- 1-Rain became showers again as tapered off to occasional mist. By 9am had .1" since midnite or 2.22" storm total so far. Had a few more showers including one at 6pm for .02" more. Two days totals; office-2.34", Prout-2.40", LA-1.44", LAX-1.27", Northridge-1.60", Beaumont-1.80", Mt. Wilson-6.10", Big Bear-.65", Lancaster-1.16", Plm Sprs-.87", Thermal-1.22", San Deigo-.65" and Mt. Laguna-2.69". Baro was at 29.84" at 1am, low for month.
- 3-Low of 48 was coolest morn since May 28. After 10pm had a few brief showers of .04" by midnite.
- 4-Had occ'l lite rain after 8am from upper low off coast with .09" by 11am when it ended. At 2pm started to sprinkle and a thunderstorm began to SE after 2:20pm with one strike at 2:46pm at 2/5 mile away. Moved over toward NW with considerable lightning and moderate to heavy rain from 2:35-2:55pm of .39". At 3:02-3:05pm had a lite rice-sized hail storm then ended. At 3:45pm lite rain began again with another thunderstorm beginning to ENE at 4pm until 4:30pm with closest at 1 1/2 mile north at 4:17pm. Had .65" storm total by 5pm as occ'l lite rain continued until ended at 9:30pm with .48" more or storm total of 1.13" so far.
- 5-Day dawned to scattered showers observed far to south with .02" here around 10am then rain from 1:30-4pm of .31" more for 1.46" storm total. This brought our season total to over 8", wettest since 1983 and 2nd wettest so far on stations 33 years of records. Office-.99", LA-.62", LAX-.42", Pasa-1.28", Northridge-.95", Beaumont-.98", Mt. Wilson-2.29", Big Bear-.75", Lancaster-1.07", Plm Sprs-.70", Thermal-.50", San Deigo-1.15", Palomar-2.02" with .45" Sta Barbra and 1.10" Bksfield. First snow hit mtns with 4" Big Bear and 6" Tram. Prout-2.40", La Crea-1.85", Crab-2.08", Descanso-2.44"

- 6-Around 2am had .02" more in a shower.
- 11-High of 81° was warmest day in 15 days and for month, which was 2nd coolest max on stations records.
- 13-Weak front produced lite rain from 9-10pm of .03". LA-.07", LAX-0, Pasa-.07", Prout-.05", San Berdu-.01", cabin-.01", Mt. Wilson-.03" with wet spot at El Toro-.22" and San Deigo-.07", Julian-.27".
- 14-After 3am gusty NW winds came up to 35 mph at 4:25am and ending by 7:30am. After 10:45pm wind shifted to NE. Mojave reported 50 mph in afternoon and 37 mph at Lancaster.
- 15-NE winds blew until 2am up to 28 mph at 12:35am. Raised temp 6°
- 17-Ac clouds from approaching front produced occ'l showers after 9:30am with .03" by 5pm. From 7-7:30pm had an apparent frontal passage with lite rain of .02" more then clearing. At 10pm steady lite rain began again and ended at 11:30pm with .15" more or storm total of .20". Office-.04", Prout-.25" LA-.02", Pasadena-.03", Beaumont-.14", Wld Hills-.04", San Berdu-.13", Mt. Wilson-.14", Big Bear-.14", Lancaster-.08", Plm Sprs-.02", with San Deigo-.06", Thermal-.11" and wet spot at National City-.28". *Chab-.22", LaPres-.2*
- 19-Baro went up to 30.32" at 11am, a station record high for Nov. and highest since Jan., 1986.
- 20-Weak front brought showers to Sta Maria-Bksfield, skipped us, then and then .05" to San Deigo County area.
- 25-A dry front passed over in early morn followed by gusty NE winds after 7:30am to 45 mph at 10am and ending by 3:45pm but coming up again after 7p to 35 mph at 9pm. Was cold in mtns with observer finding rime ice and drizzle in Tehachapis and 28° at 5,000' level. Big Bear had a 36 high.
- 26-NE winds continued until 2:30am hitting 20 mph at 1:30am.

