- 18) Moderately strong upper level low forming off C. Calif. coast & moving SE. Light rain C. Calif evening  
Heavier rain last 2 days San Fran + Sacramento area -  
1-2 inches - with help from Octave moisture  
Funnel clouds + tornadoes near Concord, Ca today  
Octave circulation dissipated a couple of hundred miles S. of L.A.
- 21) At 8 PM T.S. Priscilla 200 mi SE of La Paz, Baja Calif  
- moving NW @ 13 mph - max winds 50 mph - inc. in strength

At about 9 PM PDT Hurr. HUGO's eye over Charleston, South Carolina - HUGO is a 4 on the Safford-Simpson Scale. - Hugo moving NW @ 22 mph, with sustained winds of 135 mph. - Storm surge upto 17 feet expected

Upper high over No. Baja and thermal trough along coast, giving So Cal a warm dry off-shore flow  
L.A. C 95° - Chats 101°

Near sunrise - Laguna Peak 82° @ East winds to 27

- 22) Upper high over West U.S. Mod off-shore flow becoming ~~weak~~ weakly on by late evening  
97° LAC 101° RRB 105° Ont. and Chats 109° PHX  
Priscilla @ 8 PM - 20.0 N 116 W 881 naut mi SSE of L.A.  
moving 285° @ 8 knots max sust winds 55kn @ 70kn
- 25) High clouds from dying Priscilla
- 26) Upper high bldg over H-corners - Record heat Phoenix -  
Upper low west of N. Calif is nearly stationary
