East-west cold front moving South through state - Evening NNW Brz at Van Nuys - 15 knots

Van Nuys @ 2/45 Clear, 48°, D.P. 37°, Wind 340 @ 12.

17) Mod. to Strong dry N-flow a (off over S. Cal, w) trough over the Western states and a ridge off-the coast.

Off-shore flow and trend

Pressure falls off of S. Cal. coast and pressure rising over interior

21) Wk. Upper Low trough passage AM.

22) High Pressure (a surface + aloft) still covering

W. Coast + Calif.

25) Chatsworth 88° CSUN 81° LACC 80° WWHills 83°

Highest in nation Ft Myers 85°

26) Strong High pressure area over Nevada and Utah w/ a low pressure over N. Baja creating very strong Santa Ana winds for most of S. Calif. A weak Upper trough w/ some showers over the mtns + deserts moved through S. Calif. during the morning. High wind warning in effect through tonight for gusts of 60 below canyons and 70 mph in mtns.

Zuma @ 1000 + 1300 gusts to 50 knots, Van Nuys

45 knots, Mt. Laguna by Pt. Magu 90 mph gust. 4 or 5 gusts here of 60 mph or more, about 30 gusts of 50 or above.
