- 1-Ac clouds were first clouds since July 17. Was 120° RMRC.
- 7-Heat continued with 96° hottest in 9 days. So far this month the first week has averaged 92.7° or 6½° above normal for August. Was 95° Pasadena, 102° San Berdo, 115° Palm Sprs, 117° RMRC, 122° Death Vly after a 96° low.
- 8-Hit 102° in Solvang.
- 9-Barometer went down to 29.72" at 6pm, low for the month.
- 10-First day of the month with the high below 90° with 87°. Was still hot else where tho with 113° RMRC, 114° Palm Sprs and 117° Death Vly. Deserts had a few showers with T" Thermal and .09" Needles.
- 12-Thunderstorms hit deserts including .19" at Borrego and .12" Idlywild, RMRC had a shower and thundershower from 1 to 1:40pm of T". *Hurkey Cr. Park-80*
- 14-High of 91° was 13th day this month of 90+, 4th highest for Aug. in last 19 years. Av. max., av. min. and average are all the warmest ever for Aug. with the av. max. 6.2° above the normal and av. min 3.7° above the normal.
- 15-First stratus in the morning of the month and in a long time. Was also the coolest morn so far this month and since July 25. High of 84° was coolest high since July 23.
- 16-Low of 53° was coolest morn since July 3. Was also the coolest Aug. temp since 1991 and only 1° from tying the Aug. record set in 1978-85-89. High of 81° was coolest day since July 4 and ended up being the coolest high for

- the month which tied as the warmest cool high for August along with 1981.
- 17-At 3:40pm had a lite, brief EARTHQUAKE. Some didn't feel it. Was a 5.4° centered 10 mile north of Ridgecrest.
- 20-Thunderstorms developed over the mtns and deserts with T° Borrego and Ther 01° RMRC, .03° Wrightwood, .04° Hesperia and Idlywild, .09° Imperial and .11° Big Bear. In the evening Rosamond reported .60" in 40 minutes w/Mojave.
- 21-Thunderstorms again in the mtns and deserts with .14° Cuyumaca, .25° Mt. Laguna, .63° Campo, .14° Wrightwood, .23° Bear Valley, T° Beaumont and 1.3 Blythe. Idlewild had 1" in 20 minutes for 1.20" total. Cabin had 1.03" in 1 hour with erosion. Barometer up to 30.09" at 11am, high for month.
- 22-Showers again in the mtns and deserts with T° Wrightwood and .03° Mt. Laguna
- 25-Lite EARTHQUAKE at 4:51pm. Was a 3.2 centered at 7 miles north of Sunland
- 28-High reached 98°, the 21st day of 90+ this month, a August record with 20 days in 1992. Was 100° Burbank, 102° Pasadena and Wld Hills, 99° LA, 114° Palm Sprs and 115° Death Vly and RMRC.
- 29-Hit 101° at 2:53pm. Hottest day of the month. Was 99° LA, 103° Burbank and Pasadena, 105° Wld Hills, 108° Hemet and 115° Palm Sprs and 118° RMRC. Beat the date record by 1° set in 1985.
- 31-After a 75° low, high climbed to 100°. Was 95° LA, 101° Burbank and Pasadena, 106° Wld Hills, 112° Palm Sprs, 117° RMRC and 119° Death Vly. Set date record by 4° set in 1985.

- 1-High hit 101°. Showers fell in San Deigo County from tropical air with .09" Imperial Bch, .14" Campo, .07" Mt. Laguna and .40" Cuyamaca Park with .01" Riverside, T" Palm Sprs and Beaumont and .22" Idlywild. *Death Vly hit 119°*
- 2-A 79° low was the warmest for Sep. since 1988, was warmest morning for any month since Oct., 1991. High climbed to 103° beating the date record by 1° set in 1992. This was 7th day this year so far of 100° or more, tying with 1985 as most in one year. Was 100° Pasadena, 104° Burbank, 106° Wdld Hills, Van Nuys and Riverside, 99° LA, 109° Plm Sprs, 116° RMRC and 117° Death Vly. At 7:15 to :30pm had a distant thunderstorm to NW. Had earlier hit LAX with T". Cbs built over the mtns and deserts with T" Riverside, .05" Beaumont, .20" San Berdo, .19" Big Bear, .18" cabin and .31" Idlywild with .03" Borrego, .07" Mt. Laguna and .79" Santa Isabel. The storm at Big Bear at 1pm dropped the temp 17° in 1 hour at the airport.
- 3-Has been above 90° for 14 days in a row with 97°. Thunderstorms hit southern mtns with 10" Idlywild, T" RMRC and .30" Mt. Laguna. *96° Lone Pine* Was 94° LA, 99° Burbank, 101° Pasadena and 103° Wdld Hills. *Deep Sprs College - 0.75", El Mirage - .04", 22 Rd/100 - .04", Anza - .67"*
- 5-Back up to 100°, the 8th day this year of 100+, a station RECORD. The last 9 days the av. high has been 99.4° 15° above normal. Was 99° Burbank, 102° Pasadena, 103° Wdld Hills, 102° Beaumont, 100° LA. Has been above 90° the last 16 days. The last 9 days average low is 73.6° (11° above normal.) *Deep Sprs 146°*
- 7-Broken Ac in the morning with virga in the area but cleared off in mid-morn. Wrightwood had .03", *Mecca - .02", Victorville - .10"* *had 10*

