 F.F. Watch burn areas, some lightning w/ front. San. Gsb., San Bern. Valley  
 Strong winds near front, gust to 47<sup>mph</sup> @ Malibu Hills, 70 mph @ I-5 + Hwy 5  
 in Kern County  
 Strong upper low ~ 125 W of CA/OR border @ 9 p.m.  
 area rainfall amounts mostly 0.50" - 1.00"
- 3) Mostly dry, except for line of showers, stationary coming  
 off of Piru area and extending SE thru S FU to L.A.  
 mid-late afternoon
- 16) Large plume of moisture from Hawaii NEwards and into NoCal +  
 OK. Strong S winds No Cal. 3.33" Kentfield, 3.85" Santa Rosa
- 17) Cold front appchng C + N Cal.  
 @ 2:15 pm - SUR storm warning for W.C. Contra Costa County  
 near Tiburon + Richmond  
 @ 2:17 pm - marine warning for storm 14 mi SW of SFO moving NE 20  
 @ 1:34 pm Post storm warning - W.C. NW between Ferrelly +  
 Leveale along I-80 + N + W of Fallon  
 Flood Watch for Russian R.  
 @ 3 pm Storm Tops ~ 40,000' SFO area, frgt Ct activity  
 @ 2:56 pm @ SFO - 190 @ 39 E 54 KT
- 20) Midday storms Pacoima to Moorpark + W. Cooma + Inland Empire - RAZ  
 ONT - Lots of Thunder Riverside Midday
- 21) Strong jets from 150-160 plus diving SE-ward W of CA and  
 heading into N. Baja. Wk surface low (1005 mb) 200 mi W  
 of SAN + moving slowly today, Ct-mod rain mainly  
 N into coastal sections late afternoon.
- 25) Strong cold front - frontal passage ~ 2400 ESE winds  
 prior to front 15-25 in the area, -- much  
 stronger withs + C. Coast
