2) midday - Pressure falling rapidly as a storm develops off of S. Calif. about 400 mi WSW of L.A., moving SE, plus, a cold front extends along Ca + S. Calif coast from a low off San Fran. Storm is pulling cold air off of the Nevada Plateau area into S. Calif. giving Santa Ana-like winds during the ~~rain~~ day as light to moderate rain falls. Winter storm warning in mountains and blizzard like conditions in passes as snow level falls below 3000'. Gale warning for S. Cal. coast. Flash Flood Watch for below desert slopes in Riverside, Imperial Clys. Gusty East winds in Mtns, esp. Tehachians 30-60 mph w/ snow. .89" here (Taylor)
 Wind Chill factor here down to 10°F.
 Some snow reported in North Valley. Snow level 2000'.

23) Active cold front 150 mi W. of L.A. moving East @ 25 knots
 SW flow aloft - Assoc. trough deepening
