

March, 1991

- 18) Flash flood watch issued 2300 until 2 AM (19th) for L.A. County nearly 6" rain Santa Barbara  
ESE winds at Laguna Peak 50-60 mph, gusting to 97 knots (111 mph) mid-even.
- 19) few rumbles + flashes of lightning  $\approx$  0200 w/light rain another cold front approaching from WNW tonight.  
Mostly fair with  $\odot$  in during day, West winds  $\approx$  5-15 mph dying by mid-eve.
- 20) Another short wave / cold front passage with heavy showers <sup>early AM</sup> scattered Tshowers much of SoCal daytime but little if any activity SFV. Funnel cloud reported 2 consecutive hours @ RIV midday. " " " W of SMX, and reports of tornado damage SFD area  
Loud, long single rumble of thunder here  $\approx$  0300
- 21) Rain late evening as cold front slowly drifts SE thru SoCal - cold upper low off of SFO nearly stationary
- 22) Rain ending here  $\approx$  sunrise, then PC to Cdy during day after cold front passage with some light showers around SFV, but dry some areas including here. Another rootmax / short wave forming West of SoCal during aft. and headed towards L.A. + SBA evening - prompting a WSW Mtng statements warning of the possibility of tornados  
brnados earlier today in Norwalk and NW of NID (Chim Lake)
- 26) Light rain early AM, then again PM - heavy showers / Tshowers after 4PM, with gusty South winds to 33 - 14 mod barometer  
Only a couple of flashes of lightning  
water spout / Tornado <sup>at</sup> Huntington Beach @ 2230  
Heavy Snow Mtns
- 27) 3 to 4 feet of snow local mtns