4-After 8:30am SE winds came up increasing as the day wore on with occ'l drizzle after 10:30am with .12" by 5pm as the rain began becoming moderate with SE winds hitting 43 mph at 5:45pm. Baro. fell rapidly after 10am from 30.13" until wind shift and frontal passage at 6:50pm to 29.88" and rain ended abruptly and skies began to break. Winds hit 30 mph at Long Bch, 36 mph at LAX and 37 mph Bksfield. Had 1.03" more or storm total of 1.15". Office-1.64", Crab-1.46", Prout-1.68", Pasa-1.60", Wild Mills-1.25", Sean-0.77", LA-1.04", LAX-.65", Mt. Wilson-2.44", Lanc-.58", Flm Sp-T & RMRC-.15". Today measurable precip means that we had measurable precip every month this calendar year. First time in 33 yrs of records.

6-Drizzle began at 8pm from approaching weak front with .07" by midnite.

7-Drizzle ended by 3:30am with .05" more or .12" storm total. Cleared after daybreak but had occ'l fog from below until NW winds after 7:30am to 20 mph blew it away. Office-.07", LA-.03", LAX-.08", Pasa-.05", Wild Mills-.12", Sean-.02", Mt. Wilson-.36", Hig Br-.10" with deserts 0 and near nothing in San Diego County area but .20" Julian.

10-High of 80 was warmest day in 1 month.

12-SE winds came up after midnite to 30 mph then shifted to NE after daybreak and increased in afternoon to being very strong and gusty with power out at times after 7pm. Hit 83 mph at John Gregg home at 10:45pm. Baro fell to 29.77" at 6pm, lowest Dec. reading in 3 yrs and since last March. Was strongest wind since Jan, 1985 and Dec. wind since 1982, being 2nd strongest

