5-Hit 87° today. Was 87° Pasa, 86° Burbk, 90° LA, 88° LAX, 89° Sta Maria, 94° Anaheim and 91° Palm Springs.

6-Brief lite Santa Ana in morn to 13 mph at 7:13am. Temp rose to 93°, the warmest day since Sep.13. Was the warmest Nov. day since 1997 and tied for the 2nd warmest. Set a date record hi by 5° last set in 1991. Tied the all Glendale record with 1962. Was 92° Burbk, 90° Pasa, 97° Pierce, 95° LA, 91° LAX, 95° Oxnard, 86° Morro Bay, 95° Riverside and 94° Palm Springs.

7-High hit 95°, only 1° shy of tying the Nov. record high here. Was the second 90° this month, just 1 day shy of record. The all Glendale high of 97° was set exactly 44 years ago today. Did set a date record by 7° last set in 1991. Was 94° Burbk, 93° Pasa, 97° LA, 93° LAX, 101° Pierce, 100° Simi Vly, 93° Oxnard, 96° Sta Maria, 91° Pismo Bch, 98° Riverside and 95° Palm Sprs.

 8-NE winds in the morning to 17 mph at 8:22am. After 9pm had a few sprinkles from approaching weak front.
 9-At 6:30pm a shower hit from an approaching front of T". At 9:15pm began to rain ending by 11pm with .44". Was the biggest storm since May 20-21. SE winds after 8pm to 21 mph at 9:30pm and shifted to NW at 10pm.

Was 20° Pierce, 36° LA, 35° LAX, 31° Redondo Bch, 30° Torrance, 38° Avalon, 20° Chino, 25° Ontario, 24° Riverside, 21° Banning, 1° Big Bear and cabin, 9° Lake Arrowhd, 3° Lancaster (a Jan. record low), 23° Santa Maria, 1° Bishop, 12° Yosemite with river frozen over, 24° Palm Sps and 18° Thermal. NE winds came up after 7:20pm to 27 mph at 8:55pm. Low at Bishop was coldest Jan. since 1974.
- 15-Low of 32°, along with NE winds to 24 mph at 8:41am and ended by 10am. High of only 60° was still the warmest day in 5 days. All across Calif millions of dollars in crops have been lost. Set a date record by 3° set last year and a all Glendale record by 2° set in 1962. Was 35° Burbk, Pasadena, 22° Mt. - 22-Showery rains conti. until 6am with .45" more in early morning hours for storm total of .95" as skies broke after 9am. Was wettest storm since Feb. 27. Showers began again at 12:45pm with .11" by 1:15pm. At 2:10pm a thunderstorm began to west moving north ending by 2:20pm then more showers to 4pm for 1.26" storm total. Was the most Sep. rain since 1986. Was the 7th wettest Sep. in 54 yrs High of 67° was the coolest day since June 5. At 6:45pm had .01" more in shower for 1.26" total. - 25-Baro. rose to 30.08" at 11am, high for month.
