1-Began to shower at noon and became occ'l dirzzle with .01" by 5pm. Terribl floods up north continued with downtown Reno flooded as well as Guerneville 2-Fog and drizzle all nite and day with fog again in the late afternoon and .40" since 5pm yesterday to 5pm today. Became lite rain after 10pm.

3-Fog and lite rain fell until 4am then mist until 8:30am with .61" overnite or 1.02" storm total the last 3 days. Cleared by noon and gusty NW winds came up at noon and up to 29 mph at 4:20pm then died down after 8pm and ended by 9pm. Office-.66", Pasa-.83", LA-.44", LAX-.45", Avalon-.15", Wdld Hills-.54", Beaumont-.82", Big Bear-.37", deserts-0, San Deigo-.05" and Mt. Palomar-1.97"

5-Lite rain began at 3:45am becoming moderate from 4:40 to 5:55am and ended by 6:15am with .27". This was 13th time it has rained on this date in the last 21 years, the most on any date. Office-T", Pasa-.07", LA-.03", LAX-.03", Wdld Hills-.04", Beaumont-.23", Avalon-.07", Mt. Wilson-.30", Big Br-T" with T snow, San Deigo-.04", Mt. Palomar-.35" and 1" snowfall and Bear Valley 4" snow. At 11am NW winds came up up to 23 mph at 6:15pm.

6-Winds became NE at midnite and increased to becoming very strong hitting 74 mph at 4am and 77 mph at 7:45am. Strongest for any month since Feb.17, 1988. Strongest for Jan. since 1985. Caused lots of damage including observer's home with large tree taking out railing and deck and blocking driveway. Trees were down and blocking streets. Power was out here for 2½

hours and nearly all day nearby. Winds continued all day and into the evening. Showers fell to the east and south with 3" snow Big Bear, 2" Hesperia and 1" Mt. Laguna. 5-Went up to 83. Beat the date record by 2 set in 1993. Day temp difference tied for second highest in Feb. at 35. Was 89 Pasadena as nation high, 87 Santa Ana, 84 LA, 80 LAX.

9-High climbed to 89, hottest day since Nov.9. Tied for the second highest March temp with 3 other years. Beat the date record by 8 set wwice before the last time was last year. Only two other March dates have been hotter in the last 21 years. Was 88 Burbank, LA & Woodlad Hills, 91 Pasadena and nation hot spot of 99 San Gabriel. Was 90 Ontario and 92 Palm Sprs.
