- 4-Upper low over Baja brought a band of showers over the area with T" showers from 6am to noon then cleared. Most areas had 0 but LAX-.03", LA-.01", Pierce Newport-.08", San Diego-.05", Mt. Wilson-.03", Wrightwood-.10", Palomar-.14" and Palm Sprs-T".
- 11-A weak storm brought brief moderate rain from 2:20am to 2:40am of .10" then drizzle and showers until 1:30pm with .20" as cleared. Office-.07", Burbk-.06" Pasadena-0, LA-.03", Pierce-.05", Ontario-T", Newport-.05", Mt. Wilson-.21", Wrightwood-.01", Palomar-.05" with most other areas to east and south with 0.
- 12-After 1pm had occ'l sprinkles from approaching storm along with increasing SE winds with T" by 5pm. At 5:20pm moderate rain began, occ'lly heavy, until abruptly ended at 6:45pm and cleared. Had .71" in 1½ hrs. SE winds hit 32 mph at 5:18pm. Was heaviest rain since April 21. Office-.63", Burbk-.64", Pasadn .65", LA-.35", LAX-.35", Pierce-.50", Avalon-.23", Mt. Wilson-.53", Riverside=.35", Big Bear-.34", Lancaster-.34", Palm Sprs-0, Palomar-.29" & San Diego-.19 First snow of the season fell in Sierras with Tioga Pass closed.
- 19-Barometer rose to 30.22" at 11am, high for the month. Was the lowest high baro pressure since 1983 for November.
- 23-Gusty NW winds came up in the early morning up to 29 mph at 2:32am.
- 24-Began to drizzle from approaching storm with lite rain beginning at 2pm. SE winds began at 9am. Rain became moderate to heavy after 4pm until let up at

4:45pm with 1.30" storm total so far by 5pm. SE winds increased to 31 mph at 4pm. At 4:30pm had a wind shift to NW. Rain ended by 6:15pm with .22" more or 1.52" storm total. Was the wettest storm since Feb.24-26. From 4:30 to 4:45pm had .44" fall in 15 minutes. Barometer fell from 30.02" at 11am to 29.83" at 4pm. This was the month low reading.

- 25=Office-1.74", Pasadena-1.00", Burbk-0.83", LA-.55", LAX-.60", Pierce-.59", Avalon-.57", Mt. Wilson-1.16", Crytal Lk-1.32", Big Bear-.77", cabin-1.04" with 1" snow, Ontario-1.14", San Diego-.40". Big Bear mtns had lite snow above 4,000 ft in the early morning. Low here of 38° beat the date record by 4° in 1988 and the all Glendale record by 2° set in 1965. Tied for the 3rd coldest Nov. temp here. Was 27° Mt. Wilson, 38° Ojai, 37° Simi and 24° cabin. Seasons first heavy snow hit Sierras with 6" Bridgeport, 8" Mammoth RS, 36" Mammoth Mtn and 16" Tahoe City.
- 26-At 6pm NE winds came up to 32 mph by 8:17pm and dropping the wind chill to 31° Was cold in Calif with 27° Arrowhead, 21° Big Bear, 18° Big Bear RS, 26° Hesperia, 26° Yosemite, 13° Shaver Lake, 20° Bishop, 19° Pine Mtn, 4° Tuolumne Mtns and South Tahoe, 5° Mammoth RS and -13° Bodie.
- 27-Was cold again in Calif with 20° Oakhurst, 11° Shaver Lk, 10° Lodgepole, 13° Bear Valley and 22° Idyllwild. NE winds came up in the early morn hitting 35 mph at 6:30am along with a wind chill of 29°. Continued to increase to 47 mph at 10:04am then slowly decreased during the rest of the day and ending by dark.
- 28-Low of 40° beat the date record by 1° set in 1994 and tied the all Glendale record last set in 1960.
- 29-At 5am lite rain began from an approaching storm that was supposed to be heavy but fizzled out to only .13" when ended at 1pm and skies cleared. Had SE wind to 23 mph at 10:54am. Office-.15", Pasadena-.15", Burbk-.12", Pierce-.29", LA-.24", LAX-.30", Avalon-.67", Newport Bch-.56", San Diego-.12", Riverside-.01", Big Bear-.17" and 1" snow and Palomar-.20". Low of 41° set a date record low 1° last set in 1998. High of 50° was the coolest Nov. max since tying with 1985.
- 30-Low of 40° set a date record low by 1° last set in 1985.

