way to rapidly approaching front with light rain after 3:15pm with .20" by 5pm then ending by 8:15pm with .19" more or .39" storm total. Office-.22", Pasadena-.27", World Hills-.17", LA-.10", LAX-.07", Avalon-.09", Beaumont-.13", Mt. Wilson-.50", Big Bear-.13", cabin-.16", deserts-0, San Deigo-.03" and Cuyumaca Park-.17". Up north heavy rain and snow fell with a tornado doing damage in Stockton. San Fran-1.10", Kentfield-3.31", Blue Cyn-3.45". Mammoth 8" snow and Alpine Mdw-14".
- 4-Gusty NE winds came up at noon until sunset up to 26 mph at 2:05pm. Day temperature difference of 38° was a April record high.
- 5-NE winds blew occ'lly during the night to 20 mph then picked up after 8am to 27 mph at 8:45am and continued most of the day to 5pm. Low of 60° was warmest April in 3 yers and since Feb.8. Temp rose to 88°, hottest April in 2 years and since Feb.7. Was 87° Pasadena, 89° LA and Long Bch, 87° Sta An and 86° Palm Sprs. Winds below Cajon Pass hit over 50 mph with 37 mph Pt. Magu, 40 mph Ontario and 32 mph Burbank.
- 6-Another 88° day. Was 87° Burbank, 90° World Hills, 89° Avalon, 87° San Deigo and 90° on Pt. Loma.
- 7-Hi of 90° was warmest April since 1992. Only 4 other Aprils have been warme in the last 19 years. Was 90° Pasadena, 88° LA and 100° Death Vly (1st of yr.
- 10-Strong winds hit deserts and mtns with 40 mph Sandberg, 43 mph Palmdale and Edwards and 75 mph Mojave. Drizzle fell in San Deigo coastal areas.
- 12-Gusty NW winds came up after 8am to 27 mph at 11:45pm. Gusty winds hit many areas with 33 mph LAX, 39 mph Oxnard, 44 mph Lancaster and 58 mph Moja

- 13-Gusty NW winds continued to 2am up to 28 mph at 12:25am, high for month.
- 16-Unexpected drizzle began at 11:30am from approaching front with occ'l lite rain after 1pm with .23" by 5pm as the rain continued. Heavier rain fell up north of over 2" with 10" new snow in Sierras. Fresno had a funne cloud at 1:45pm. Had occ'l fog in the afternoon.
- 17-Showers continued during the night ending by 6:30am with .25" more since 5pm yesterday or .48" storm total. Office-.34", Pasadena-.46", Wdld Hills .07", LA-.27", LAX-.03", Avalon-.06", Beaumont-T", Mt. Wilson-.84", Big Bear-T", deserts-0, San Deigo-.01" and Palomar-.09". At 6pm drizzle began from a new storm with lite rain after 9pm with .18" by midnight. Up to 12 snow fell in Sierras again and down to 1,500' in NW Calif. Winds hit 80mp at Squaw Valley ridges.
- 18-Lite rain continued to 1:30am then began again at 4:45am to 5:30am when broke. Had .17" since midnight for .35" storm total. Gusty NW winds came up in mid-morning up to 26 mph at 3:25pm ending by 11pm. Hit 29 mph LAX, 40 mph Palm Sprs and 58 mph Mojave. Office-.27", LA-.34", Pasadena-.24" LAX-.31", Wdld Hills-.27", Beaumont-.31", Avalon-.53", Mt. Wilson-.53", Idlywild .30", deserts-0, San Deigo-.32" and Palomar the wet spot-1.18".
- 19-Barometer rose to 30.21" at 11am, highest April pressure since 1988 and high for the month.
- 23-Hi climbed to 92°, warmest April since 1989 and since Oct. 7, '95. Only 5 other April dates in the last 19 years have been hotter. Beat the date record by 6° set in 1992. Was 90° LA, 94° Van Nuys, 93° Pasadena and 90° Lg Bc
- 24-Low of 63° was warmest morn in April since 1992. South deserts were all above 100° with 104° RMRC.
- 26-Temp climbed to 94°, hottest Ap. since 1989 but only 5 other April dates have been hotter. Was the warmest day since last Oct. 2. Beat the date record by 5°. Was 92° Burbk, 93° Pasadena, 99° Beaumont, 100° Wdld Hills, 111° Palm Sprs, 110° RMRC, 78° Big Bear, 92° Sta Maria, 95° Paso Robles and 101° Solvang. Was the 12 day this month of 80+, tieing the April record.
- 27-Barometer fell to 29.86", low for the month.
- 28-Temp climbed to 85°, 13th day this month of 80+, a April record. Old record of 12 was set twice before in 1987 and 1992. NE winds came up at 7pm to 11pm to 20 mph at 8:45pm.
- 29-NE winds came up at 6am until noon and hit 18 mph at 11:20am. Low of 64° was warmest morn of the month so far and since Feb. 8. High hit 93° and beat date record by 1° set in 1981. Was 96° LA and Sta Ana, 94° LAX, 95° Pt. Magu, 92° Burbank, 90° Sta Maria and SLO, 85° San Deigo and 96° Fallbrook.
- 30-Low of 65° was warmest month and for April since 1989. Only one April in the last 19 years had a warmeer morn with 77° in 1989. High hit 96°, the second hottest April temp ever. Beat the date record by 16° set 3 times before. Only 3 other April dates in the last 19 years have been hotter. Was 96° LA and Pasadena & Northridge, 98° Wdld Hills, 96° Sta Maria, 99° Lompo 92° San Fran, 90° Monterey and 96° SLO. Sacramento set a April record w/97°.

