- 5) Upper high continuing over SW States w/wk S. flow aloft  
Warm relatively dry air mass over S. Calif. w/wk off-shore  
flow. Tomorrow - Upper high expected to shift Eastward  
from N. Ariz. to Texas + stronger sea breeze in PM.
- 7) Hur. Marie 150 mi SW of Cabo San Lucas moving NW @ 15 kts.  
Ridge of high pressure building into Pac. NW but M.L.  
deepening here - 2000' - few level on-shore flow
- 8) Hur. Marie - late evening 30 mi south of  
San Diego moving NNW ≈ 12 knots  
Sustained winds of 80 kts + weakening  
slowly. Very hot for all of S. Calif -  
105@ Santa Ang, 103 LACC, 110 San Gabriel -  
for 9th - Increasing chance of <sup>hottest in nation</sup>  
rain + SE winds for San Diego.
