- 2-NE winds came up around 4am up to 27 mph by 7:08am then hit 48 mph at 1:46pm as it calmed some after but continued to 32 mph at 8:12pm. Humidity fell to 7% in afternoon. Other areas; Devore-42 mph, Ontario-45 mph, Newhall-56 mph, Chilao-61 mph and Warm Sprs Pk.-78 mph.
- 3-NE winds blew lighter all day until sundown then up to 19 mph. Barometer rose to 30.35" at 11am, high for the month.
- 4-High of 79° tied the all Glendale record hi along with 1966 and 1999 and was hi for the month. Was 81° Burbk, 82° LAX, 80° Sta Maria, 84° Sta Ana and 77° Plm Sprs In evening humidity fell to 6%.
- 5-Upper low to SW increased Ac during the day with sprinkles after 3pm with T" by 5pm. At 7pm had occasional rain. Was first moisture in 24 days and first measurable in 68 days (Oct.29). Ended up with a whopping 0.05" as it ended at 9pm. At this location it has now rained on this date 14 of the last 25 years. Office-T", Burbk-.04", Pierce-.02", Ontario-.03", Beaumont-T", Big Bear-.16" Palm Sprs-T", Mt. Wilson-.15" and San Diego-T"
- 8-Began to rain at 11am from approaching storm with lite rain until 4pm with .16' total. Was wettest storm since Oct.29 (71 days). Was one of drier spots with office-.16", Burbk-.18", Pasadena-.09", LA-.27", LAX-.39", Avalon-.11", Mt. Wilson-.14", Newport-.72", San Diego-.65". Mountains had 1-2" snow.
- 10-Steady rain began from approaching front at 2:25pm with .40" by 5pm. Had gust SE winds to 31 mph by 4:42pm and 40 mph at 8pm as wind chill fell to 25. steady rain continued into evening. Low of 43° tied the date record set in '87'

- 11-Steady rain continued until ended briefly at 5am. SE winds hit 47 mph at 12:25am then let up and shifted to NW after 2am. At 7am heavy rain began until 7:30am then let up and ended by 8:15am. Had .46" in half hour. Had 2.95" from 5pm to 7:30am over night. Had another shower from 10:30 to 11:30am Started to shower again at 4:15pm with .23" during the day or 3.58" storm total so far. At 7:15 to :45pm had 2 rolls of thunder. High of 46° was coolest Jan. max since 1992. Was wettest storm since Feb.22-24,1998.
- 12-Had occasional rain in the early morn hours with .45" since 5pm yesterday to 7am for 4.03" storm total. Occasional showers and sprinkles during day ended by 4:30pm with .10" more or 4.13" total. Could see new snow above 3,800 ft. on Lukens. Mountain resorts had up to 4 feet of new snow with 12" Palomar and 17" Wrightwood. Others; office-4.25", Pasadena-4.13", LA-4.41", LAX-3.60" Avalon-2.16", Pierce-5.14" and Riverside-1.51"
- 13-Low of 38° beat the date record by 2° last set in 1989. Was 35° Wdland Hills, 15° at Wrightwood.
- 15-Low of 39° beat the date record by 1° last set in 1989. NE winds came up after 3am and blew all day up to 25 mph at 11:55am.
- 16-NE winds blew most of the day up to 28 mph at 10:40am.
- 17-NE winds increased to 53 mph at 3:15am and continued until about 11pm. Was strongest January winds in 4 years.
- 24-Light rain fell from 1am to 11am with .50". office-.45"
- 25-Low of 34° beat the date record by 2° last set in 1999. Tied all Glendale stations set back in 1955. Was coldest Jan. minimum since 1989. Was 38° Pasa. and Long Beach, 32° Wdld Hills and 22° Frazier Park.
- 26-Low of 37° tied the date record with 1979. Max temp of only 43° tied with 1979 and coldest Jan. max. temp. Rain fell from about 3am occasionally to 7pm with .33" by 5pm and .11" more for .44" total. Office-.29", Pasadena-.45", Burbk-.71", LA-.52", LAX-.63", Pierce-.67", Mt. Wilson-.48". Snow stuck down to 3,000 feet with highs only 49° Burbk and 41° Newhall.
- 27-BARometer fell to 29.85" low for the month.
- 28-Low of 39° was 10th day of temps in 30s, a record number for January. Old reco was 6 in 1979.
- 31-NE winds came up at 6am to 25 mph at 11:25am then died down and ended by 6pm.

