- 1) Upper low moving south through C. + S. Calif - snow adv. mtns above 4500 feet. Mostly small rain amounts; Wind adv. deserts
- 2) Strong Upper trough over plateau, w/ Upper low developing over Utah High Pressure building into Pac. NW. - High wind warning mtns + below canyons. as offshore low increases
- 15) High wind warning for SE Kern County (76 mph @ Mojave AP)
Wind adv. La. part of Mojave Desert + N. Mtns
Cold Low pressure over E. Nevada, moving slowly E.; 1003 mb over SE Utah
- 19) High pressure ridge over West
89 @ LACC ties record high for date
- 23) Strong NW winds N. Mtns + N. Desert evening
- 24) High pressure over W. U.S. + Eastern Pacific
Record High @ LACC - 94.0; - @ 2300: LACC 74°, LAX 75°
- 25) First 90° temp in March here
LACC record 96°. Long Beach 90; Thermal 100°; 99 @ Ft. Meigs
Still 78° @ El Toro @ Mt.
- 26) Surface High over Utah to offshore, except w/ thermal trough over Baja along S. Coast; Str. Upper trough w/ cold front moving into N. Calif + Pac NW. High (NW-N) wind watch for mtns tomorrow as front + trough move thru SoCal.
Many record highs in SoCal today - Many stations recording hottest March temp. ever. - LACC 98°
