- 9) LAEC 102 - Record, Pt. Mugu 105 - Highest in nation  
@ 2300 Burbank 79° N9  
Surface High over W. Montana + Wyoming
- 13) Wk Cold front off Pt. Conc, late eve w/few showers
- 16) Wk Cutoff low over N. Baja.
- 19) Upper low over C. Baja w/ showers over S. Ariz, ext. S. Calif desert  
High pressure bldg into Pac. NW, M.L. decreasing a little
- 20) Upper low over Northern Mexico slowly moving east - drying NE flow  
aloft. Expected to lower M.L. to 1500 feet tomorrow
- 23) Wk Wind Pattern continues - Ridge over Pacific Coast, with a weak  
thermal trough over interior deserts and AM Stratus along coast +  
into valleys. Warm to hot still in interior with maximums  
at near record levels for this time of year. Death Valley  
maximums over 100 most of October thru the 20th,  
but 99 + 98 on 21st + 22nd.
