- 1-NE winds came up in the early morning hitting 19 mph at 6:52am then let up during the day but increased in the evening to 29 mph at 9:15pm and continued
- 2-NE winds continued all night lightly and increased at daybreak to 29 mph at 7:01am. Shifted to SW after 9am then shifted back to NE at 2:15pm and increased to 27 mph at 6:32pm and died down after.
- 6-Light rain began at 8am briefly, then occasional showers the rest of the day due to a weak frontal passage then clouds broke at 3pm with .02" falling. Office-.02", Burbk-.01", Pasadena-.10", LA-T", LAX-.06", Avalon-.10", Pierce .06", Mt. Wilson-.12" and Chilao-.20". Opid Camp was wet spot with .25"
- 7-Drizzle to sprinkles began after 3pm with T" by 5pm. Lots of T" around with more against the mountains with .06" Mt. Wilson and .18" Crystal Lake. Had another shower between 9-10pm of .02"
- 10-Began to sprinkle from approaching storm to the south at 8pm. Steady, light rain began at 11:30pm with .05" by midnite.
- 11-Rain fell all night then let up from 6-8am then began again with another let up from 9:15 to 11:30am then continued with 1.99" storm total by 5pm. After 6pm became showery. Had gusty SE winds all day to 22 mph at 9:06am. Barometer fell to 29.79" at 4am, low for the month.

- 12-Showers ended at 5:15am and skies broke by 9am with .43" overnight or 2.42" storm total. From 3:30 to 4pm had a T" shower. Office-2.23", Burbk-2.16", Pasadena-3.32", LA-2.27", LAX-2.09", Pierce-2.79", Avalon-2.15", Opid Camp-6.22", Lytel Creek-5.35", Big Bear-1.49" (no snow), Palm Sprs-.90", San Diego-1.62" and Palomar-4.38".
- 13-Barometer rose to 30.22" at 11am, high for the month.
- 16-Began to sprinkle after 8am with T"
- 17-Gusty SE winds came up at 10:30am as clouds increased and hit 20 mph at 12:34pm. At 2pm occasional lite rain began as winds ended. With winds, high climbed to 72°, the warmest day since the 4th. Had .27" by 5pm.
- 18-Occasional lite rain fell after 4am becoming brief heavy from 11am to 11:20a with .32" falling. Gusty SE winds blew all day to 22 mph at 8:01am and 3:38 Rain became showery after 2pm with 1.09" more since 5pm yesterday or storm total so far of 1.36". Rain was from stalled upper low off San Francisco. Rain came thru in periods.
- 19-Thunderstorm began at midnite to 12:30am, 2:40am to 3:14am with closest at 1 2/5 mile at 2:44am and another around 3:35am to 4am mostly 6 miles to SW. In the morning had a roll of thunder at 8:40am and 10:29 to 10:33am. Showers continued, heavy, from 10:45 to 11am with .42". Showers ended briefly and the sun came out from 1:30 to 3:45pm and showers began again. Had 2.12" by 5pm since 5pm yesterday for storm total of 3.48" so far. Around 11pm the 7th thunderstorm of the day rolled over with closest lightning at 1 2/5 mile SW followed by heavy rain as lite rain had begun again at 8:45pm and ended by 11:45pm.
- 20-At 1am rain began again, brief heavy at times, until skies broke at 7:45am. Had 1.65" overnight since 5pm yesterday for a storm total so far of 5.13". Had some sun then clouded up again with sprinkles after 1pm and lite rain after 3pm. By 5pm had .13" during the day or 1.78" since 5pm yesterday or storm total of 5.26". Rain and SE winds increased after 8pm. Had an inch between 10pm and midnite.
- 21-Moderate rain continued in the early morning with another inch by 3am then let up some with 2.85" by 8am since 5pm yesterday for 8.11" storm total. Had no rain and skies broke from 10 to 11:40am and again from 12:30 to 2pm. At 2:43pm a thunderstorm began with moderate to heavy rain falling with 1.21" in half hour (3-3:30pm). Second highest of record. Rainfall was unreal. Had over 25 lightning strikes by 3:45pm as ended and moved NE. By 5pm had received 4.36" since 5pm yesterday for 9.62" storm total so far. With this amount became the wettest season of record with 49.59". Old record was 49.46" for all of 1982-83 season. Month total is now 12.08". Many areas had flood and mud damage. Several people died in mud and rock slides into homes. At 5pm occasional lite rain began again ending by 6:30pm and began again at 10:30pm. Waterspouts were seen off the coast and a couple tornados hit northern Sacramento.
- 22-Showers, some brief heavy fell until 3:15am, then again at 7:30-8am with .65 overnight since 5pm. Showers fell the rest of the day with .36" more or 1.01 since 5pm yesterday to 5pm. Storm total is now 10.63". Flooding and bad slides of homes continued. Lite rain began at 9:30pm.
- 23-Moderate rain began at midnite to 2am with .67" in 2 hours. Became showery until 11am with 1.00" since 5pm for storm total of a whopping 11.63" as ended. February total is now 14.09", the 4th wettest. January-February total is 31.07", second behind 1969 with 32.10" and the Dec to Feb. total is a record with 41.04". Office-12.53", Burbk-6.88", LA-9.14", LAX-4.48", Chatsworth-9.79", Bev Crab-13.45", Riverside-5.19" and Opid Camp-22.20".
- 25-Cbs built in the late morning with a thunderstorm from 3:15 to 4pm with T" rain but heavier amounts in valley with .01" Burbk, .31" Northridge, .30", Chatsworth and .72" Van Nuys.

3-Fog in morning to 7am.

5-Approaching weak upper low began with occ'l lite rain after 5:45am and .15" by 5pm. Had brief moderate rain at 9:30pm with showers generally ending by 10pm and .16" more for .31" storm total.

6-Had .01" more at 1am with .32" storm total. Totals were very spotty with office-.11", Burbk-.15", Pierce-.12", LA-.01", LAX-.19", Avalon-.0, Mt Wilson-.96", Ontario-.45", Riverside-.40", Arrowhd-1.10" and deserts-0

9-Another weak storm with heavy drizzle from 10am to 12:30pm with .03" falling. Amounts ranged alot with office-T", Burbk-.04", Pierce-.14", Avalon-.0, LA-.18", LAX-.14", Malibu-.25", Mt. Wilson-.05", Arrowhd-.16", Big Bear-.01" with most areas in Orange Cty and south-0. Heavy snows for May hit Sierras with 2" Truckee, 12" Squaw Valley, 5" Tuolumne Mdws, 14" Tioga Pass and T" Lee Vining.

10-Low of 43° set a date record low by 1° last set just 2 yrs ago. Was also a all Glendale record. Gusty NW winds blew most of day to 19 mph at 9am.

13-High of 88° was the warmest day since Oct. 14 (7 months). Was 90° Burbk, 94° Pierce, 91° Simi Valley, 92° Riverside, 90° Santa Ana and 90° Palm Sprs.

16-What a change. 85° yesterday and a high of 64° today due to stratus cover all day. After 3:30pm had occ'l sprinkles and even brief lite rain at 5:30pm all only a trace. Heavier amounts fell to north with up to 2" in Sierras and 4" snow above 9,000 ft. Yosemite Valley was flooded with all roads

- closed. Merced River was 3 feet above flood stage. Barometer fell to 29.82" at 5pm, low for the month.
- 19-High of 88° set a date record by 1° last set in 1986 and 1988. Tied with 195 as the all Glendale record for the date. Was the first date record high since January.