3-Temperature rose to 82°. Was 87°Burbank and 90°San Gabriel.

4-Temperature rose to 83°. Was 86°Burbank, 87°LA, 90°Pasadena and Oxnard. The 93° at Santa Ana was the nation hot spot and was 87°Palm Sprs.

7-Light rain fell from 4 to 5am of .17" followed by gusty NW winds to 26 mph at 6:07am along with a wind chill down to 22°. at 6:07am.Snow stuck down to 3,80 feet. Winds hit 27 mph at 7:48am. Low fell to 36°. Station was one of a few reporting rain along with Burbank .02", office-T", LA-.06", Pierce-.03", San Gabriel .26" (wet spot), Mt. Wilson-.16", San Diego-.06", San Berdu-.07", Wrightwood-.67" and Mt. LAGuna-1.00". In afternoon around 3 to 4pm could see snow showers over mtns to NE and showers over LA. Barometer fell to 29.77" a 7am. At 2pm La Crescenta and Simi Valley and a snow flurry.

8-Low of 34° beat the date record by 2° last set in 1989. Was also a all Glendal record by same number. NE winds came up at 7:30am to 8am to 29 mph at 7:25am Was 36°Pasadena, 35°Pierce, 34°Anaheim and Ontario, 26°Beaumont, 19°Mt.Wilso 29°1000 Oaks, 11°Wrightwood, 15°Mt. LAGuna, 22°Hesperia, 7°Bear Valley, -5°Bodie and -7°Mammoth LAKes. Barometer rose from 29.84" at midnite to 30.17" at midnite or 0.33".

9-Low of 37° beat the date record by 2° last set in 1998.