HIT 82 mph at Carlsbad

- 13-Strong, cold NE winds conti. all night up to 79 mph at 2:45am then began to let up after daybreak but still to 44 mph at 12:50pm in occ'l strong gusts. From 7pm last night to 10:45am this morning had the power out 8 hrs. 36 min. High of a cold 55° under clear skies was coldest max since March. Wind chill here in the morning was +18°. Wind hit all areas with LAX-31 mph, Sta Monica-40 mph, Ontario-52 mph, Mt. Wilson-60 mph, Rialto-82 mph, Daguerre-40 mph, Plm Sprs-40 mph and El Toro-70 mph. Was cold everywhere too with Mt. Wilson-28/18, Big Bear 20/13.
- 14-NE winds conti to 51 mph at 1:30am and ended generally by 6am as temp fell to 36° at 7am. Coldest since March and 2nd coldest Dec. temp. Was 40° Burbk, 43° Pasa, 41° Avalon, 37° Wld Hills, 36° Lg Bch, 39° Plm Sprs, 18° Lancaster, 20° Mt. Wilson, 22° Beaumont, 13° Big Bear and Mt. Laguna and 37° San Deigo. El Pasa, Texas had 22" of snow in 24 hrs breaking all records.
- 15-Cold, conti with 36° low here with 38° Burbk, 36° Pasa, 32° Wld Hills, 29° San Berdu, 28° Plm Sprs, 27° Thermal, 19° Lancaster, 25° Mt. Wilson and 10° Big Bear with 38° San Deigo, 19° Campo and 27° El Centro. SE winds came up after 8pm to 37 mph by 10:55pm.
- 16-SE winds conti all nite to 42 mph at 6:15am as a very lite rain began. Was very cold with temp falling from 47° at 6am to 38° at 10am with snow in La Crescenta falling above 2,000' and sticking above 2,300'. Had .03" by 7am as wind and rain continued. During the day had several gusts to 40mph. Had .51" total by 5pm. Snow closed Tejon Pass, Antelope Vly freeway and Cajon Pass briefly. Mulholland Drive reported snow above Malibu sticking. Snow fell most of the afternoon at Victorville, Lancaster and China Lake with 6" Lancaster and 4" Big Pine. ^{Lake Hughes 2"} Winds hit all areas with Burbk-35 mph, Vandenburg-44 mph, LAX-44 mph, Sta Barbara-46 mph, Bksfield-47 mph, Sta Monica-58 mph, Pt. Arguello-70 mph and 100 mph at Wheeler Ridge near the Grapevine. High of 47° at 6am was the coldest since March and coldest Dec. high ever. Was 45° Pasa, 43° Wld Hills, 38° Beaumont, 30° Mt. Wilson and 52° Palm Sprs. All highest temps.
- 17-Winds shifted to NE and hit 27 mph until 1:10am and ended by 2am. Occ'l showers conti all nite with .13" more by 8am and .10" more during day until ended at 4pm with .23" since 5pm yesterday or .74" storm total. Snow level rose to 4,500' with 15 cm sed with 18" at Lebec. Antelope Vly freeway was only partially open. ^{Lancaster 3" Lake-1" Big Bear 2" Mt. Wilson 3" San Deigo 2"} Big Bear had 12" and Tram 18". Baro fell to 29.65" at 5am, low for the month. Office-.51", P. out-.87", LA-.46", LAX-.85", Wld Hills-1.63", Beau-.30", Avalon-2.13" was wet spot, Lanc-.47", Plm Sprs-.60", RMRC-.50", Mt. Wilson-1.45", Big Br-1.17" with San Deigo-1.55".
- 19-Surprise rain shower began at 11:45am ending at 12:30pm with .11". Office-.04", ^{LA-0} LA-0, Pasa-.02", Beau-.01", Big Bear-T", Plm Sp-T", RMRC-.02", San Deigo-.19" and Ramona-.42". Observer drove to Lebec and found snow on the ground above 2,300' with drifts to 6 feet in Gorman area from windy conditions in the 17th storm. ^{Bishop had 2"}
- 22-Weak front went over with sprinkles of T" from 8-8:30pm followed by NW wind after 9:15pm to 27 mph at 11:05pm. Most areas had nothing except .21" San Berdu, .12" Beau, .11" Big Bear and .27" cabin.
- 23-NW winds blew until 5am up to 35 mph at 1:25am and conti all day then shift to NE after 9pm and increased. At 11pm had a temp of 38° and wind gusting to 44 mph at 10:50pm for wind chill of +8.
- 24-NE winds conti all nite up to 40 mph with low of 35°, coolest since Feb and coldest Dec temp in 9 years. With wind the wind chill dropped into +10° range. Wind conti all day and into evening hitting 52 mph at 9:25am. Scat to brief broken clouds over mtns produced snow showers with 2" Waterman & Big Bear areas. Lows this morn included 38° Pasa, 37° Avalon, 28° San Juan, 25° Beau, 22° Lanc, 23° Sta Maria, 15° Mt. Wilson with 23° high and 5° Big Bear with 15° high and cabin 9/19° and RMRC 39/52° and Tram -2°. Winds hit 35 mph Ontario and 40 mph LAX. ^{Crook Tree-40 mph @ 35° low.}
- 25-NE winds conti up to 52 mph at 7:50am and finally ended at 6:45pm. after 59 hrs 45 minutes of constant wind. Low of 34° was coldest Dec in 9 yrs. Was bitter cold all over the west with 35° Burbk, 38° Pasa, 25° Wld Hills, 27° Sta Barbara, 23° Sta Maria, 21° Beau, 37° Newpt Bch, 14° Mt. Wilson, 7° Big Bear, 36° Plm Sprs, 34° San Deigo which was only 2° from tying the all time low set 109 yrs ago. Was 29° Del Mar, 15° Campo, 17° Palomar and 9° Mt. Laguna. ^{Crook Tree was 38/47°}

