3) Tail end of cold front passing through mid-afternoon, causing thunderstorm w/hail over Newhall area, San Bern.; Strong W winds along W. Coast, N. Deserts

B) First in a series of Pacific storms moving into California from the west. Heaviest rain around 1AM to 8AM.

Flash Flood watch for burn areas of Ventura County for next storm expected on 14th, with up to 8 inches expected for the storm in the burned areas.

(A) Second Pacific storm slamming into California - warmfront type weather from noon on 13th to noon on 14th - Drizzle; light rain + mild temps in mid 50s to upper 50s

Snow level above 10,000' today, lowering tonight.

Storm Warning along C. Calif. coast

Flash Flood Watch for most of Santa Barbara, Ventura,

L.A. Mtn areas; Flash Flood Warning to 10 PM in Santa Monica Mountains + Ventura County, burned areas

Strong Winds - SE 40-50 mph in Bakerfield PM.

High Winds North Coast - San Francisco area 50-70 mph AM

Strong line of Thunderstorms moving through S. Calif mid evening, from Daguerre to Orange City @ 2030, moving E @ 30

15) Most westerly flows aloft w/ scattered light showers following frontal passage - Very mild Pacific air