- 1-Low of 62° was warmest May low in 3 years. Beat the date record by 8° set 11 yrs ago with 90° high.
- 2-Low of 53° was coolest day in 10 days.
- 4-Low of 51° was coolest day in 13 days.
- 10-Baro went up to 30.11" at 10am, high for the month.
- 11-Low of 65° was the warmest May morning since 1990. High climbed to 95°, the hottest May temp since 1990. Only 2 other Mays in 19 years of records have been hotter. Beat the date record by 1° set in 1988. Only 4 May dates in 19 years have been hotter, tied 2 others. Was 95° Burbank, 96° Pasadena, 97° Wdld Hills, 93° LA, 93° Long Bch, 102° San Berdu, 87° Mt. Wilson and 82° Big Bear with 112° Death Vly.
- 12-High climbed over 90° again to 92°. Was 4th day this month over 90° only 1 day from tying the May record set in 1988. Was 90° Burbank, 102° San Berdu, 89° Wrightwood and 111° Palm Sprs with 101° Paso Robles and 115° Death Vly.
- 14-Up north the first rain in nearly 3 weeks brought up to nearly 1 inch.
- 16-First rain in nearly a month began at 8:30am with mostly drizzle and ended by 12:30pm with .05". Office-.02", Pasadena-.03", LA-.04", LAX-.01", Wdld Hills-T", Avalon-0, Mt. Wilson-.06" and most other areas to south-0
- Heavier rains fell up north with flooding in Yosemite with 4.80" at Blue Cyn.
- 23-Low of 48° was coldest of month and beat the date record by 1° set 3 times before including last year. Was the coolest morning since Ap.21. At 9:45pm gusty NW winds came up hitting 35 mph at 10:05pm and ended at 11:41

- Was strongest for May since 1991. At 8:36am had a light EARTHQUAKE. Was very brief and barely felt. Was 3.6 centered just east of LA.
- 24-Upper cold low over Nevada produced showers and thunderstorms to east and south after midnorning with snow reported at Lake Arrowhead and 1" at Big Bear. Some areas had heavy rain with .19" Wrightwood, .07" Daggett, .42" Ramona, .67" Poway and 1.84" Fallbrook along with flooding and 2" of hail. Occ'l gusty NE winds in the afternoon hit 30 mph at 1:20pm. Barometer wen down to 29.78" at 4am, low for the month.
- 25-High of only 65° was coolest day since Ap.16. Was cool everywhere with 50° high at cabin and Big Bear, 65° Needles with .34" rain and 83° Death Vly & Thermal with .11" Death Vly and T" Thermal. Big Bear had snow all morn. but did not stick with .20" at cabin.
- 27-Occ'l light drizzle off and on of T" all morning from heavy stratus.
- 29-Drizzle from heavy stratus began in the early morning until 9am with .01" Most areas had a T" or 0.

