- 18) D.V. 127° (Low 87°) Mt. Wilson 87/75  
 19) Upper High over Calif; Upper Low over No. Mexico  
 D.V. 125°

- 20) Upper High over N. Calif / N. New border. ENE flow aloft  
 Flash flood watch for Eastern 1/2 of S. Bern. + Riv. Ctxs till mt  
 Line of strong storms moving W. out of AZ into Colo. R. Vly between  
 Wind E @ 45 - 65 @ 2200 PDT @ Blythe AP. (Nells + Blythe)  
 118 @ Redding - ties 9/11 time high

- 21) Upper high near Reno <sup>center of</sup> with a 6000 meter ~~center~~ height at 500 mb  
 Shows + T Shows over mtns + deserts of  
 S. Calif - mostly W. Mtns + Desert. Very humid + unstable  
 air over region. 75° here at 2330, mostly clear  
 Bakersfield 93° @ 2300 @ cloudy. Record Hi min here <sup>trial</sup> - 69

- 22) Fl. Flood Watch again for mtn + deserts of L.A., Kern + S. Bern Ctxs  
 Record High min here - 69°

- 23) FFW again for mtn + deserts - Upper High over Ariz., 109 mb Redding  
 Deepening Marine Layer as inland thermal trough deepens a bit, 1009 mb @ Reno  
 Sea temp 74° @ Marine Del Rey @ 11 PM

- 25) Upper High over SW U.S. with upper inverted trough over Sacramento

- 26) 4 Corners High continues - Severe T Storm near Mt. Pass @ 2200