Clear days-4, Cloudy days-3, partly cloudy days-23

Days with NE winds-3 Rain was 0.42" above normal, temps were 3.2° below normal. Av. max temp was 4.9° below normal. Set 4 date record lows. Was the cloudiest Nov. since 1988.

- 2-At 6pm light showers to drizzle began occasionally with light rain beginning at 11:15pm with .05" by midnite.
- 3-Lite rain continued until 4:30am as skies began to break with .34" more for .39 storm total. Just this small amount made this the wettest Dec. in 3 years. Office-.22", Burbk-.12", Pasadena-.15", LA-.28", LAX-.23", Ontario-.28", Mt. Wilson-.77", Palm Sprs-T" and San Diego-.09"
- 4-Low of 40° tied the station and the all Glendale record low set 5 times before in 1956, 1964, 1967, 1971 and 1983.
- 5-Barometer rose to 30.33" at 9am, highest since January.
- 7-At mid morn NE winds came up increasing to 45 mph at 3:22pm then slowly calmed but still to 34 mph at 6:23pm. Temp climbed to 79°, warmest day of month and since Nov. 8. Winds hit 49 mph at Saugus, 53 mph Chilao and 62 mph Warm Sprs Mtn. Was 82° Burbk and Newport Bch, 85° Long Beach and 79° Palm Sprs.
- 8-NE winds continued in the early morn to 26 mph at 1:53am and ended by 4:30am.
- 9-Clear all day became suddenly cloudy in the late afternoon as upper low drifted over the area from central Calif. Lite rain began at 5:10pm along with one roll of thunder at 5:17pm and one mile NW. Was first Dec. thunderstorm in 7 yrs. At 6:10pm a active thunderstorm began one mile SE with frequent lightning. At 6:12pm a moderate rice-sized hail storm began covering the ground briefly until

ended at 6:20pm but moderate rain continued. Was first Dec. hail in 14 yrs and only the 3rd hail in Dec. in 24 yrs of records. By 6:30pm had had .40" rain in 20 minutes. Rain let up and ended by 8pm for storm. Wind hit 24 mph at 7pm from NW wind the wind Chill down to 27°. Could see continued lightning far to SE until after 8:30pm. Station was the wet spot with some areas receiving 0. Office-.14", Burnk-.29", Pasadena-.01", LA-T", Northridge-.01", Mt. Wilson-.38", Big Bear-.07", Palomar-.40", San Diego-T" and Palm Sprs-T". A dusting of snow stuck on Lukens above 4,700 ft. with 1" Wrightwood and 3" Palomar.

