

- (9) Flash-flood watch for N. San Bern. county, E. Kern + S. Inyo County due to thunderstorms
Wk flow all levels. Air mass mod. moist + unstable
East + North of Daggett, dry stable elsewhere
F.L. 13,000' w/ upper low over Oregon
Strong Inv @ 3-4000 feet over coastal areas
- 22) wk flow surf. + aloft - air mass drier + more stable.
F.L. 14,000' strong Inv @ 3,500'
- 23) wk NW to N flow aloft F.L. 14,000 strong Inv. @ 3,500'
- 24) Major ridge moving over the district with a. Pacific trough being ejected to the ENE. Desert trough (thermal low) moving east.
M.L. 3000' Mod. on shore flow; 13,000' F.L.
- 25) Short wave ridge over area - M.L. 1500-2000 feet
- 26) F.L. 15,000' wk w- NW flow aloft - Atmos. dry + stable
M.L. 1000-1500 ft - Mod. on shore flow
- 27) M.L. 800-1800' + rising; wk upper trough over S. Cal.
F.L. >15,000' - Upper low off Wash. Coast
- 28) M.L. ~3500' cyclonic SW flow aloft - trough off coast
F.L. - var. mid + high level moisture + on shore flow
- 29) Upper level low off Monterey - Unstable air here
