9) An intense early winter storm moving South along West Coast. Strong winds today in N. Deserts, winter storm watch for Owens Valley, N. Deserts, & N. Mtns for tomorrow night above 4000 feet.

12) Upper low now over S. Nevada

Very cold air behind low.

Morning light snow in San Bern. + Riverside.

On 11th, snow in Victorville, towards Bardow

Heavy snow left in Sierras, N. Arizona.

23) Strong frontal system moving towards Cent. & S. Calif from the west, expected to bring heavy rain by morning of 24th

Flash flood watch for extreme S. Santa Barbara Cty + all of Ventura Cty, esp. burned areas.

No rain in S. Calif before Mt.

Tr. Advisory for Mtns + N. Desert for strong S. winds, heavy rain in Mtns. Snow level beginning @ 8000'

24) Fl. Flood watch continues for areas mentioned on 23rd.

Low pressure area 200 mi. W. of L.A. moving SE, (@ 10 pm)

No flooding problems so far

29) Very strong S-SW-W winds, esp. along coast and in N. Deserts + Mtns. Gust @ Ventura Harbor ~ 55 knots. Fast moving front moving through midday.
