4 AM cold front passage w/rain, then strong winds N. Mtns + coastal areas from NW + N - up to 60 mph N. Mtns.

12) Wind Adv. for Mtns + N. Des., w/high wind watch for tomorrow. We dry cold front passing thru SoCal this evening.

Storm developing over Gr. Basin + Rockies w/ strong NW winds expected; cold polar air expected over SoCal by eve. of Bth, w/some snow N. Mtns + deserts.

13) High Wind Warning for N. Deserts + N. Mtns.

A very cold storm system is developing in the SW. U.S. - over Nev. + Utah. West Winds at Daggett today gusted over 50 mph + vis. was less than 1 mile in blowing dust + sand.

→ Showers Pasadena area w/hail
Late evening lightning east of here over mtns. - Light snow showers ~~over~~ in San Bernardino after midnight (on 14th)
Cum + Sc clouds in L.A. Basin most of day - North + NW winds beginning mid evening in coastal areas - clearing most areas except near mountains.

14) A storm system is moving across AZ - Wind advisories are cancelled for evening over SoCal. Freeze warning for valleys tonight. ^{an} Heavy snow Gorman area as front max moved thru with cold North winds - A few very light snow flurries near foothills around 6 AM. - a little heavier San Bern. Valley + Rancho Cucamonga area.

^{E-W trending}
17) Very slow moving front [^] from ~~west~~ through SoCal today w/mod to heavy rain AM - esp. heavy west L.A./Ber. Hills with 4 to 5 inches, wettest storm here in at least 2 years.

Very cold
18) Upper low moving into So. Nevada, cold unstable air over SoCal w/snow level \approx 2000 feet, but w/showers of hail + sleet much of coastal SoCal L.A. area. Cold NW winds evening coastal areas 20-30 mph

25) Dense fog along coast evening