- 25 conti-Hit -5° Mammoth, -2° Tahoe. Snow fell all morn at Tuscon, Douglas and El Paso. Was 6° at Reno, 0° SLC and the 20° at Fresno was coldest in 12 yrs. Nation low was -30° at Laramie. Winds hit 30 mph LAX, 45 mph at San Berdu and 29 mph Plm Sprs. *30 mph Crabtree*
- 26-Low of 34° tied monthly record of temps in 30s at 7, set Feb and Mar, 1985. Was a Dec record. Was ice until noon down on Beaudry as temp fell well below 32° in many areas with *32°* Pasa, 27° Burbk, 34° LAX, 26° Wld Hills, 21° Beau, 17° Lanc, 27° Sta Barbara, 28° Plm Sprs and 27° RMRC and -1° Big Bear and 11° at cabin. Baro rose to 30.30" at 11am, high for the month.
- 27-Cold again with 35° low and 34° Burbk, 37° LAX, 19° Lancaster, 28° Plm Sprs, 27° RMRC, 27° Indio, 20° Thermal and 16° Yucca Vly.
- 29-Surprise weak front increased clouds rapidly after 10am with occ'l sprinkles then a thunderstorm at noon along with brief lite hail until 12:30pm with main storm to the east. Showers ended by 2:30pm with .30" storm total. High of 53° was reached at 10am then fell to days low of 39° at 1pm in the storm. Office-.33", Prout-.26", B.Crab-.29", Pasa-.12", LA-.23", LAX-.17", Wld Hills-.48", San Berdu-.44", Beau-.0, Mt. Wilson-.67", Big Bear-.98", cabin-.57", Lanc-.42", RMRC-.01". Snow fell down to 2,500' with Ridge Route briefly closed and 6" Big Bear. *Llano-1", Palmdale-4", Devils Punchbowl-3", Arroyo-4", Tehachas*
- 30-Fell to 34° again with 35° Pasa, 34° Burbk, 39° LAX and 19° Lancaster.
- 31-With of 36° low, this was the 12th day this month of temps below 40° beating any other month by 5days. Was also the 9th day in a row. Went down to 33° Burbk, 34° Pasa, but bitter cold in mtns with the -8° at Big Bear the coldest Dec. since 1960 and 5th coldest Dec temps in 78 yrs of records. Was +4° at cabin, a Dec. record and coldest day in nearly 3 yrs. Was -2° Mammoth and -20° Tahoe with +8° Bishop, lowest since Dec, 1984 and -9° at Ricks. *Was -25° Bridgeport - state low for month.*

Rainfall was normal. Was windiest average max. speed in 5 yrs. The average temp was 6° below normal and coldest Dec ever. It tied Jan. 1979 for any month. 92° Woodl'd Hills, 96° San Berdu and 98° El Toro.

6-High of 90° beat the date record by 11° set in 1981. Was 93° Pasadena, 94° Wldl Hills, 98° San Berdu, 89° Solvang, 104° Palm Sprs and 106° RMRC. Was 72° even at Tahoe Valley and 79° at cabin. Has been 36 days now without a drop of rain by far a March-April record.

10-6th day in a row of 80+ with 89°. In San Fran was 91°, hottest April EVER.

Low of 64° tied the April warmest min. temp.

12-8th day in a row of 80+ with 81°.

13-Thunderstorms and showers hit mtns and deserts with .18" Beaumont and Palm Sprs and .10" Big Bear.

14-Around 1am the first moisture in 44 days began with lite rain most of the day with .76" by 5pm. Ended near midnite with .21" more for .97" storm total. This was wettest April in 5 yrs. Office-.63", Prout-1.03", Bob C-.90", LA-.42", LAX-.46", Pasa-.71", Lg Bch-.10", Wldl Hills-.85", Beau-.10", Big Bear-.74", Mt. Wilson-2.70", Lanc-.27", Plm Sprs-.13" with 1.11" at Mt. Laguna, .70" San Deigo and 1.40" Mt. Palomar. Had NW winds to 32mph at 1:30pm. High of 54° was coolest afternoon since Feb.29. Big Bear had a few inches of snow. La Cree-.94", Crystal Lk-3.20", Lk Arrowhead-3.06".

