1-Hottest day of year so far with 97°. Low of 65° was warmest morn since July. Oddly, today's hi was only 1° shy of tying the date record and yesterday's lo set a date record low. Was 99° Burbank, 100° Wld Hills and Ontario, 101° Beaumont, 105° Hemet and 112° Palm Sprs.

2-Low of 70° was the warmest morn of the year so far and since last Oct. 8. High hit 101°, high for year so far and warmest day since Oct. 7. Beat the date record by 7° set in 1992. Humidity fell to 7% in the afternoon. Was 102° Burbank, 103° Pasadena, 104° Wld Hills, 98° LA, 106° San Berdu, 105° Beaumont, 112° Palm Sprs and Thermal and 120° Death Valley.

3-Low of 73° was wthe warmest morn of year so far and since a year ago on Aug. 25th. Hit 98° and beat the date record by 3° set in 1995. Thunderstorms hit mtns and deserts with .01" Big Bear, .25" cabin (.23" in 15 min.), .59" 29 Palms and .89" Landers in 15 min. Was 100° Burbank, 103° Pasadena, and Wld Hills, 105° Beaumont and Ontario and 111° Palm Sprs and 123° Death Vly.

4-High of 98° beat the date record by 3° set in 1978 and 1994. Was 101° Pasadena, 99° Burbank, 104° Wld Hills, 110° Hemet, 113° Palm Sprs and cabin had .02"

5-Low of 75° was warmest morn of year so far and since Sep. 1995. Was warmest Aug. morn in 2 years. Temp rose to 106° at 1pm, a record August high here beating the old record by 2° set exactly 3 years ago today. Was 3rd hottest temp ever recorded here. Was hottest day since July, 1995. Was 100° LA, 107° Pasadena, 108° Burbank, 110° Mark, 111° Van Nuys and Wld Hills, 100° Long Beach, 111° San Berdu, 113° Beaumont, 117° Palm Sprs, 112° RMRC, 121° Thermal

- 123° Death Valley with 105° Fallbrook, 107° Romona, 101° Julian, 118° El Centro
86° San Deigo and 88° cabin.
- 6-Low of 79° tied the August record hi minimum temp set in 1981. Was warmest
morn for any month since Sep., 1995. 'Cooled' off to 101 beating the date
record by 1° set back in 1983. Was 99° Burbank, 105° Pasadena, 110° Wdld Hills
98° LA, 92° LAX, 98° Newport Bch, 92° Alon, 109° Beaumont, 96° Mt. Wilson and
117° Palm Sprs.
- 7-Coollest day of month so far with 90°. Was still hot elsewhere with 99° Burbk
106° Wdld Hills, 107° Bakersfield, 111° Redding, 108° Sacramento, 102° Yosemite.
Cabin had .01" shower.
- 8-Desert had some severe thunderstorms in the afternoon with .01" Beaumont,
.03" Mt. Laguna and .75" 29 Palms.
- 9-Coollest day of month so far with only 80° high due to stratus cover to noon.
- 10-Drizzle in morn from heavy stratus with first August measurable rain since
1991 with .04" as ended by 9am. High of only 77° was 29° cooler than the
high 5 days ago. Was the coolest hi in 13 days. Was coolest Aug. high
since 1993. Most areas had 0 but El Toro-T", Fallbrook-T" and Vista-.06"
- 12-Low of 55° was coolest of month and only 1° from tying the date record and
3° from tying the August record.
- 16-High of only 75° due to stratus cover until 2pm was coolest Aug. high since
tying 1992. Was coolest day in 18 days. Was only 97° Palm Sprs.
- 19-A dieing tropical storm passed to the west bringing rain from San Fran
north but only humidity and heat here. Clouds actually topped the peaks
above 5,000 feet with 90° heat. At 5pm had humidity of 80%. Temps hit
94° Lompoc, 96° Sta Maria and 90° Vandenberg.
- 20-Tropical storm died over northern Calif. with near record Aug. rains with
.71" San Fran, 1.25" Oakland, 1.50" Vallejo, .88" Blue Cyn, 1.37" Mt.
Shasta, .68" Redding and 1.37" Big Sur.
- 21-Barometer up to 30.11" at 10am, high for month.
- 22-High of 99° beat the date record by 4° set last year. Was 94° Pasadena, 99°
Burbank, 100° Northridge, 103° Wdld Hills, 106° Hemet and 111° Palm Sprs.
- 31-Baro fell to 29.84" at 6pm, low for the month.

