22nd Summary by Lt. NWS

The base apr/lvl is precess system took residence in the NE Pacific, and the circulation around the southern periphery pumped very moist air via subtropical connection into Cen + SoCal. The "atmospheric river" of highest moisture remained focused across SoCal from the 17th to 22nd, bringing almost continuous rain to the region. Finally, on the 22nd, the upper low moved eastward and its strong frontal system moved through the region Tuesday + wed (21st + 22nd), with heavy rain and scattered thunderstorms.

Exceptional flooding/mud flows in Laguna Beach + Highland. Thunderstorms moving on 22nd from Long Beach to Pasadena
