- 6) High pressure ridge continues at surface + aloft over West Coast. Upper low develops over High Wind Watch for tomorrow as surface high intensifies over Gr. Basin. Near record highs for West SFV. Very warm morning temps as wind increased - 72° @ 0500 here. Van Nuys + Burbank both in low 70s towards midnight; PSP highest in nation 89°
- 7) High Wind Warning for most of SoCal - N to NE winds w/gusts 45-60 mph. Str. surface high over West Canada and low pressure over outflow Calif.
- 8) High Press over Utah/Idaho + low pressure over N. Baja, with strong NE flow at most levels over SoCal.
- 14) Strong Upper Low ~~and~~ deepening over Nevada and then expected to move SW over SoCal. Strong N winds in Owens Valley + strong W winds in Ant. Valley tonight
- 15) Strong Cold Upper Low drifting West through Central Calif. - off Pt. Conception. Cold Midday Showers here with daytime low of 41° early aft. Strong NE winds North Valley + Simi Valley midday - 50 mph @ Twinsburg. Snow level near 2000 feet midday. Sheet in Santa Clarita, Snow evening in Ant. Valley. Snow in Paso Robles - 2" 6" of snow closing U.S. 101 South of Paso Robles. I-5 closed evening due to snow
- 16) Stationary Upper Low 125 mi West of Pt. Conception. 1 foot of snow @ Olancha; 1 storm @ Santa Barbara @ Mt. Snow Advisory continues for Nor. Mtns + Owens Valley
- 17) Low pressure aloft off Cent. Cal. coast drifting slowly Northward
- 18) Upper low moving E into AZ; one thunderclap here ≈ 0600
- 20) 989 mb low 400 mi W. of Seattle eye, w/strong front moving SE thru Cent. Calif
- 23) Win. St. Watch for N. Mtns for tomorrow + Christmas. Strong low pressure center expected to develop over N. Nevada tomorrow. "Unusually cold air" with system may lower snow level to below 2000 feet on Christmas. Surface low 300 mi W. of N. Calif on 23rd evening + developing rapidly and moving ESE
- 24) Major Winter Storm for Southland - W. St. Warning for Mtns for tomorrow as cold air + showers move in from North with possible snow as low as 1000 feet. 15" of snow today in Owens Valley.
