- 13) Few Sm, Fe; EGV; Very early AM NE 20-30 PG 45 dying towards sunrise, then 10-15 PG 24 Midday, dr
- 14) AM $\textcircled{1}$ - $\textcircled{1}$ As, Ci; Cu w/ late eve Ci, $\textcircled{1}$ - $\textcircled{1}$ thin Ci PM. EGV AM, VGV PM. NE 10-20

- 16) Rain, mod-hvy AM w/ str ENE wind 10-20 PG 35, some sleet?; Light - Mod. Lrn PM; PM ES
- 49 High temp @ 4 AM, PM High 44 @ 1800; No Sun, Very Cold, Windy + Wet esp. near sunrise
- 17) AM Showers; Daytime $\textcircled{1}$ As w/ spkls very light showers + NE Brz 7-15 PG 34 midday, PG 26 eve.
- 18) Few Ci, Eve Ac $\textcircled{1}$ - $\textcircled{1}$; EGV - VGV eve. Early AM 10-20 PG 28, Midday 10-15
- 19) $\textcircled{1}$ - $\textcircled{1}$ Sc, Cum, Ac; clear eve; NE 5-12 PG 25 midday, 20 eve.; EGV PM) (dying eve

- 24) Daytime $\textcircled{1}$ - $\textcircled{1}$ Cu, Sc, esp. over mtns.; EGV, NE Brz 5-15 PG 26 dying mid-eve.
- 25) EGV NE Brz 5-12 PG 25 midday; NW Brz late aft + eve to 10