15-Showers conti. in deserts with a whopping 1.73" at Death Vly. Low of 41° was coolest morning since Feb.23.

- 19-Had a drizzle in early morning of .01" by 8am with a few more showers until 11am with .01" more or .02" total. At 4:30pm began to sprinkle with T" more by 5pm as a lite rain began. At 10:45pm had an abrupt wind shift from SE to SW hitting 32 mph at 11pm then decreasing with rain, moderate from 7 to 8pm, letting up at midnite with 1.73" or 1.75" storm total. At wind shift the temp fell 6° immediately.
- 20-Occ'l lite rain ended by 6:30am with 1.99" since 5pm to 7am or 2.01" storm total so far. Showered again in morning ending by noon then another shower from 4-5pm for .19" more during day or 2.20" storm total. Snow stuck above 5,000 ft with 5" Big Bear and 3" Mt. Wilson. - 1-NW winds continued most of day with 31 mph at 1:20pm. Was cold in mtns with 23° Big Bear, 24° cabin and was 2nd coldest May for station with a 24° at Mt. Wilson and Mt. Laguna and 29° Palomar. Was 20° at top of Tram, coolest May in 5 yrs.
- 2-Baro went up to 30.22" at 11am, a May record high. Have set barometer high for 4 of last 5 months and 5 of last 7 months.
- 5-Upper low off central Cal. produced sprinkles from 7-8am of T" with beautiful cumulus skies in the afternoon. Measurable precip fell at Beaumont-.09", Lancaster-.04" and Riverside-.02" with .63" at Big Bear in snow with more precip in San Deigo County with .03" San Deigo, .10" Mt. Laguna with snow and .35" Cuyumaca Park in snow. Winds hit 42 mph at RMRC and high of only 72° was station low max for May. Tram had 3" of snow. *The 1/2" of snow at 8:30pm was the highest in last 4 yrs.*
- 6-Low of 40° was coldest May morn for station and coldest Glendale temp in 20 years. Was coldest morn since Jan. 20. Was 49° LAX, 45° Pasadena, 40° Beaumont 38° Lancaster, 24° Mt. Wilson and 22° at Big Bear which was the coldest May temp since 1975. Cabin hit 23°, coldest May in 13 years. Was 15° at Mammoth Ranger Station. Baro went up to 30.19" at noon and this was another record high for the month. In last 7 months, 5 are new records. *low of 46° at 8:30pm, was all time low for May.*
- 7-Upper trough went over after 5pm with lite rain for an hour of .08". Most areas had nothing but Pasadena-.02", San Berdu-.04", Prout-.14" and Mt. Wilson-.11" and office-T". Showers hit foothills above Sta Barbara and Solvang around noon. Over last 3 days northern and central Cal has received .37" San Fran, .15" Sta Maria, .45" Fresno, .78" Napa, 1.40" Redding and 1.73" Shelter Cover