- 10-Light rain began at 3:30am ending by 8am with .34", Had more showers from noon to 12:45pm and at 4pm a light hail storm began with rice to small pea sized covering the ground by time ended at 4:25pm. Had storm total of .47" by 5pm. Was first Feb hail in 5 years. High of 46° was coolest Feb. high since tying in 1989. Was 2nd coldest Feb. high for station. Office-.38", Burbk-.42". Pasadena-.17", LA-.36", LAX-.13", Avalon-.14", Pierce-.32", Mt. Wilson-.52", Beaumont-.11" and San Diego-T". Lite snow stuck above 3,700 ft.
- 11-Low of 36° tied the date record set in 1999. Lite showers began at 11:45am along with increasing SE winds to 29 mph at 12:56pm. By 5pm had .07" so far. Had .31" more by midnite as rain increased after 11pm.
- 12-Low of 40° tied the date record last set in 1978 and 1989. Rain continued moderately at times to 5:30am when it became occasional showers with 1.73" since 5pm to 8am. Had a moderate rain shower from 10:30 to 11:30am then just drizzle with .40" during the day or 2.16" since 5pm to 5pm today or storm total of 2.23". Had occasional fog in the morning. Office had 1.74" since 5p along with 1.67"- Burbk, 1.48" at Pasadena, 1.51" LA, 1.10" LAX, 1.27" Pierce, .43" Avalon, 3.34" Mt. Wilson, 1.74" Wrightwood and T" Palm Sprs. Rain began again at 5:30pm along with SE winds to 29 mph at 11pm. High of only 43° was coolest Feb max since 1979. Snow stuck above 4,500 feet but up north low snow levels reported 8" in mountains above Sta Cruz, 2" behind OAKland, 25" on Lick Observatory at 4,200 ft, falling, but not sticking at Ft. Bragg, 4" Ukia at 615 ft. Rain became steady after 9:30pm.
- 13-Steady rain, moderate at times, continued until 5:30am then let up to showers with 2.22" by 8:15am since 5pm yesterday. SE winds were very strong in the early morning hours up to 50 mph at 2:36am. Hit 48 mph at 6:08am with a wind chill down to 16°. Showers continued until 1pm with .20" more during the day to 5pm or 24 hour total of 2.42" and storm total of 4.65" so far. Showers began again at 7pm and thunderstorm began 2 miles southwest from 820 to 8:40pm. Heavy snow closed the Ridge Route all day with 18" Lebec, 4" Tehachapi, 24" Bear Valley (Hedy) and 4 foot drifts, and 30" Frazier Park, 48" Wrightwood and 4" Palmdale with Mt. Wilson-40". Small pea sized hail began at 8:57pm along with SW winds to 26 mph at 8:55pm and wind chill of 20°. This 2nd hail day this month was the most ever for Feb. Had a roll of thunder one mile south at 9:03pm. Hail ended by 9:35pm. Strong winds hit other areas; Cheeseboro-53 mph, Chino-73 mph, Saugus-35 mph, Whittier Hills-37 mph, Oxnard-41 mph. Barometer fell to 29.57" at 4am, lowest for Feb in 3 years. Rain ended by 11pm with .34" more or 4.99" storm total. Snow fell in La Crescenta-La Canada areas above 1,400 ft and stuck above 1,800 ft with 1" Circle Vista. Also stuck on Verdugos above 2,400 ft. *Pierce College had 4.25" today, 6:16 24h for no*
- 14-Low of 32° beat the date record by 1° last set in 1990. Was also a all Glendale record. Was only 1° from tying the Feb record here. Finally cleared up. Heavy snow marooned lots of people in the mtns. Mt. Wilson-40", Wrightwood-60" Lake Arrowhead-31", Anza-12", Palmdale-4" and Phelan-12". Storm totals; office-4.07", Pasadena-3.82", Burbk-4.22", LA-5.10", LAX-3.67", Pierce-5.68" Avalon-2.04", Mt. Wilson-8.35", Newport Bch-2.75", San Diego-.62", San Berdo-2.88", Mt. Laguna-4.40" and Palm Sprs-.12"
- 15-Low of 36° was 8th day of temps in 30s here this month, tying the Feb. record
- 17-After a week trapped by deep snows, the operators of Mt. Waterman and Kratka Ridge were airlifted out today. Angeles Crest was closed beyond 6,000' level
- 18-Lite rain showers after 7am to 8am from weak front passing thru dropped .02". Office-T", Burbk-.03", Pasadena-.08", LA-.02", LAX-0, Pierce-.04", Avalon-.05 Mt. Wilson-.12", Wrightwood-.07", Palm Sprs-T" but most areas had 0.
- 19-Began to sprinkle after 11am along with gusty SE winds to 23 mph at 8:50am. Had a wind shift to SW at 3pm. Lite rain fell from 2 to 3pm then drizzle with .27" by 5pm. Drizzle ended by 9pm with .11" more or .38" storm total. Office-.25", Burbk-.09", Pasadena-.22", LA-.57", LAX-.25", Pierce-.20", Avalon-.04", Mt. Wilson-.57", Beaumont-.39", San Diego-.39" and Palomar-.66".

- 20-Clouded up during the day with occasional sprinkles of T" from 2 to 4:30pm. Low of 39° was 9th day this month in 30s, a Feb. record. Tied for the 3rd most for any month.
- 23-Rain began at 6:30am with low of 37° at the same time. Beat the date record low by 2° set in 1987. Ended by 8:30am with .14", office-.11", Burbk-.07", .12", LAX-.16", Avalon-.02", Pierce-.05", Mt. Wilson-.18", cabin-.04" with snw. Snow fell above 2,500 ft but no large amounts. Beaumont-.21", San Diego-.34", Palomar-.36" and deserts-0
- 24-With low of 39°, rain rain began at 8am and continued all day with .36" by 5 High of only 41°, tied the station record for the lowest high with Feb., 1979 Day temp difference of only 2° was the lowest since 1983 and for any month since June, 1998.
- 25-Light showers fell most of the night with .24" by 7am. At 11am steady rain began with .61" during the day to 5pm and .85" since 5pm yesterday and 1.21" so far for the storm. Steady rain continued.
- 26-Rain ended by 5am with 1.05" overnight since 5pm for the storm total of 2.26 Had a brief T" shower around 3pm. Office-2.20". This was 12th day this mon with measurable rain, tying for 2nd most of record for Feb. In 1998 had a record of 15 days.
