- 1) Large Upper low nearly stationary near 30N/128W  
 - 500 mi SW of Pt. Conception @ noon.  
 eve discussion out of Hanford: upper low near 28N/131W, a  
 swath of juicy moisture from subtropics extends from  
 extreme SoCal southward toward the equatorial zone.  
 Low expected to track NE very slowly next 24 hours.

Flood Watch hoisted for the 12th as tropical plumes  
 aimed right at L.A./VTA counties.

- 2) Rain all morning and aft., turning to drizzle eve. Upper low pumping  
 moist S winds up into VTA/LAX counties.  
 SFV + Conejo Valley wettest, in LAX area. MWS - 7.68"  
 for 24 hours ending 4pm - Newhall 4.90"  
 PMD 3.44, WJF 2.52, SDB 3.89

Upper low west of Monterey eve, windy + moony NE

48-hour storm totals ending midnight 12th with 24-hr in parent.
