- 5-Cold, weak storm went over with gusty SW winds. Snowed in Sierras up to 3" Mammoth RS and 1" Tahoe City and T" Big Bear.
- 6-Low of 46° was the coldest morn since May and for month. Was 32° Mt. Wilson, 24° Wrightwood, 23° Big Bear, 28° cabin, 19° Lodgepole, 20° Bodie, 21° Mammoth RS and 17° Truckee.
- 10-Low of 49° set a date record by 2° set in 1997 and 2001.
- 12-Lite rain began at 10pm with .11" by midnite.
- 13-Lite rain conti until 4am with .52" more or .63" storm total. Office-.53" Burbk-.49", Pasa-.56", LA-.95", LAX-.64", Avalon-.20", Mt. Wilson-.44", Big Bear-.10" and deserts-0
- 15-Drizzle in early morn of .01" with Woodland Hills-.01"
- 18-Low of 49° tied the date record low set 5 times before.
- 19-High climbed to 90°, warmest day in 23 days. Was 88° LA, 90° Burbk and PAsdena 95° Riverside and 91° Palm Sprs.
- 21-NE winds came up just after midnite increasing to 36 mph at 5:22am and conti all day to 32 mph at 11:58am. Many fires erupted all over including Malibu, Canyon Country and San Deigo Cty along with Running Sprs and Arrowhead. Peak gusts; Catalina AP- 49 mph, Malibu Hills-64 mph, Newhall Pass-74 mph, Camp 9-78 mph, CIO-75 mph, Warm Sprs-91 mph, Whitaker Pk-108 mph, Port Hueneme-73 mph and Lag Peak-82 mph

- 22-Fires now cover 20 spots. NE winds came up at sunset to 17 mph at 5:30pm
- 23-High of 96° set a date record by 2° set in 2003. Was the warmest Oct temp in 4 yrs and for month. Was a all Glendale record by 1° set back in 1959. Was 92° Burbk, Pasadena and Pierce, 98° Long Bch, 87° Santa Monica Pier, 85° Avalon, 97° Camarillo, 96° Oxnard, 95° SLO, 99° Santa Ana, 96° Riverside with 92° Plm Sprs
- 24-High of 95° tied the date record set in 1990, Low of 69° was the warmest Oct. morn in 4 yrs. Was 93° Burbk, 96° Pasa, 94° LAX, 99° Camarillo, 102° Simi Vly, 91° SLO, 99° Santa Ynez, 98° Riverside and 95° Palm Sprs. Skies were clear but occ'lly covered with smoke from the 21 fires burning.
- 27-Upper low off coast produced shower at 11am and from 4-5:30pm of T". Some are had T" but up coast; Ventura-.02", Sta Maria-.14" and SLO-.19"
- 28-High of 92° set a date record by 2° set in 2003 and 2006. BARo rose to 30.22" at 11am, high for month.

15-High of 89° set a date record by 3° set in 2006. Was a all Glendale record by the same. Was 87° Burbk, 88° Pasadena, 89° Pierce and Lompoc, 93° Hemet was nation hot spot.

21-Low of 42° was the coldest morn of the month and since Ap.21. Was 50° Burbk, 49° Pasadena, 23° Big Bear and 21° Lockwood Valley.

23-NE winds came up at 1:45pm up to 34 mph at 5:35pm, let up some after 8pm.

24-NE winds hit 14 mph at 1:05am and ended at 7:30am.

28-Another Malibu area fire erupted at 3:30am burning 35 homes. Barometer rose to 30.22" at 7pm, high for the month.

- 4-Low of 37° set a date record by 1° last set in 2004. Had occ'l gusty NW winds during the day that increased in evening to 26 mph at 9:51pm.
- 5-NW winds ended after 4am after hitting 15 mph at 12:50am. Barometer rose to 30.32" at 10am, high for the month.
- 8-High of 79° was the warmest day in over 2 months (Dec.5).

- 2-NE wind came up briefly after 11pm to 20 mph
- 3-Barometer rose to 30.30" at 11am, high for the month.
- 10-High of 80° was the warmest day in 12 days (Feb.27). Was 80° Burbk, 78° Pasadena, 81° Pierce, 82° LA, 86° Anaheim and 83° Palm Sprs.
- 11-High of 82° was the warmest day since Feb. 12. Was 78° Pasadena, 82° Burbk, and LA, 86° Pierce and 87° Palm Sprs.