- 10-High of 90° was warmest day in nearly a month. Was 89° LA, 93° Pasadena and really warmed up in deserts with 101° Blythe, 105° Borrego and 106° Plm Sprs and Thermal. Low of 59° was warmest morn in a month.
- 11-Summer arrived. High of 94° was hottest May temp in 4 yrs and 2nd warmest in last 9 years. Was warmest day since Oct, 1987. Was 91° Pasadena & LA, 103° Northridge, 101° San Berdu, only 69° Avalon and 67° Sta Monica but 110° Borrego, 109° Thermal and nation hot spot and warmest May in 4 years at Plm Springs with 112°. RMRC was 111° at station record for earliest temp above 110°. Cabin hit 83°.
- 12-Heat conti. with 94° high. Was 93° Pasadena, 100° Northridge, 92° Sta Barbara and 112° Plm Sprs, Thermal and RMRC, all hottest spots in the US.
- 17-Weak front moved down the coast last nite with only wind in the deserts here but .11" San Fran, .60" Blue Cyn and 1.82" Redding.
- 19-Temp of 53° to 87° both tied the date records for the coolest and warmest May 19th. Low was set 7 years ago and high 2 years ago.
- 20-Hit 92° with 95° Pasadena, 100° Northridge, Wld Hills and San Berdu with 92° San Francisco.
- 21-High of 94° was 5th day this month of 90+, a station record. Was 109° RMRC.
- 28-Cloudy skies all day brought coolest high of 64° in 3 weeks. After 11pm occ'l lite rain began.
- 29-Rare very cold air mass produced showers in early morning hours of .04" and brought very strong NW winds after 7am to 48 mph at 8:50pm. Strongest May winds in 4 years. Cabin at Big Bear had snow begin around 5am, becoming moderate around 9am and continued off and on until 4pm for ½" on the ground and .20" of precip. High was only 39°. Was latest snowfall in 26 years. Precip was spotty everywhere with T" LAX and Lancaster, .05" San Berdu, .08" Bks-field, .08" Big Bear and .33" Beaumont and .05" San Deigo, .57" Julian and wet spot 1.00" at Palomar. - 30-NW winds ended by 4am but gusted during day briefly to 30 mph at 1:15pm.

- 5-Low of 47° tied the June record low set in 1985 and 1980. Was coolest day in nearly a month. High of 69° was coolest June day in 3 years. Was 50° Pasadena, 49° Wld Hills, 34° Mt. Wilson but 46° Big Bear.
- 6-Cool air continued with a 49° low. High of 65° was coolest max. in 4 years. Was 52° Pasadena, 44° Wld Hills, 31° Mt. Wilson, & 29° Big Bear. Up north rain showers continued and Tahoe had brief lite snow this morning. Lows included 37° Paso Robles, 30° Mammoth, 24° Tahoe and nation low of 22° at Truckee. ^{note +6}
- 7-Low of 44° was coldest June ever in stations records and coldest in area since 1971. Was 46° Pasadena, 43° Wld Hills, 32° Mt. Wilson, 29° Bishop and the 26° at Big Bear was coldest in 6 yrs and second coldest in 17 years. Was 32° Cuyumaca Park and 27° Julian. Went down to 49° at RMRC, a station record low. Rain continued in central and north Calif. with over 1" in several areas & 24° low at Mammoth, the nation low. Had .70" at San Fran and 1.27" Red Bluff Baro went up to 30.15" at 11am, highest June reading in 4 years.
- 8-Low of 47° was 4th day this month of temps in 40s, a station record. was 46° Pasadena, 45° Wld Hills, 38° Beaumont and 27° Big Bear. Went down to 23° Mammt a nation low was 22° at Tahoe and Truckee.
- 9-Upper low continued off northern Calif with 1.25" at Crescent City and was 21" at South Tahoe.
- 17-Cool weather continued with 52° low. We have tied or broken the low date records for 7 of last 17 June days. Av. low is 5° below normal and a record low so far. High of 70° was coolest in 11 days.

- 18-A rare June thunderstorm began at 8:31pm to SW until 8:45pm with closest lightning at 1 3/5 mile but was mostly cloud to cloud. From 8:40-:45pm had T" sprinkle. Was caused by upper low SW of San Deigo and brought T" amount to southern deserts and mountains. Was first moisture in 3 weeks. Beaumont had .08" with .01" Wld Hills and San Berdu and T" RMRC.
- 19-Some areas again had thunderstorms particularly central Cal and Tehacapi areas. *Tehachapi-.08"*
- 20-Shows hit RMRC in early morn with .03" *Indio-.08"*
- 23-Upper low off coast caused thunderstorms and rain to hit the Big Bear area including Thermal and Death Vly in the morning then touched off thunderstorm in Barstow region all afternoon and also the Sta Barbara area with .03" & Solvang with .11" including hail. Was clear here. *Los Angeles-.19" Ojai-.19"*
- 24-Thunderstorms hit Sta Barbara mtn areas again in the evening.
