- 3) High Pressure b'gng to build into Gr. Basin - @ 2400 73° @ cable, calm Wind Adv. for N. Mtns for NW winds to 45 mph
- 4) NW-N wind all night @ Van Nuys AP keeping temp in 70s  
 NNE Brz beginning here  $\approx$  1000 - dipping  $\approx$  1630  
 Van Nuys AP had SE Brz + very hazy + smoggy air from 1100-1500, before N Brz started again. Line of smog + haze reached as far west as Platt + Victory and smog + haze were seen just East + South of here from 1:30-2:00 PM, but that air retreated quickly after 3 PM. and never did reach here. Chatsworth 99°. Hottest in nation, Mt. Allen Tx 102°  
 W Hills + Chats hottest in ~~nation~~ California (Cable 97)
- 5) Dense fog coastal areas Evening  
 Chats 97, Cable 100; W Hills official hottest in nation with 95°
- 6) First major storm developing in Gulf of Alaska - 500 mi off Pac. NW coast + moving SE towards N. Cal. Large enough to affect most of Calif w/ wind from by tomorrow night
- 14) Strong winds desert, mtns, + coast - NW to 48 @ Daggett, NW 40 @ Lancaster  
 3" rain @ Mt. Wilson. snow local mtns down to  $\approx$  6000'  
 Upper trough moving east into AZ
- 17) Strong wind adv. for N. Deserts + Mtns gusts to 40 from NW  
 Strong upper trough dipping into E. Deserts.
- 2) Str. Storm off SW Canada moving SE; High Wind Watch for mtns + deserts tomorrow. 20% chance of snow tomorrow
- 28) High Wind Warning for Mtns + Valleys w/ gusts up to 60 mph  
 Forecast for tonight + tomorrow
