- 5-38° low but was very cold elsewhere with 35° Burbk, 29° Pierce, 19° Lancaster, 38° Redondo Bch, 23° Riverside, 14° Wrightwood, 18° Lk Arrowhd, 17° Hesperia and 5° BB
- 8-At 7:50pm had a lite 3 second EARTHQUAKE. Was 4.5 centered 1 mile south San Berdu.
- 9-NW winds in early morn hit 17 mph at 5:57am then ended and a stratus deck tops with fog moved in then moved back after 7:15pm.
- 10-NE winds came up after noon to 24 mph at 1:52pm then died down. Barometer rose to 30.40" at 10am, high for month and for 7 yrs in Jan.
- 11-Lite NE winds came up at 1:50am ending by 9am. Came up again abruptly at 4:30 hitting 24 mph at 6pm.
- 12-High of 87° was a date record by 1° set in 1996. All Glendale record too by same number. Was only 2° shy of tying the Jan. record. Was the month high. Low of 61 was the warmest Jan. minimum in 6 yrs. Continued NE winds hit 17 mph at 4:45am and ending at 9am. Came up again at 2:30pm hitting 26 mph at 4:25pm and continued. Was 87° Burbk, 89° Pasadena, 81° Pierce, 88° LA, 84° LAX and 87° Long Bch.

4-SE winds blew from 9am to 3:30pm hitting 17 mph at 10:55am

5-Lite rain after 1:30pm with .63" by 5pm. Continued showers to lite rain conti into the evening. SE winds hit 18 mph in afternoon.

6-Rain continued overnite to let up by noon but came up again after 3pm with 1.5 by 5pm since 5pm yesterday or storm total so far of 2.15". Rain continued mod at times until ended at 11pm with 1.27" more or 3.47" storm total. SE winds blew most of the day to 20 mph at 7:35am and 22 mph at 5:35pm. High of only 50° was coolest for Feb. in 7 years.

7-Had a brief shower from 7 to 8am of .03"

8-Showers fell in the morning from 7am to 8am with .07". Another storm began at 11pm with .02" by midnite. LA-T", Pasa and Bur-.01", LAX-.34" and office since the 5th-3.49"

9-Rain fell most of the night then showers until skies broke at 2:15pm with .53" more for .55" storm total. At 1:12pm and 2pm had brief pea sized hail. Was first Feb hail in 8 years. Low of 38° was coldest morn in 2 weeks. Office-.29 Burbk-.39", Pasa-.51", LA-.48", LAX-.20", AValon-.20", Pierce-.39". Snow stuck on Lukens above 4,500 ft. Big Bear had 24" with avalanches on the Arctic Circle and 1.86". Idywild had 19" and Palomar-12". Death Valley had a whopping .96"

10-Low of 32° was the coldest morn since Feb., 2007 and for month. Set a date record by 3° set in 1999. Was a all Glendale record too by same numbers plus 1965. Was 39° Bur and Pasa, 31° Pierce, 20° Mt. Wilson, 26° Riverside, 9° Idywild

- 11-Low of 34° set a date record by 2° set in 1999 and 2001. Tied the all Glendale record including 1965.
- 12-Low of 37° set a date record by 3° set in 1978 and 1989 and 2001.
- 13-A fast approaching front brought showers after 7:45am then steady rain after 12:30pm until moderate briefly at frontal passage at 2:45pm, then tapered off rapidly and cleared by 4pm with .40" storm total. Had brief gusty NW winds at passage to 16 mph. Snow on Lukens down to 3,500 ft. Office-.34", Burbk-.26", Pasa-.50", Pierce-.19", LA-.26", LAX-.18", Avalon-.16" and Big Bear-.62". High of 47° was the coolest Feb. since 2001 and for any month since January of last year and was for month.
- 16-Steady rain began at 4am. Since 1952 had rained more times (24) on this date than any other date. Gusty SE winds came up after midnight hitting 27 mph at 4:10am. Had a wind shift at SW at 8:30am and hit 21 mph at 3:54pm. Steady rain ended at 9am then became showery with 1.07" by 5pm. Low of 38° was 8th day in row of temps in 30s. This tied for 2nd for most number of days in Feb Record is 12 in 2001. Had occ'l showers after 7pm ending by 10pm with .07" more. Baro fell to 29.79" at 8am, low for month.
- 17-Showers came up again after 2am becoming steady after 7am to 9am with another showers at noon. Had .39" by 5pm for last 24 hrs for 1.46" storm total. Another shower fell from 5:30 to 7pm of .02" for storm total of 1.48". Office 1.33", Burbk-1.70", Pasa-1.71", LA-1.41", LAX-1.60", Avalon-1.51", Lancaster-.77", Palm Sprs-.38". Heavy snow fell above 5,000 ft with 24" Mt. Wilson, 48" Big Bear, 18" IDywild, 7" Palomar, 8" Lebec and 13" Frazer Park.

- 19-Low of 43° was first day after 10 straight days of temps in 30s. High of 73° was warmest day in 15 days.
- 22-Peak wind was only 4 mph.
- 23-Low of 56° was the warmest morn in over a month (Jan.21) and for the month. From 7am to 10am had T" in occ'l sprinkles to lite showers. Most areas had 0 to T" with Avalon and Burbk-.02" and office-T"
- 28-After a 66° yesterday, high climbed to 82° for hottest day of month. High set a date record by 1° last set in 1999. Was 83° Burbk, 81° Pierce, 84° LA, 82° LAX, 86° Sta Monica Pier and 89° El Cajon.

- 2-Upper low off Oregon spun clouds and a shower system thru at 2pm to 2:30pm with .02". Office-.01", Burbk-.03", LA-T", LAX-T", Pierce-.03" and most other areas 0.
- 4-Lite showers began at 6:30am with steady rain from 8am to 10am then sprinkles to 4pm with .21". Had another shower at 5:30 to 7:15pm of .05" more or .26" storm total. Office-.23", Burbk-.38", LA-.25", LAX-.04", Avalon-.12", Pierce-.35", Mt. Wilson-.09", Big Bear-.01" and most other areas 0.
- 5-Low of 38° tied the date record with 1985, 2003 and 2006.
