- 2) Deep Upper low W of SFO @ 04Z (3rd) ~ 543 dm and dropping South. 1008 mb low near SFO
Numerous flood watches + winter wx watches in effect as slow moving front approaches So Cal from NW
Max/min @ SFO - 47/46
- 3) Strong front thru C.A. by noon. Large Uptr Low ~ 300 W of Pt. Conc. Waterspout S. of SMO ~ 1600; Funnels off of OJ Cty
Strong storm SFV w/ hail + occ lightning + local flooding
- 4) Shower activity daytime as upper low moves into AZ/NV
- 5) Min of 3F in Lockwood Valley + Frazier Park
- 6) at 8 pm - deepening surface low ~ 400 mi W of MRY, moving east - ESE
High Wind Wng for Cen. Coast as low deepens + approaches
- 7) Strong low moving into C. Cal + strong front thru So Cal by noon
Very strong winds - 66 @ Chileo, 62 mph Mill Creek,
62 Volterra, 65 mph Vandenberg AFB
65 mph Pt. Piedras Blancas, 72 mph Huntington Beach
75 mph ~ Train in Kern County - snow am. in Las Vegas
- 8) Stream of Pacific O. moisture is aimed at So Cal from the WSW + SW. Shortwave embedded in flow is organizing and will move into the district late tonight + tomorrow

Major upper low nearly stationary near 44N/130W - off of the WA coast. - Excellent orographics working on very moist airmass. 12.29" @ Opids Camp thru 11 pm.
Numerous flood + wind + winter storm watches + advisories

Baroclinic belt developing to our SW this evening - near 25N 130W. Snow levels rising to ~ 7000 ft

- 9) Cont. strong SW-WSW flow - cyclonic flow - of moisture into So Cal
as of 9:10 pm, Little Creek - 23.13" of rain since 5:20 am.
