w/ a Marine layer 5-6000' deep. F.L. 12,000'

Ridge of High Pressure over S. Calif today, but a weak + slow
cold front expected tomorrow followed by cold unstable air +
strong upper trough
F.L. lowering to 10,000' by AM on 20th

Winter Storm Watch for N. Owens Valley, snow
down to 5000'; strong winds expected in N. Deserts.

20) Cold Upper trough over California - surface low
over Nevada; high W. winds in N. Deserts
- Blowing sand + dust - winds of .45 to .55 knots @ Las Vegas
Snow + F.L. lowering to 4000' + 5000', respectively

23) Inc High level moisture and
an on-shore trend. High
Pressure ridge along S. Cal.
coast w/ NW flow aloft
Rain front expected on 24th

24) Large High Pressure System at the surface
w/ a wk. ridge aloft dominating
S. Cal. - fronts will to the North
