- 4) Upper low 200 mi SW of L.A. moving slowly East
Thunderstorms over San Gabriel Valley around sunset,
only a little thunder here
- 5) Funnel Cloud / Waterspout 5 mi W of LAX @ 1015
An intense line of thunderstorms moving along coastal
waters between Long Beach + Oxnard around 1300.
Sp. Marine Statement - Warning for Costa / areas
Upper low moving NE to near Bakersfield by evening
Very heavy rain in various parts of S. Cal. - esp. San Diego,
Death Valley region, and Las Vegas. All roads to D.V. by close
Some large hail in spots; Light winds, mostly 10-mod showers
here.
Snow @ most ski resorts in S. Calif., Snow level 6-7000
- 6) Ridge bldg over Calif.
- 7) Strong polar trough digging SE into Nevada
Cold front through N. Calif w/ high pressure building behind front.
Strong wind advisory (W-NW) for N. deserts & mtns
