W. of Pt. St George moving N @ 20 knts
- Tstorm w/ mod R + occ lightning here ~ 2000
Numerous advisories + warnings
Serious flooding Lemoore area + Newbury Park a.m.
Sur Tstorm watch SLO city to MRY city.
- 7) Another strong front moving east into C.A. dragging
a wet cold front thru VTU + LA cty's
late aft + eve. More strong S-SE winds, esp
VTU, SBA, + SLO counties, with gusts 40-50 mph
- 8) Wk front w/ mod R, one rumble of thunder
- 9) Strong, wet front moving ESE thru So Cal.
BP down to ≈ 29.62 midday
tornado in Central Valley
- 10) Storm 1.03"
- 11) Sur Tstorm warning SBA county late aft.
squall w/ wall cloud SFO even a.m.
- 12) Very strong + dynamic trough digging along CA coast.
Great diffrence aloft, very moist SW flow + low
mid levels, strong flow aloft, old frontal
boundary from yesterday lingering across L.A./VTU
county area. Heavy rain SBA/VTU, W.L.A.
county through mid afternoon. Chugging SE into
Orange Cty, Inland Empire evening
