5) 90°F @ San Diego / Gillespie Field - Highest in Nation

6) ^{July} Upper low approaching So Cal from West with abundant mid-level moisture. Sprinkles & light rain mostly VTh county north along coast, dry air at surface. Highest in nation officially Blendale & Northridge with 81°F (though Pierce reported 83°F) but these are highs from the 5th.

12) Dry frontal passage Apr. with local strong N winds behind front pk gust 63 mph @ Saugus @ 1300, 28 @ 409 55 knots @ 2246Z

17) Developing SA winds - Max 88 @ Pismo B.

26) Large brush fire to our north - right up to the woods on Via Colmar.

28) From Hanford NWS: BFL - w/ zero rain in Dec... only 7th dry Dec since records began in 1889;
For BFL - first dry calendar year (below normal prec) with 4.96" since 1890 (3.51")

For FAT - 4th driest Dec since 1878 with 0.07" calendar year amount of 15.24" - 14th wettest on record because of 10.62" between 1/15 + 3/8 ann. normal is 10.60"

FAT - 0.08" in Nov/Dec, driest on record... no meas. rain @ BFL in Nov/Dec ties 1962
Riverside UC Highest in nation w/ 85,

28) 87°F @ Simi + Riverside UC

30) 84°F @ Pierce - Hottest in Nation... 4 pmer from 29th.
