ST High Wind Watch for late tonight - mtns & below canyons -
Mod. to Strong S.A. winds expected as surface high pressure
rapidly builds over Nevada. W. Hill hottest in nation (Chats 83°, too)

6) Strong winds have not developed through Laguna Peak ~~area~~ ~~had~~
50 knots from DNE. Tues 91° ~~Hottest in nation~~; 85 @ LACC

7) 91° @ Oceanside

(8) Omega block Gulf of Alaska - Arctic Air beginning to move into
Western U.S. from the North as deep upper low forms over
Washington. On-shore flow increasing So Cal. - High Wind Watch Mtns tomorrow
(Showers expected SoCal tom. night & Thurs ^{20th}) Much colder Thurs. as
cold trough dips into Calif & Nevada - low snow levels expected all of Calif.

(9) Arctic front as far south as ~ Redding late aft. - Rain showers
portions of Central Calif & San Diego area - none for most of
L.A. area. Very strong onshore gradient to 992 mb
surface low near Salt Lake, Utah, causing strong w. winds
along coast - 40 knots @ Zuma & Santa Monica, ~ 70 mph
gusts @ Laguna Peak. They snow Central Sierras &
snow at Eureka much of day.

21) Very Strong N to NW flow over SoCal, becoming more NW
late eve. Air very cold - Highs 23@ Sandberg, 29 Redding &
Red Bluff. Early eve ^{almost} calm here allowing temp to drop
to 27° before NE Breeze started raising temp to 32°.

Temps in SFV already in high 30s soon after sunset.
Van Nuys 33° @ 7 pm. with North wind 18 knots gusts to 30.
Most of L.A. area got no precip with this arctic air, but
the San Diego area got 1/2 - 1 inch rain as the flow aloft
had more of an over water fetch before landfall.

Morning of 21st saw very light snow flurries in Long Beach
& San Pedro. I-5 near Forman closed ~~occasionally~~ due to ice & snow.
High temps Moat/Wy only -20 or so.

22) Record Mins in SoCal 33 @ LACC, 73 Big Bear, 3 @ WJT
High pressure at surface building into Nevada, inc. off shore
flow. Windy morning Chats & VNeys with low only 30°

23) Strong (at 9 High S. Idaho - Mod-Spr SA, gust to 50 Chats; All-time lows set in CA, NV, UT
