5) Cable 106 Chats 105

12) Hurricane Octave moving NNW @ 12 knots about ~~850~~ <sup>770</sup> nautical mi SSE of L.A., or 238 <sup>naut.</sup> mi WSW of Cabo San Lucas (evening)  
Max. sustained winds 115 knots w/gusts to 135 knots  
Weakening expected tomorrow, but high surf expected next couple of days.

At 8 P.M., centered @ 21.7N 114.0W  
diam. of eye 20 miles.

13) Hurricane Octave @ 8 P.M. PDT: 617 naut mi S of L.A.  
23.7N 117.3W moving 305° @ 8 knots 75 knots wind-gusts to 90

Ridge aloft over So Cal, M.L. becoming shallower and low level flow wking, perhaps becoming slight offshore tonight & tomorrow

14) Octave downgraded to a Trop. Storm midway - still moving NNW to NW @  $\approx$  10 mph - near 25N 119W @ sunset or 500 mi S of L.A. Upper trough to its NW (along 35W) expected to kick it up towards Calif. LAC 96°; warm here evening

15) T.D. Octave  $\approx$  280 mi S of L.A.

High Cloud shield covers most of Southern Cal. by evening.  
only Precip - some 1+ rain in San Diego

At 8 P.M. = 28°N 119.3°W <sup>moving</sup> <sub>010°</sub> N @ 5 knots Winds 30 to 40 knots  
Upper low approaching Calif. from the West, with much mid & hi level