- 1-Summer arrived. High climbed to 96°, warmest June temp since 1994 and beat the date record by 8° set in 1987. Was 97° Pasadena, 95° Burbk, 99° Wld Hill 100° San Berdu but 66° Sta Monica Pier. Day temp difference of 39° was 3rd highest for June and most for any month in 2 years.
- 2-Temp hit 98°, warmest day since Sep.15 last year. Beat the date record by 7° set in 1990. Only 8 June dates in the last 19 years have been warmer. Was 100° Pasadena, 96° Burbank, 102° Wld Hills, 102° Riverside, 94° EA, 88° Avalon and 96° San Francisco, 105° Paso Robles. Barometer went up to 30.10" at 11pm, high for the month.
- 3-High hit 94°. Was 95° Pasadena, 102° Wld Hills, 114° Palm Sprs and 120° Death Valley and 109° Paso Robles, a date record.
- 4-Hit 114° Palm Sprs and Needles, 113° Blythe and 121° Death Vly.
- 7-Hit 121° at Death Valley for 4th day in a row. Low was 92°.
- 25-Upper low up north produced showers with snow in Tahoe area of up to 2". High at South Shore was only 46°. Highs in San Joaquin Vly in 70s produce record low max. for several cities.
- 26-Felt like Spring with the coolest high since May 30 with 70°. Some areas had showers with T" El Tero, Wrightwood and Death Vly. Highs were cool with 92° Death Vly, 87° Palm Sprs and only mid-50s in mountains. Not a dro of rain here tho for nearly a month. Barometer wnet down to 29.84" at 3a low for the month.
- 27-Low of 50° was coldest of month since since May 31. Beat date record by 4° set in 1987. Went down to 38° at Mt. Wilson, and Mt. Laguna and 33° cabin.
- 28-Low of 50° again setting a date record by 1° set in 1987.

29-High was 50° warmer than yesterday's low with 100°. Beat the date record by 5° set in 1980. Was hottest day of the year so far and since last S.p. Was 5th hottest June in 19 years. Was 7th time temp has reached 100° in June in the last 19 years. Was 101° Burbank, 102° Pasadena, 103° Wdld Hills, 104° Beaumont, 98° LA, 100° Long Beach and 91° Sta Barbara and 105° Solvang.

30-Low of 72° was warmest morn of the month and since Sep. 14, High hit 98°. Was 100° Pasadena, 103° Wdld Hills, 96° LA, 90° LAX, 114° Palm Sprs, 118° Death Valley with 100° San Jose, 102° Sacramento and 107° Paso Robles.

- 1-High hit 102°, warmest day since last Sep. Was 102° Pasadena, 106° World Hills 104° Beaumont, 109° Hemet, 110° Daggett, 116° Blythe and Palm Sprs, 117° Thermal and 121° Death Vly with 103° El Cajon and Ramona and 100° Napa, 91° San Fran., 106° Bksfield and 104° Sacramento. Tied as the 3rd hottest July temp for station. Only 4 other Julys have had hotter temps including today with 104 in 1985.
- 2-Hit 103° with only 4 other July dates hotter. Beat the date record by 2° set in 1985. - 22-Baro rose to 30.26" at 2am, highest Oct. reading since 1984 and the 2nd highest Oct. reading of record. NE winds hit 56 mph at Bear Valley-Hedy.

- 30-Rain conti. all night and into the morning ending by 2pm with 1.36" total. The wettest Oct in 4 yrs and 5th wettest Oct in last 42 yrs. Was wettest storm since Mar. 12-13. From being a dry season so far went to 110% of normal. High of only 54° was coolest high since Mar. 28 and a Oct record

low max. and beat the old record by 3° set last year. Low of 45° tied for the Oct. record low. Office-1.16", Pasadena-1.18", Wdld Hills-1.37", LA-1.06", LAX-1.47", Avalon-.70", Beaumont-1.24", Mt. Wilson-2.38", Big Bear-1.31", cabin-1.37" (4" snow), Death Vly-.40", Palm Sprs-T", San Deigo-.61" and Palomar-1.50". With another 5½" snow at Tuloumne Mdws the Oct. became the snowiest of record. with 30½".

31-Low of 40° was a station record Oct. low. Broke the record by 5°. Beat the date record by 7° set in 1991. All-time Glendale stations record was 36° in 1971. Was 42° Pasadena, 37° Beaumont, 28° Mt. Wilson, 22° Wrightwood and 23° cabin (a Oct record low). Another 1½" snow fell at Bear Vly-Hedy.