- 10-Low of 36° beat the date record by 1° last set in 1985. Was the low for the mo and coldest Dec. in 3 yrs and since Apr. 10. Was 40° Pasadena, 36° Pomona, 37° Riverside, 34° Hemet, 24° Mt. Wilson, 23° Wrightwood and 17° Big Bear. Clouds increased after 11am with lite shower from 1 to 1:30pm of T". Barometer fell to 29.76" at 4pm.
 - 11-NE winds came up around 5am nitting 34 mph at 5:30am with a wind chill of 26°. Winds continued hitting 45 mph at 11:30am. Low of 38° tied the date record set in 1985. Was 39° Pasadena, 36° San Gabriel, 24° Mt. Wilson, 38° Santa Ana and 18° Big Bear. Shower fell to SE with .08" San Diego, .05" and 1" snow at Big Bear, .12" Palomar and 1" snow and T" Palm Sprs.
 - 13-Barometer rose to 30.33" at 9am.
 - 14-Weak front moved in with sprinkles after 8am and lite rain after 10am until ended by 2pm and cleared. Had .14" storm total. Office-.05", Burbk-T", Pasadena-.17", LA-.16", LAX-/23", Pierce-.09", Avalon-0, Mt. Wilson-.49" and Palm Sprs-.02". NW winds came up after 6:30pm to 23 mph by 7:39pm and dropping the wind chill to 27°. Winds then decreased. Barometer dropped rapidly from yesterday to 29.74" a 0.59" drop in 30 hours. Was the lowest Dec. reading in 4 years and for the month. High of only 46° was the coldest Dec. max in 6 yrs and only 1° from tieing record set in 1988.
 - 15-Winds shifted more NE at 4am and hit 31 mph at 5:11am with wind chill at 34°. Reached 32 mph at 7:21am then let up with a few more gusts during the day including 26 mph at 3:30pm, then ending.
 - 16-At 11am barometer went back up to 30.33", the 3rd time this month. High of only 61° was wthe warmest day in 8-days.
 - 20-Had drizzle from approaching weak storm begin at 11:30am with .01" by 12:30pm when skies broke. Lite rain began at 7:15pm. At 8:25pm thunderstorm began 4/5 mile NW wiht moderate rain. Ended by 8:50pm as it moved east. Was the 2nd thunderstorm day this month, tieing the Dec. record set in 1984. Showers continued with .53" storm total by midnite.
 - 21-Showrs contigued occasionally to lam then again from 6am to noon when skies broke with .09" more for .62" strom total. Office-.71", Pasadena-.65", Pierce .52", LA-.66", LAX-.13", Avalon-.38", Mt. Wilson-1.04" with 4" snow, Wrightwd-.68" with 3" snow, Palm Srs-.07", San Diego-.19" and Mt. LAguna-.75" with 3"sr
 - 22-Barometer rose over 30.33" for 3rd time this month to the month high of 30.34" at 10am.
 - 24-NE winds came up after midnite, hitting 43 mph at 4:07am then died down after daybreak.
 - 29-Rain began about 10am with lite rain occasionally all afternoon with .24" by 5pm. Showers ended by 5:30pm with .02" more. High for day was 52° at 4AM, low was 46° at 10AM.
 - 30-Had .01" shower around 2am for .27" storm total. At 4pm showrs began from anothr weak storm with .02" by 5pm and .01" more by 6pm when ended. For two da office-.32", Burbk-.26", Pasadena-.23", Northridge-.35", LA-.22", LAX-.29", Avalon-.27", Mt. Wilson-.63", Palmdale-.41" and Palm Sprs-.01"

- 2-At 9pm heavy drizzle began from a weak storm with lite rain from 11 to 11:30pm as storm ended with .07" total. Office-.07", Burbk-T', Pasadena-0, LA-.12", LAX-.14", Avalon-.02", Pierce-.22", Mt. Wilson-.08", Newport-.02", San Diego-.1 and Palm Sprs-T"
- 3-Had fog in the morn until 8:30am.
- 5-Barometer rose to 30.42" at 9am. highest Jan. reading since 1989 and second highest Jan reading of record (25 yrs). Was highest for any month since Dec. 1999. Only 6 other months in the last 295 months have had a higher reading.
- 7-High of 74° was the warmest day in exactly 1 month.
- 8-High of 79° was the warmest day since Dec. 7. Low of 59° was the warmest morn since Nov. 9. Only other spot warmer nearby was Northridge at 80°. Was 83° Riverside, 85° at Hemet as the US hot spot and 80° Palm Springs.
- 14-Barometer fell to 29.93" at 4pm, low for month.
- 16-Drizzle to lite rain in the ealry morn to 8:30am with .08", Office-.08", Pasadena-.13", Burbk-T', Simi Vly-.29", San Gabriel-.30" and wet spot at Haine Cyn with .55". Most other areas had T" to 0.
- 17-Temp fell to 41°, coldest morn since Dec. 23. Was 39° Burbk, 35° Van Nuys and Ri erside, 18° Lancaster, 29° Ojai, 14° Wrightwood, 19° Idlywild, 5° Big Bear, 6° Bear Valley, 11° FRazier Park and 6° Bishop.

