- 3) Upper high over NE AZ - strong T storm moving W out of AZ eve into E. So Cal Deserts.
- 12) Large upper high over Nevada, nearly stationary; some T storms mtns + deserts
- 13) Strong upper high over Nevada with moist SE flow aloft. By noon - 2pm, a large MCC began developing over Central San Diego County. Very heavy rain Southern Mtns - 5.91 @ Mt. Palomar in less than two hours. Large anvil top expanded + covered most of SAN, Orange L.A. + W. San Bern + W. Riv. Counties by evening. Another heavy T storm N. of Ontario in Lucamonga Pk area - FI. FI. Windy + sev. Tst. Windy for it around 1600 - 1700 PDT. Outflow from T storm brought gusty winds + cooler temps many areas 10x off. Temp here fell about 18 degrees in one hour, with a gust to 18 from the east.

Most areas under MCC were dry

Most stations cloudy @ 10 p.m. w/high clouds

- 14) ☉ debris clouds until \approx 1000, then clyg + humid overnight
AM Low of 75 warmest low on record -
75 again by 2300

- 18) Upper High still over SW U.S. - now near Needles being pushed south by trough developing off of Wash.
- 2) Deep trough digging down W. Coast - M.L. deepening, eddy, stronger onshore flow - heat wave ending.