- 8-After 18 straight days of 90° the temp failed to reach 90° with the coolest day in 22 days with 85°. Mornings low of 65° was coolest in 2 weeks. Has been above 90° for 52 days so far this year, second only to 55 days the entire year of 1992. Average is 37 days a year.
- 13-High of 97° was 55<sup>th</sup> day this year of 90° tying the station record set in 1992. Hit 117° RMRC, high for the month.
- 14-Broke the record with 101° making 56 days this year of 90°. This was also the 4th day this month of 100° tying the all-time record set 4 other times: 8/94, 9/93, 8/92 and 9/84. Broke the date record by 3° set in 1989. Was 99° Burbank, 105° Wdld Hills and Riverside. IT's also been 60 days with no precip. Was the 9th day this year of 100°, a station RECORD. Baro 29.84"
- 18-Low of 55° was coolest morn in over a month. (Aug. 16)
- 20-Lite EARTHQUAKE at 4:27pm. Was a slight roll here but 5.5 near China Lake.
- 26-Stratus deck produced .01" drizzle in the morning until 9am. Was first moisture of any kind in 72 days (July 16). Many areas had T" with .01" Pasadena. High of 72° was coolest day since June 17.
- 28-Lite drizzle in morning again with T" from heavy stratus. High of 64° was coolest afternoon since June 16 and coolest Sep max. since 1988.
- 29-Low of 52° was coldest morn since July 16 and in 2 years for Sep.
- 30-Bodie dropped to 14°

- 3-60th day this year of 90° or more with 92°. Was 98° Pasadena, 96° Northridge, 91° Sta Monica Pier and Avalon with 96° San Luis Obispo and Paso Robles.
- 4-Barom-eter down to 29.82" at 7am, low for the month.
- 5-Very lite EARTHQUAKE at 9:47am. Was a 3.7 just SE of Simi Valley.
- 7-Low of 55° beat the date record low by 1° set 10 years ago.
- 8-Brief fog in morning.
- 11-Fog in morning with visibility at 500 feet.
- 15-Fog rolled in after 8am to 8:30am. Was 3rd fog day this month, most in Oct. since 1988.
- 20-Barometer rose to 30.22" at 10am, highest reading since last March and for Oct. since 1989.

- 8-Temp climbed to 86°. Was 86° Pasadena, 89° LA, 88° Sta Ana, 90° Chula Vista and 95° RMRC.
- 11-Drizzle hit some areas with T" office, El Toro with thunderstorms and hail up thru San Joaquin Valley. Winds in deserts hit 40 mph Palm Sprs and 69 mph Mojave. Barometer went up to 30.27" at 11am, high for month.
- 12-Rain began at 11:30am with occ'l moderate rain until ended at 1:45pm with .45" by 5pm. Showers began again at 5:30pm and increased becoming moderat after 8pm. Had gusty SE winds in morning up to 28 mph at 10:10am. Up north a tornado warning were out from Fresno to Ventura Counties with a

- tornado reported near Hanford. Barometer fell from 30.16" at 1am to 29.84" at 11pm.
- 13-Rain continued. Today is the 20th time in the last 45 years that rain has fallen on this date. 44% of the time, the most for any date in the year. Rain let up after and ended after 3am with 1.06" overnite to 7am for 1.53" storm total so far. As the day progressed showers began again at 2:30pm with .21" more by 5pm or 1.76" storm total so far. After 5pm moderate showers until ended at 9pm with .55" more or 2.29" storm total. At 4pm had a brief thunderstorm to north. - 21-Fog in morning. 4th day this month of fog, tieing March record set in 1985 and 1978 and is double the normal.
- 22-Drizzle from stratus in the early morning to 7am of .01". Few other areas had drizzle with T" LAX, .01" Wld Hills and .03" Riverside. Gusty winds hit deserts with 36 mph Lancaster, 40 mph Palm Sprs and 81 mph Mojave.
- 23-NW winds came up after 7:15am to 27 mph at 4:14pm, then died down at 7pm. Were gusty everywhere with 29 mph Burbank and Blythe, 37 mph LAX, 40 mph Palm Sprs and 50 mph Hedy.
- 26-NW winds came up again after 4am to 33 mph at 5:25am then ended by 9am and shifted to SW. Storm from the north hit deserts overnight with 1" snow at Big Bear and .07" and T" Wrightwood.
- 28-Drizzle began around 6am with T" by 8am but continued until 3pm when ended with .06" total.