- 18-Low of 39° was the coldest day since Dec. 22. Was 37° Burbk, 39° Pasadena, 10° Big Bear RS, 18° Lebec, & Edwards AFB and -13° Tuolumne Mds.
- 20-Low of 39° set a date record by 1° last set in 1990.
- 22-Dry front passed over in the late morning followed by gusty NW winds to 29 mph by 4:33pm.
- 23-NE winds blew all nite up to 47 mph at 5:11am. Wind chill fell to 19° with a 39° low. Continued in the morn reaching 56 mph at 12:42pm. Was the strongest Jan wind in 5 years and for any month since Mar., 2000. Wind let up after 5pm. Other gusts; Devore-48 mph, Chilao-52 mph with a 0° wind chill, Malibu-50 mph, Sandberg-53 mph and Big Bear RS-31 mph for -10° wind chill at 5pm. Was cold to Lancaster 21°, Mt. Wilson 22°, Wrightwood 11°, Big Bear RS 14°, Yosemite 22°, Bishop 16°, Bear Valley 10°, Frazier Park 12°, Mammoth Lakes -3°, South Tahoe -4°, Truckee -11°, South Lake -20° and Tuolumne Mds -17°.
- 24-NE wind continued in the early morn up to 19 mph at 1:46am. then ended by 8am and shifted to sw. Other wind gusts were; Chilao-72 mph, Devore-50 mph. Barometer rose to 30.42" at 10am, highest Jan reading since 1989 along with back on the 5th. Was the highest for any month since Dec., 1999.
- 27-Began to rain at 1pm from approaching front with .63" by 5pm and it continued. SE winds reached 26 mph by 6:10pm. Steady rain ended at 11:30pm with 1.01" mo since 5pm for storm total of 1.64". The wettest storm since 2/24-26/01.
- 28-Temp fell to 33°, coldest Jan since 1987 when reached 32°. Was coldest any day since Feb. Beat the date record by 4° set in 1999. At noon to 1pm showers fell with T" here but .01" office. Office-1.21", Pasadena-1.65", Pierce-.48" LA-.68", LAX-.49", Avalon-.23", Mt. Wilson-2.94", with deserts 0 and Big Bear with 3" snow. Up north, 2" at Redding of snow, T" snow Sacramento on ground, Eureka on the coast T" on ground, Los Gatos 2" snow and Petaluma 2" snow.
- 29-Low fell to 31, a record low for January here and coldest for any month since Dec., 23, 1990. Set a date record by 5° set in 1979 and a all Glendale record date by 1° set back in 1969. Clear in the morning then buildups in the afterno with showers in the area and could see snow showers over Mt. Wilson. No rain here, but LAX-.09", LA-.06", Mt. Wilson-.01", Santa Ana-.10", Oceanside-.26" San Diego-.09", Wrightwood-.24" with 6" snow, Big Bear-.31" with 7" snow and Palomar-.50" with 3" snow. At 8pm gusty N winds came up to 34 mph at 7pm dropping wind chill to 18° at 8:56pm. Cold temps; Burbk 34°, Pasadena 34°, Pierce 34° LA 39°, Mt Wilson 19°, Wrightwood 16°, Big Bear 14° and Frazier Park 7°.
- 30-Wind increased after 3am hitting 50 mph at 4:08am. Hit 39 mph at 7am and 45 mph at 8:16am. Let up after 5pm and ended mostly by 6pm. At 4:41am had a 14° wind chill. At 8:15am wind chill was still down to 21°. Low of 35° set a date record by 2° last set in 1979. This area was the windiest along with Chilao 48 mph and Devore 36mph. Cold everywhere in the State with Pasadena 36°, Avalon 39°, Long Beach AP 32°, Ontario 32°, Mt. Wilson 18°, Big Bear 9°, Ventura 30°, Sta Maria 27°, Lancaster 21°, Edwards 17°, Bear Valley 16°, Bishop 10°, Shaver Lk 8°, Oakhurst 12°, Mammoth RS -12°, Tuolumne Mds -17°, South Tahoe -12°, Sacramento 26° and Stockton 25°.
- 31-Low of 34° set a date record by 1° last set in 1985. Tied the all Glendale record with 1957.