- 1-Strong thunderstorms hit deserts with flood east of 29 Palms washing out highway and winds at 100 mph. RMRC-.01", Idlwild-.38" and Borrego-.10"
 - 2-Ac deck moved over with .01" shower from 5:30 to 6am. Office had .03", the first measurable rain there in 197 days (Feb.17). Was also the first measurable Sep rain there since 1989. Strong thunderstorms hit many areas again including Solvang with .40" and power out. Sta Maria-.69", Vandenburg-.38", 1000Oaks-.11", Wld Hills and Redondo Bch-.01". Flooding hit Apply Valley, Beaumont, Lucerne Valley and Mojave. Around 5pm cabin had .62" in 10 minutes.
 - 3-In afternoon could see large Cbs over mtns to north. Some area had heavy rain including flooding at Red Rock Cyn with highway wash out and Park facilities losing some structures and homes.. Big Bear-.23", Cuyumaca Par .20", Campo-.68", Palm Sprs-.12", 29 Palms-.21".
 - 4-Hit 100, 4th day this year so far of 100+ tying for 8th place as most number of days. Was 7 short of date record set 9 years ago. Was 100° Burk, Long Beach and Fallbrook, 103° Pasadena, 102° Northridge, 98° LA, 105° River side and 103° Palm Sprs. Thunderstorms hit mtns and deserts again with flash flooding in Forest Falls area with 1.26" at Oak Glen and .05" Big Br

- 5-A few severe thunderstorms hit San Deigo County Mens , so of Palm Sprs and B,ker areas. Big Bear-.09" and Borrego-.26"
- 7-7th day in row above 90° with 94°. Max. temps so far running 10° above norma
- 9-9th day in row above 90° with 96°. Was 101° Wld Hills, 97° Burbk, 99° Pasaden
- 11-High of 84° was coolest day since Aug. 17
- 12-Hurricane Linda formed SW of Cabo and was strongest ever in eastern Pacifi with winds to 215 mph and barometer down to 900 mb.
- 14-Shower-rs from Linda fell to SE with .10" San Berdu, .02" Beaumont, .45" Big Bear, .24" cabin and T" Thermal.
- 15-Showers from Linda again fell to est with .01" Pasadena, .33" Monrovia, .0 Long Beach, .06" Mt. Wilson, .02" San Deigo, .27" San Berdu, .18" Fallbroo .82" Wrightwood, .52" Palomar and .26" Big Bear. Dry here but warm with 87°. Was 90° Lompoc, 85° Oxnard and 86° Sta Maria.
- 17-Had T" shower around 8am from Ac deck. A few other areas had T".
- 18-Had a T" shower around 11am from Ac deck. Heavier amounts fell to west with Chatsworth-.10", Wld Hills-.12" and Simi Valley-.11"
- 19-Snow fell down to shoreline at Tahoe with T". First of Fall.
- 20-Low of 57° and high of 80° were coolest of month and coolest in 5 weeks,
- 22-Hit 96° hottest day since 4th. Was 99° Pasadena, 97° Burbank, 95° LA, 99° Wdl Hills, 100° Simi Valley, 95° Sta Ana, 102° Riverside but only 101° Palm Sprs
- 23-Hit 98°, no a date record but 13th day this month of 90°, tying for 7th most number of Sep days in 21 years of records. Was 99° Burbank, 101° Pasadena, 100° Wld Hills, 99° LA, 104° Riverside, 102° Palm Sprs and 97° San Fran
- 24-Low of 76° was warmest morn of month so far and since Aug. 6. Barometer fell to 29.72" at 5pm, low for month and tying the Sep record low readin
- 25-Lite rain began around 4am from Hurricane Nora centered 300 miles south of Tijuana. with .20" by 8am as skies broke at 3pm had .37" more for .57" storm total so far. *Heart Bar Park received 3.40" today.*
- 26-Drizzle in early morn with .02" more for .59" storm total. *la Crea .05"* Office-.55", LA-.45", Pasadena-1.39", Wld Hills-.25", LAX-.27", Avalon-.23", Beaunt-.94", Mt. Wilson-1.79", Big Bear-.87", cabin-1.19", Daggett-.88", Death Valley-.91", Palm Sprs-1.73", Idyllwild-2.86", San Deigo-.80", Escondido -1.84", Julian-3.00", and the wet spot Mt. Laguna with 4.57". Yuma had nearly 3". Was wettest Sep here since 1989. Barometer went up to 30.13" at 11am, high for month and highest for Sep. in 7 years.
- 28-Heat returned again with 98°. Burbank-99°, Pasadena-101°, Wld Hills-101°, LA-96°, Riverside-101°, Sta Maria-97°, Lompoc-100°, Sta Ynez-105° and Palm Springs-102°.
- 30-Fog in morn.

- 1-Hot. Santa Ana conditions produced the hottest Nov. temp here ever with 96° Was hottest for all Glendale stations since 1962. Beat the date record by 8° set in 1981. Many date records were set. LA-98°, LAX-96°, Pasadena-97°, Burbk-99°, Torrance-100°, Wld Hills-93°, Oxnard-98°, Ojai-100°, Sta Barbara-90°, Lompoc-98°, Vandenberg-91° and Palm Sprs-97°.
- 2-Low of 73° was warmest min. ever for Nov. and tied all Glendale stations records set in 1966. Back up to 96° again beating the date record again by 8° set in 1981. Beat the all Glendale record by 3° set in 1962. Again many date records were set with Santa Barbara-97°, and broke a 1926 record, LA-99°, LAX-96°, Pasadena-97°, Burbank-102°, Wld Hills-94°, Long Bch-98°, Oxnard-98°, Pt. Magu-96°, Santa Ynez-104°, Goleta-95° and Palm Sprs-97°. Today's 90° temp was 49th day this yr of 90°, moving this calendar year into 4th place.
